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## 关Patons BROomstick Lace wrap |CROCHET

Wrap is made using the broomstick lace technique. A large knitting needle is used to create the loops which are then crocheted into. A 3 round pattern with cluster stitches creates the edging around entire Wrap.


## MATERIALS

Patons ${ }^{\circledR}$ Lace $^{\text {Tm }}$ (3 oz/85 g; $498 \mathrm{yds} / 455 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Arctic Plum (33317)
3 balls
Size U.S. G/6 ( 4 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. One size U.S. 35 ( 19 mm ) knitting needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $20^{\prime \prime}\left[51 \mathrm{~cm}\right.$ ] wide x $80^{\prime \prime}$ [203 cm ] long.

## GAUGE

23 sc and 25 rows $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 81. (See diagram on page 2)
1st row: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Do not turn. 80 sc .
2nd row: Place loop from hook onto knitting needle. Working from left to right, *Draw up a long loop in next sc and place on knitting needle. Rep from * to end of row. Do not turn. 80 loops on needle.

3rd row: Insert hook through next 5 loops on needle. Yoh and draw through 5 loops on hook. 5 sc in top of group of 5 loops. *Insert hook through next 5 loops on needle. Yoh and draw through 6 loops on hook ( 5 loops from needle, 1 loop already on hook). 5 sc in top of group of 5 loops. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Do not turn. 80 sc .

Rep 2nd to 4th rows for Broomstick Lace pat until work from beg measures approx $78 "[198 \mathrm{~cm}]$, ending on a 4th row. Fasten off.

Border: 1st rnd: With RS facing, join yarn with sl st to bottom right corner. Ch 1. Work 466 sc evenly up Right side edge. Work 3 sc in top corner. Work 1 sc in each sc to top left corner. Work 3 sc in top left corner. Work 466 sc evenly down Left side edge. Work 3 sc in bottom Left corner. Work 80 sc evenly across bottom edge. Work 3 sc in bottom right corner. Join with sl st to first sc. 1104 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 2. Yoh and draw a loop in same sc as last sl st. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice - beg cluster made. (Ch 3. Cluster) in same sc as beg cluster. *Skip next 3 sc . (1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) in next sc. Skip next 3 sc.** (Cluster. Ch 3. Cluster) in next sc. Rep from * around, ending at ${ }^{* *}$. Join with sl st to top of beg cluster.
3rd rnd: SI st to first ch-3 sp. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 4 dc in same ch-3 sp. ${ }^{*} \mathrm{Ch} 2.1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next ch-3 sp. Ch 2.5 dc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * around, ending with ch 2.1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 2. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.
