## PATONS ${ }^{\circledR}$ GRACE $^{\text {m }}$ <br> LACE EDGE SHAWL (TO CROCHET)

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 54 " $[137 \mathrm{~cm}]$ wide x 25 " $[63.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] deep at center back.

## MATERIALS

Patons $^{\circledR}$ Grace $^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $1.75 \mathrm{oz} / 50 \mathrm{~g} ; 125 \mathrm{~m} / 136 \mathrm{yds}$ )
62044 (Clay) $\quad \mathbf{8}$ balls

Size 5 mm (U.S. H or 8) crochet hook or size needed to obtain tension.

## TENSION

15 sc and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

## SHAWL

Ch 2.
1st row: (RS). ( 1 sc . Ch 1.1 sc ) in 2nd ch from hook. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Ch 3 . Miss next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Turn. 3rd row: Ch 1.2 sc in first sc. Ch 3 . Miss next ch-3 sp. 2 sc in last sc. Turn.
4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Ch 1.1 sc in next sc. Ch 3 . Miss next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Ch 1.1 sc in last sc. Turn.
5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Ch 2 . Miss next ch- 1 sp .1 sc in next sc. Ch 3. Miss next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Ch 2 . Miss next ch- 1 sp .1 sc in last sc. Turn.
6th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Ch 3 . Miss next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Ch 3 . Miss next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Ch 3 . Miss next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.
7th row: Ch 1.2 sc in first sc. *Ch 3 . Miss next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * across; ending last rep with 2 sc in last sc. Turn.
8th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Ch 1.1 sc in next sc. ${ }^{*}$ Ch 3 . Miss next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. Ch 1.1 sc in last sc. Turn
9th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Ch 2 . Miss next ch- 1 sp .1 sc in next sc. ${ }^{*}$ Ch 3 . Miss next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. Ch 2. Miss next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

## STITCH GLOSSARY

Sc $=$ Single crochet.
SK = Solomon's knot.
Sp(s) = Space(s).
St(s) = Stitch(es).
Yoh = Yarn over hook.

10th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Ch 3 . Miss next ch- 2 sp. 1 sc in next sc. *Ch 3 . Miss next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. Ch 3 . Miss next ch- 2 sp .1 sc in last sc. Turn.
Rep 7th to 10th rows 22 times more. Do not fasten off.

## EDGING

1st row: Ch 1 . Work 98 sc evenly down side edge, 3 sc in corner, and 98 sc evenly up other side edge. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 99 sc . 3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 99 sc. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 100 sc .3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 100 sc . Turn.
4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. 1 HSK. 1 SK. Miss next sc. 1 sc in next sc. ${ }^{*} 2$ SK. Miss next 5 sc .1 sc in next sc.* Rep from * to * 15 times more. ${ }^{* *}$ Miss next 2 sc. 2 SK. 1 sc next sc..* Rep from ** to ** once more. Rep from * to * 16 times more. 1 SK. Miss next 2 sc .1 dc in next sc. Turn.

5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first st. *2 SK. Miss 1 SK and next sc. 1 sc in top of next SK. Rep from * 34 times more. Turn.
6th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. 2 HSK. 1 SK. 1 sc in top of first SK. *2 SK. Miss 1 SK. 1 sc in top of next SK. Rep from * 33 times more. 1 SK. 1 dtr in last sc. Turn.
7th and 8th rows: As 5th and 6th rows.
9th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. *1 SK. [Ch 5. (Yoh and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook - cluster made. Ch 5. SI st] in top of last SK. 1 SK. Miss 1 SK and next sc. 1 sc in top of next SK. Rep from * 34 times more. Fasten off.

## SOLOMON’S KNOT (SK)



Draw up a loop 1" [ 2.5 cm ] long.


Yoh and draw up a loop.


Yoh and draw up a loop, maintaining long length of loop on hook.


Yoh.


Insert hook between the single back thread and the front 2 threads.


Draw through both loops on hook.

## HALF SOLOMON'S KNOT (HSK)

Work as per Solomon's Knot except draw up $1 / 22^{\prime \prime}[1 \mathrm{~cm}]$ loop.
