



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Dc2tog** = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**Dcbp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Pat** = Pattern

**PM** = Place marker

**Rep** = Repeat

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 60" [152.5 cm] wide x 30" [76 cm] deep

## GAUGE

11 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm]

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as hdc. Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc. Move marker to each center ch-3 sp. See diagram on page 2.

Ch 4.

**1st row:** (WS). (3 dc. Ch 3. 4 dc) in 4th ch from hook. Turn. 8 dc and ch-3 sp.

**2nd row:** Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. Ch 2. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. Skip next dc. (1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc in next ch-3 sp). PM on ch-3 sp for center. Ch 2. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. Skip next dc. 2 dc in top of ch 3. Turn.

## MATERIALS

Patons® Lincoln Fog™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 190 yds/174 m)  
Wisteria (12017) **4 balls**

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

**3rd row:** Ch 2. 2 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc in next dc. \*3 hdc in next ch-2 sp. Skip next dc. Rep from \* to center ch-3 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 3. 2 hdc) in center ch-3 sp. \*\*Skip next dc. 3 hdc in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \*\* to last 2 dc. 1 hdc in next dc. 2 hdc in top of ch 3. Turn.

**4th row:** Ch 2. 2 dcbp around first hdc. 1 dcbp around each hdc to center ch-3 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 3. 2 hdc) in center ch-3 sp. 1 dcbp around each hdc to last hdc. 2 dcbp around last hdc. Turn.

**5th row:** Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. \*(1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dc) in next st – V-st made. Skip next 2 sts.\* Rep from \* to \* to last dc before center ch-3 sp. V-st in last dc before center ch-3 sp. (1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) in center ch-3 sp. Rep from \* to \* to last 2 dc. V-st in next dc. 2 dc in top of ch 3. Turn.

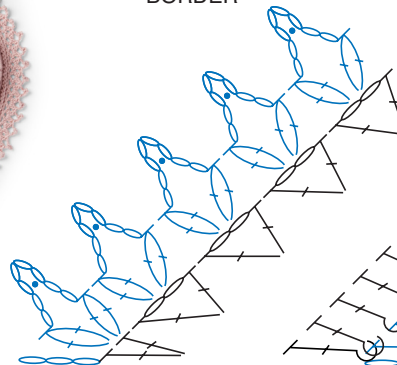
**6th row:** Ch 2. 2 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc in next dc. \*3 hdc in next ch-2 sp. Skip next 2 dc. Rep from \* to center ch-3 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 3. 2 hdc) in center ch-3 sp. \*\*Skip next 2 dc. 3 hdc in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \*\* to last 3 dc. Skip next dc. 1 hdc in next dc. 2 hdc in top of ch 3. Turn.

Rep 4th to 6th rows, noting reps between \* to \* will be increased until Shawl from beg along center measures approx 30" [76 cm], ending on 5th row.

**Border row:** Ch 3. Dc2tog in sp between first 2 dc. Ch 6. Sl st in 4th ch from hook. Ch 2. Dc2tog in same sp as last dc2tog – Cluster made. Skip next 2 dc. \*Cluster in next ch-2 sp. Skip next 2 dc.\* Rep from \* to \* to center ch-3 sp. (Cluster. Ch 6. Sl st in 4th ch from hook. Ch 2. Cluster) all in center ch-3 sp. Skip next 2 dc. Rep from \* to \* to last 3 dc. Cluster in sp between last 2 dc. Fasten off.







### STITCH KEY

-  = chain (ch)
-  = slip stitch (sl st)
-  = half double crochet (hdc)
-  = double crochet (dc)
-  = back post dc (dcbp)
-  = double crochet 2 together (dc2tog)
