SIZES

To fit bust measurement

XS/M 28-38" [71-96.5 cm]
L/XL 40-46" [101.5-117 cm]
2/5XL 48-62" [122-157.5 cm]

GAUGE

10 sts and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm]
 in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: Garment is worked in one piece.
 Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as st.

Beg at lower edge of Back, ch **101 (110-122)**. See diagram on page 3.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. *Skip next 2 ch. (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch. Rep from * to last 3 ch. Skip next 2 ch. 1 sc in last ch. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *(1 sc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last dc and sc. Skip next dc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.
 Rep last row for pat until work from beg measures **25 (30-34)"**

MATERIALS

Patons® Norse™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 211 yds/193 m)

Sizes	XS/M	L/XL	2/5XL	
Jam Heather (91018)	6	8	10	balls

Size U.S. M/13 (9 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
 2 smaller buttons 1" [2.5 cm] diameter for sides. 2 larger buttons 1½" [4 cm] diameter for front.

[63.5 (76-86.5) cm], ending on a WS row. PM at each end of last row for shoulders.

Shape neck and Right Side:

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. [(1 sc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp] 14 times. Skip next dc and sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Ch 3 (does not count as st). 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. *(1 sc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last dc and sc. Skip next dc. 1 sc in last sc. **Turn.**

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *(1 sc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last dc and sc. Skip next dc. 1 sc in last sc. **Turn.**

Rep last row until work from marked row measures **25 (30-34)" [63.5 (76-86.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Left Side: With RS facing skip next 2 ch-1 sps. Join yarn with sl st to next ch-1 sp.

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. *(1 sc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last dc and sc. Skip next dc. 1 sc in last sc. **Turn.**

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *(1 sc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 ch-1 sps. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in last ch-1 sp. **Turn.**

3rd row: Ch 1. Skip first dc. 1 sc in next sc. *(1 sc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last dc and sc. Skip next dc. 1 sc in last sc. **Turn.**

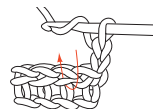
4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *(1 sc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last dc and sc. Skip next dc. 1 sc in last sc. **Turn.**

Rep last row until work from marked row measures **25 (30-34)" [63.5 (76-86.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Buttonhole front and neck edging:

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. **Turn.** **15 (17-19) hdc.**

2nd row: Ch 2. Working in horizontal bar created below next st in previous row which creates ridge (bar is below loops normally worked on WS-see diagram which shows WS of work), 1 hdc in each st to end of row. **Turn.**



Rep last row until work, when slightly stretched, measures from bottom to beg of neck shaping along left front edge and sew in position as you work.

Mark position of 2 buttons **8 (10-12)" [20.5 (25.5-30.5) cm]** and **14 (16-18)" [35.5 (40.5-45.5) cm]** up from bottom of edging.

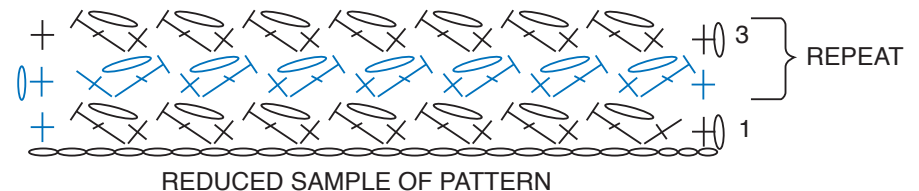
Cont as before around neck edge and down right front edge to bottom, working buttonholes to correspond to button markers as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 2. Working in horizontal bar created below next st in previous row which

creates ridge, 1 hdc in each of next **7 (8-9)** sts. Ch 2. Skip next 2 sts. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. **Turn.**

2nd row: Ch 2. Working in horizontal bar created below next st in previous row which creates ridge, 1 hdc in each st to next ch-2 sp. 2 hdc in next ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. **Turn.**

Try on Wrap and sew 2 smaller buttons through all thicknesses to secure sides. Sew 2 larger buttons to correspond to buttonholes. Fold back shawl collar (see photo).
