Patons® Lincoln Fog™ (3.5 oz /100 g; 190 yds/174 m)

Contrast A Silver (12007) 4 balls

Contrast B Mother of Pearl (12003) 2 balls

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

SI st = Slip stitch

Sp = Space

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 24" x 60" [61 x 152.5 cm], excluding fringe.

GAUGE

11 sts and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.
- Shawl is reversible.



♣ Patons° TWEED CROCHET SHAWL

With A, ch 67.

1st row: (RS). With A, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. *1 dc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from * to last ch. 1 dc in last ch. Join B. Turn. 66 sts.

2nd row: (WS). With B, ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. *1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 dc in last sc. **Do not** turn.

3rd row: (WS). With A, sl st in first sc. Ch 3. *1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to last dc. 1 sc in last dc. Turn.

4th row: (RS). With B, sl st in first sc. Ch 3. *1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to last dc. 1 sc in last dc. Do not turn.

5th row: (RS). With A, sl st in first dc. Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. *1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 dc in last sc. Turn.

6th row: (WS). With B, sl st in first dc. Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. *1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 dc in last sc. **Do not** turn.

Rep 3rd to 6th rows until work from beg measures approx 60" [152.5 cm], ending on 3rd row.

Next row: With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn. **Do not** fasten off.

Fringe Chains: *Ch 17. SI st in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. SI st in next sc. Rep from * across to last sc. Ch 17. SI st in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Fasten off.

Join A with sl st to first ch of foundation ch. Ch 1. Working in rem loops of foundation ch, 1 sc in same sp as last sl st and each st to end of row. Turn. **Do not** fasten off. Work Fringe Chains as given for opposite side.
