



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Beg** = Begin(ning)  
**Ch** = Chain(s)  
**Cont** = Continue  
**Dc** = Double crochet  
**Dec** = Decreas(e)(ing)  
**Hdc** = Half double crochet  
**Hdc2tog** = Yoh and draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

**Rem** = Remain(ing)  
**Rep** = Repeat  
**RS** = Right side  
**Sc** = Single crochet  
**Scbl** = Single crochet in back loop  
**Sp** = Space  
**St(s)** = Stitch(es)  
**WS** = Wrong side  
**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## SIZES

### To fit bust measurement

**XS/S** 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]  
**M** 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]  
**L** 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]  
**XL** 44-46" [112-117 cm]  
**2/3XL** 48-54" [122-137 cm]  
**4/5XL** 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

### Finished bust measurement

**XS/S** 38" [96.5 cm]  
**M** 42" [106.546 cm]  
**L** 46" [117 cm]  
**XL** 50" [127 cm]  
**2/3XL** 58" [147.5 cm]  
**4/5XL** 66" [167.5 cm]

## GAUGE

21 hdc and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

## INSTRUCTIONS

*The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes, the instructions are written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.*

## MATERIALS

Patons® Grace™ (1.75 oz/50g; 136 yds/125 m)

## Anchor® Embroidery Floss Spools

0877 – 1 spool 0877  
 0875 – 1 spool 0875  
 0893 – 1 spool 0893  
 0279 – 1 spool 0279  
 0884 – 1 spool 0884

Sizes U.S. E/4 (3.5 mm) and F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge**. Yarn needle. 5 buttons - size 3/8" [9 mm]. Optional: Sticky-back water soluble fabric stabliizer to transfer embroidery motif.

## BACK

### \*\*Ribbing

With smaller hook, ch 21.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 20 sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.\*\*

Rep last row until ribbing measures **19** (**21-23-25-29-33**)" [**48** (**53.5-58.5-63.5-73.5-84**) cm], when slightly stretched, ending on a WS row. (**Do not** fasten off).

**Next row:** (RS). Ch 1. Work **98** (**110-118-130-150-172**) sc evenly along side edge of Ribbing. Turn.

**Note:** Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as hdc.

Change to larger hook and proceed as follows:

**1st row:** (WS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each sc to end of row. Turn. **98** (**110-118-130-150-172**) hdc.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until Back measures **12** (**12-13-13-15-15**)" [**30.5** (**30.5-33-33-38-38**) cm], ending on a WS row.

**Shape armholes: 1st row:** (RS). Sl st in each of first **8** (**11-13-15-19-19**) hdc. Ch 2 (**does not** count as hdc). 1 hdc in same sp as last sl st. 1 hdc in each hdc to last **7** (**10-12-14-18-18**) hdc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. **84** (**90-94-102-114-136**) hdc.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 hdc. Hdc2tog. Turn. **82** (**88-92-100-112-134**) sts.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows **5** (**6-6-7-10-14**) times more. **72** (**76-80-86-92-106**) sts.

Cont even in hdc until armholes measure **8** (**8½-9-10-11-12**)" [**20.5** (**21.5-23-25.5-28-30.5**) cm], ending on a WS row.

**Shape neck: Next row:** (RS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of next **18** (**20-20-22-22-28**) hdc. Hdc2tog. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

**Next row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn. **18** (**20-20-22-22-28**) sts.

**Next row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Fasten off.

With RS facing, skip next **32** (**32-36-38-44-46**) hdc. Join yarn with sl st to next st. Ch 2. Hdc2tog over same sp as last sl st and next st. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn. **18** (**20-20-22-22-28**) sts.

**Next row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Fasten off.

## LEFT FRONT

\*\*\*Work from \*\* to \*\* as for Back ribbing.

Rep last row until ribbing measures **8** (**9-10-11-13-15**)" [**8.5** (**23-24.5-28-33-38**) cm], when slightly stretched, ending on a WS row. (**Do not** fasten off).

**Next row:** (RS). Ch 1. Work **40** (**45-48-53-68-77**) sc evenly along side edge of Ribbing. Turn.

Change to larger hook and proceed as follows:

**1st row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each sc to end of row. Turn

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg measures same length as Back to armhole, ending on a WS row.\*\*\*

## Shape armhole and V-neck:

**1st row:** (RS). Sl st in each of first **8** (**11-13-15-19-19**) hdc. Ch 2 (**does not** count as hdc). 1 hdc in same sp as last sl st. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 3 hdc. Hdc2tog (neck edge). 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn. **32** (**34-35-38-49-58**) sts.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn. **30** (**32-33-36-47-56**) sts.

Rep last 2 rows **5** (**6-6-7-10-14**) times more. **20** (**20-21-22-27-28**) sts.

## Sizes XS/S, L and 2/3XL only:

**Next row:** (WS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows **1** (**0-4**) time(s) more. **18** (**20-22**) sts.

**All sizes:** **18** (**20-20-22-22-28**) sts.

**Next row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until armhole measures same length as Back, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work from \*\*\* to \*\*\* as given for Left Front.

## Shape armhole and V-neck:

**1st row:** (RS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in first hdc. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last last 7 (10-12-14-18-18) hdc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. 32 (34-35-38-49-58) sts.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in first hdc. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn. 30 (32-33-36-47-56) sts.

Rep last 2 rows 5 (6-6-7-10-14) times more. 20 (20-21-22-27-28) sts.

## Sizes XS/S, L and 2/3XL only:

**Next row:** (WS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in first hdc. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows 1 (0-4) time(s) more. 18 (20-22) sts.

**All sizes: Next row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until armhole measures same length as Back, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

Ch 11.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 10 sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.\*\*

Rep last row until ribbing measures 15 (16½-16½-17½-18-20¼)" [21.5 (21.5-26.5-26.5-30.5-30.5) cm], when slightly stretched, ending on a WS row. (Do not fasten off)

**Next row:** (RS). Ch 1. Work 77 (85-85-93-97-105) sc evenly along side edge of Ribbing. Turn.

Proceed in pat as follows:

**1st row:** (WS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until Sleeve from beg measures 4 (4-4-5-5-5)" [10 (10-10-12-12-12) cm], ending on a WS row.

**Shape Top: 1st row:** Sl st in each of next 8 (11-11-15-19-19) hdc. Ch 2 (does not count as hdc). 1 hdc in same sp as last sl st. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 7 (10-10-14-18-18) hdc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. 63 (65-65-65-61-69) hdc.

**Next row:** (WS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 hdc. Hdc2tog. Turn. 61 (63-63-63-59-67) sts.

**Sizes XS/S, M and L only:** Rep last row 25 (26-26) times more, dec 2 sts every row. 11 sts rem. Fasten off.

## Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

**Next row:** (WS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn. (61-57-65) sts.

Rep last 2 rows (3-9-7) times more, dec 2 sts every other row. (55-39-51) sts.

**Next row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn. (53-37-49) sts.

Rep last row (19-11-17) times more. 15 sts rem. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

## BUTTONBAND

With RS facing, join yarn with sl st to bottom Right Front.

**1st row:** Ch 1. Work 62 (62-68-68-78-78) sc evenly up Right Front edge to V-neck shaping, 42 (44-46-50-54-58) sc evenly along V-neck shaping to shoulder, 21 (36-42-47-51-61) sc evenly along neck edge, 42 (44-46-50-54-58) sc evenly down Left V-neck shaping and 62 (62-68-68-78-78) sc evenly down Left Front edge. Turn. 187 (248-270-283-315-333) sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. \*Ch 4. Skip next 4 sc (buttonhole made). 1 sc in each of next 9 (9-11-11-13-13) sc. Rep from \* 4 times more. (5 buttonholes made). 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**4th row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc and 4 sc in each ch-4 sp to end of row. Turn.

**5th row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Fasten off.

Sew on buttons to correspond to buttonholes.

## EMBROIDERY

Using template on page 5 and color guide on page 6, embroider Floral design on either side of Cardigan.

**Stems:** Using 0877, embroider Stems using Stem Stitch.

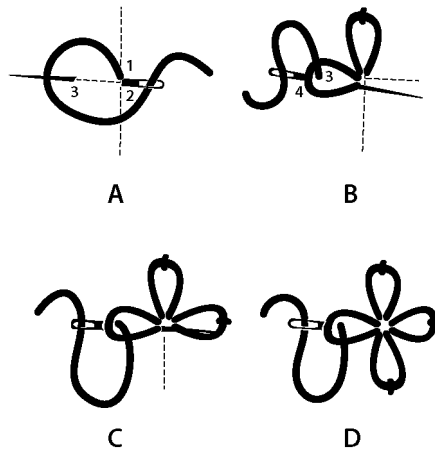
STEM STITCH



**Leaves:** Using 0875, embroider Leaves using Lazy Daisy Stitch.

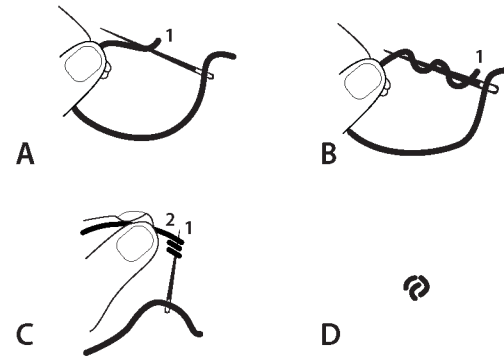
**Flower Petals:** Using 1023, 1092 and 0279, embroider Petals using Lazy Daisy Stitch.

LAZY DAISY STITCH



**Flower Centers:** Using 0884, 0893 and 0279 embroider Flower Centers using French Knots.

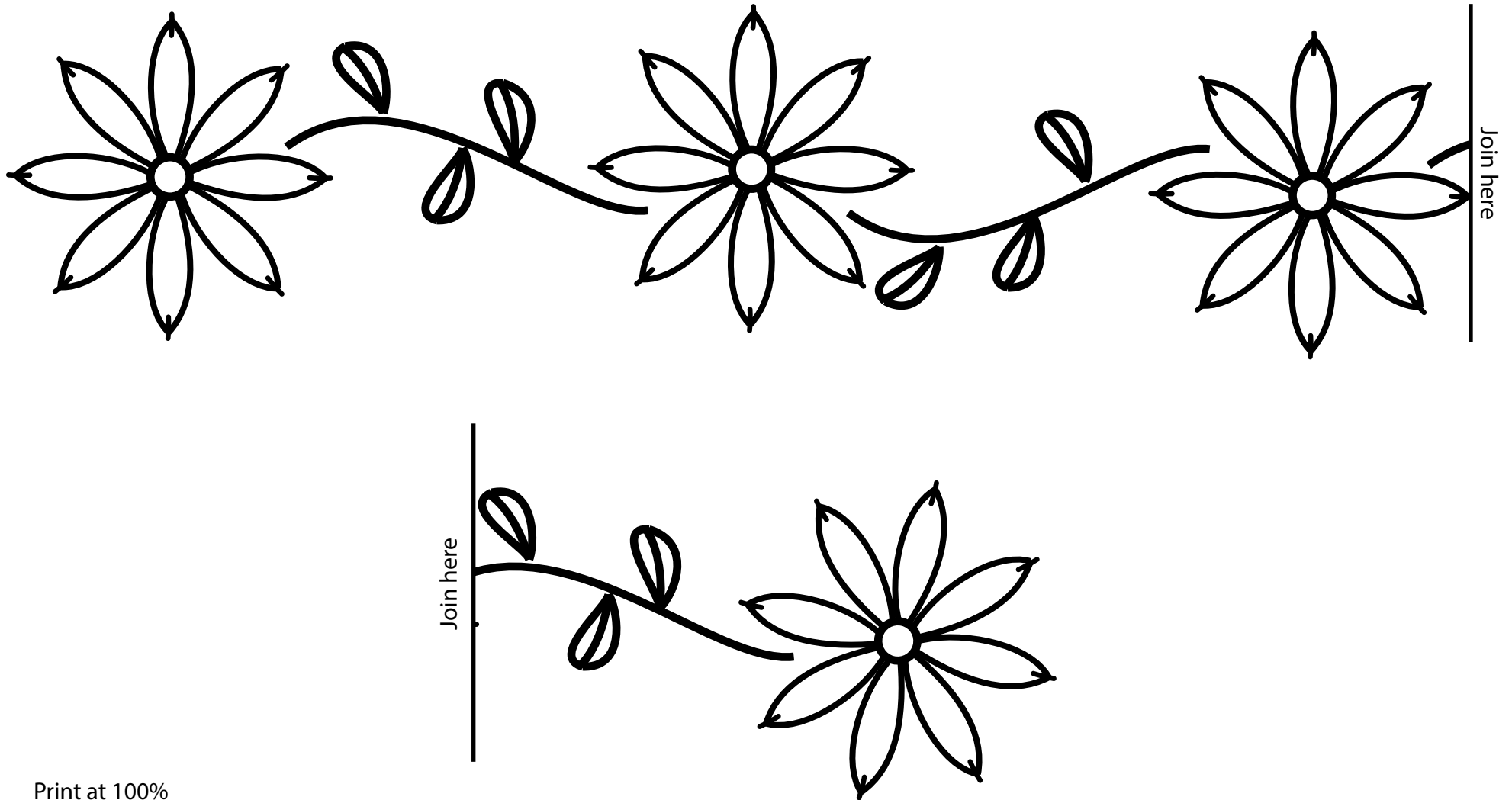

## Optional Fabric Stabilizer:

- Using template, transfer design using a washable fabric pen or printer onto Fabric Stabilizer.
- Peel and stick stabilizer to front of Cardigan – Have fun! You may wish to play around with the placement!
- Once in position, work on top of stabilizer, and through fabric of Cardigan as indicated in embroidery instructions.
- When you have completed embroidery, peel up edges and cut away any excess stabilizer to ease in rinsing it away.
- Place Cardigan in warm water, with warm running water over it.
- Once stabilizer has dissolved, squeeze out excess water and lay flat on a towel to dry.
