## MATERIALS

Patons ${ }^{\circledR}$ Canadiana ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $3.5 \mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{~g} ; 205 \mathrm{yds} / 187 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Main Color (MC) Oatmeal (10022) 4 balls
Contrast A Toasty Gray (10012) 1 ball
Contrast B Flax (10010) 1 ball
Contrast C Timber (10013) 1 ball
Contrast D Pale Gray Mix (10046) 1 ball
Contrast E Dark Gray Mix (10042) 1 ball
Sizes U.S. G/6 ( 4 mm ) and H/8 ( 5 mm ) crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge.

## CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)
Beg $=\operatorname{Begin}($ ning $)$
Ch(s) = Chain(s)
Cont $=$ Continue(ity)
Dc = Double crochet
Hdc = Half double crochet
RS $=$ Right side

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 28" x 34 " [71 x 86 cm ], excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

14 sc and 17 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] with larger hook.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Flying Geese Panel
Note: To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook. Draw loop of next color through 2 loops on hook to complete st and proceed in next color.

With MC and smaller hook, ch 22. 1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 21 sc .
2nd to 4th rows: Ch 1.1 sc in each $s c$ to end of row. Turn.

Sc = Single crochet
$\mathbf{S I} \mathbf{s t}=$ Slip stitch
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

Place Chart as follows:
1 st row: (RS). With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 5 sc . Work 1st row of chart, across next 11 sts, reading row from right to left. With MC, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Chart is shown on page 2.
2nd row: With MC, ch 1.1 sc in each of first 5 sc . Work 2nd row of chart, reading row from left to right. With MC, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Chart is now in position.
Rep 6 rows of chart 16 times more, alternating colors as follows: A, B, C, D, E.
Next 5 rows: (RS). With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. Fasten off at end of last row.

## 三 Patons flying geese crochet blanket Designed by HelloStella | CROCHET

## Body of Blanket

Note: Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc. Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as hdc.

With MC and larger hook, ch 93. 1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc ). 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 91 dc.
2nd to 7th rows: Ch 3.1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.
8th row: Ch 2.1 hdc in each dc to end of row. Turn.
9th row: Ch 2. Working in back loop only, 1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd to 9th rows to form pat.
Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx $28^{\prime \prime}[71 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on a 9th row of pat. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Pin pieces to measurements and cover with damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

With RS facing and larger hook, join MC with sl st to top left corner of Flying Geese Panel. Ch 1. Work 91 sc across side of Panel. Fasten off.

## To join Flying Geese Panel and

 and Body of Blanket: With RS facing of Flying Geese Panel and Body of Blanket, join MC with larger hook with sl st to corner sc. Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses, 1 sc in each sc along side edge of Flying Geese Panel and each rem loop of foundation ch across Body of Blanket. Fasten off.Side edging: With RS facing and larger hook, join MC with sl st to right bottom corner of Blanket.
1st row: (RS). Ch 1. Work 112 sc up right side of Body of Blanket. Turn.
2nd and 3rd rows: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. Fasten off at end of 3rd row. Rep for opposite side edge.
Fringe: Cut 10" [ 25 cm ] lengths of all shades. Taking 3 strands (1 strand MC and 2 contrast strands to match color repeat in Chart design), knot into fringe evenly spaced across top and bottom of Blanket. Trim fringe
