Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Rounds

Sc = Single crochet

SI st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

Trfp2tog = (Yoh) twice. Inserting hook from right to left, draw up a loop around post of next st. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. (Yoh) twice. Inserting hook from right to left, draw up a loop around post of next st. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MATERIALS

Patons® Hempster™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 190 yds/174 m)

White Sand (11013)

1 ball

Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Tapestry needle.

SIZE

Designed to fit a 4'' [10 cm] plant 17 sc and 21 rows = 4'' [10 cm]. pot.

GAUGE



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INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 3 at the beg of rnd counts as dc.

Do not work into top of any st that a post st is worked around unless specifically instructed.

All rnds are joined with a sl st to first st.

Beg using magic loop method, demonstrated here.

1st rnd: Ch 3. 11 dc in ring. Join. 12 dc.

2nd rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in first st. 2 dc in each rem st around. Join. 24 dc. 3rd rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in first st. *2 dc in next st. 1 dc in the next st. Rep from * around. Join. 36 dc.

4th rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in first st. *2 dc in next st. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. Rep from * around. Join. . 48 dc.

5th rnd:. Ch 3. Working in back loops only, 1 dc in first st. 1 dc in each of next 11 sts. *2 dc in the next st. 1 dc in each of next 11 sts. Rep from * around. Join. 52 dc.

6th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 sts. 1 dcfp around next st. *1 sc in each of next 3 sts. 1 dcfp around next st. Rep from * around. Join. 52 sts.

7th rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in each st Hanging Straps (make 2) around. Join.

8th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. Fasten off. Trfp2tog around last and first post Assembly sts of rnd 2 rnds below. *1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Trfp2tog around last post stitch just worked 2 rnds below and next post st 2 rnds below. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 sc in each of last 2 sts. Join.

9th rnd: As 7th rnd.

10th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each ofd first 3 sts. Trfp2tog around each of first 2 post sts of rnd 2 rnds below. *1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Trfp2tog around last post stitch just worked 2 rnds below and next post st 2 rnds below. Rep from *around. Join.

11th rnd: As 7th rnd.

12th to 15th rnds: As 8th to 11th rnds.

16th rnd: Rep 8th rnd.

17th rnd: Ch 3. 1 dcfp around next post st. *1 dc in each of next 3 sts. 1 dcfp around the next st. Rep from * around. 1 dc in each of last 2 sts. Join.

18th rnd: *Ch 3. Sl st in next 13 sts. Rep from * around. Join. Fasten off.

Work a chain 25" [63.5 cm] long.

Cross straps, and tie in middle. Sew ends of each Strap to opposite ch-3 sps of 18th rnd using tapestry needle.
