CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 27" x 72" [68.5 cm x 183 cm].

GAUGE

13 sc and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Motifs (Make 9 each in A, B, and C)

See diagram on page 2.

Ch 6. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

1st rnd: (RS) Ch 3. 15 dc in ring. 16 dc.

2nd rnd: Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc and 1 ch). *1 dc in next dc. Ch 1. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch-4.

3rd rnd: Ch 3. *2 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last ch-1 sp. 2 dc in last ch-1 sp. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. 48 dc.

4th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp. *Ch 5. Skip next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 3. Skip next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from * around, omitting final sc in last rep. Join with sl st to first sc.

MATERIALS

Patons® Lincoln Fog™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 190 yds/174 m)

Contrast A Nest Egg (12014) **3 balls**

Contrast B Lake (12015) **3 balls**

Contrast C Pool (12016) **3 balls**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
6" [15 cm] wide piece of cardboard for tassels. Tapestry needle.

5th rnd: Sl st in next ch-5 sp. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). (4 dc. Ch 3. 5 dc) in same sp. *1 sc in next ch-2 sp. 5 hdc in next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next ch-2 sp.** (5 dc. Ch 3. 5 dc) in next ch-5 sp. Rep from * around, ending last rep at **. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. Fasten off.

6th rnd: Join yarn with sl st to any corner ch-3 sp. Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in same sp. *Ch 5. 1 dc in next sc. Ch 3. Skip next 2 hdc. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 3. Skip next 2 hdc. 1 dc in next sc. Ch 5.** (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * around, ending last rep at **. Join with sl st to first sc.

7th rnd: Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in same sp. *6 dc in next ch-5 sp. (4 dc in next ch-3 sp) twice. 6 dc in next ch-5 sp.** (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * around, ending last rep at **. Join with sl st to top of ch-3.

8th rnd: Ch 1. Work 1 sc in each dc and (2 sc. Ch 2. 2 sc) in each corner ch-2 sp around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew Motifs into 6 strips of 9 as shown in assembly diagram. Sew strips tog.

Border

With RS facing, join C with sl st to any ch-2 corner sp.

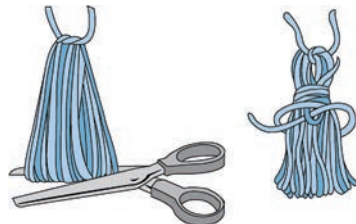
1st rnd: Ch 1. *(1 sc. Ch 2. 1 sc) in ch-2 sp. 1 sc in each st and ch to next ch-2 sp. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each sc to next ch-2 sp. (1 sc. Ch 2. 1 sc) in corner ch-2 sp. Rep from * 3 times more. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join with sl st to first sc.

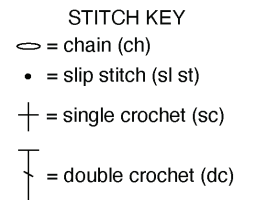
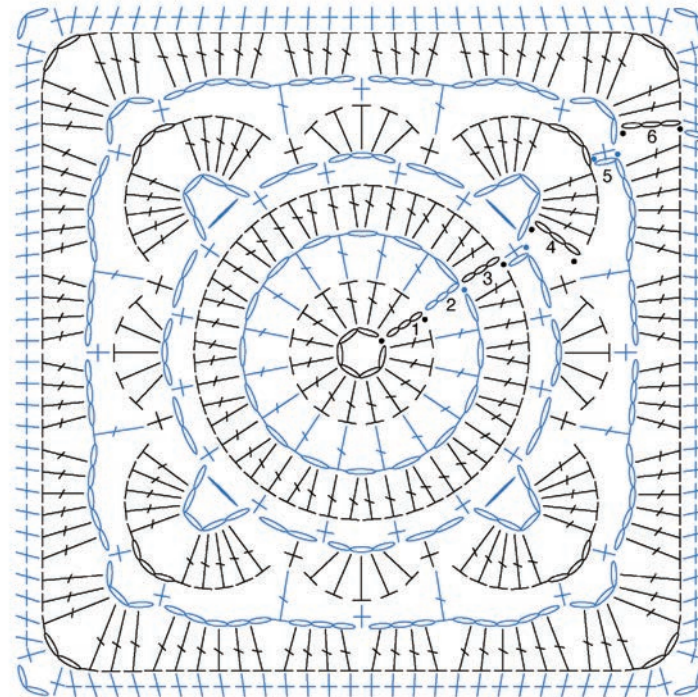
3rd rnd: As 2nd rnd. Fasten off.

Tassels (make 4).

Cut a piece of cardboard 6" [15 cm] wide. Wind C around cardboard 80 times. Break yarn leaving a long end and thread end through needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops 1" [2.5 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim ends evenly. Sew tassels to each corner of shawl.
