### WHAT YOU'LL NEED








### GAUGE

22 stitches (sts) and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.



# YARN

 Patons<sup>®</sup> Classic Wool Worsted<sup>™</sup> (3.5 oz/100 g; 194 yds/177 m)

### COLORS

Quantity

 Pink Quartz (77744) or Dark Gray Mix (00225)

6/12	S/M	L	
1	2	2	ball(s)

### TOOLS

- Sets of four sizes U.S. 5 (3.75 mm) and U.S. 6 (4 mm) Susan Bates<sup>®</sup> double-pointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.
- Susan Bates<sup>®</sup> yarn needle.
- Tape measure.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing) Beg = Beginning Inc = Increasing **Dec(s)** = Decrease(s) K = Knit **K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

**Kfb** = Increase 1 stitch by of next stitch P = Purl **Rem** = Remaining **Rep** = Repeat Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitting into front and back knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together St(s) = Stitch(es) Tog = Together

### INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for 6/12 yrs. *If changes are necessary for larger sizes* the instructions will be written 6/12 (S/M-L). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.


### **RIGHT GLOVE** Make slip knot



### SIZES


To fit: Child 6/12 yrs (Adult S/M-Adult L).



With set of 4 smaller double-pointed needles, cast on 32 (42-48) stitches (sts).



Divide sts onto 3 needles, having 11 (14-16) sts on 1st and 2nd needles and 10 (14-16) sts on 3rd needle.




## **Yarnspirations**<sup>\*\*</sup> ≜ Patons® **MAKE THIS**

### INSTRUCTIONS

Join in round (rnd), placing marker on first st.

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Hold needles so that they form a triangle. Be careful not to twist cast on ridges around the needle (all cast on ridges should lay inside of triangle). With working yarn at front of work, using last (4th) needle, slip first stitch purlwise. Bring working yarn between needles to back of work. Slip stitch back onto first needle. Place a slipping marker around first stitch to indicate beginning of round.

**Dec(s)** = Decrease(s)

Beg = Beginning


Inc = Increasing

**K2tog** = Knit next

2 stitches together

K = Knit

1st rnd: \*K1. P1. Rep from \* around.



Rep last rnd of (K1. P1.) ribbing for 3 (4-4)" [7.5 (10-10) cm].

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### INSTRUCTIONS

Change to larger set of 4 needles and knit 5 (7-7) rnds.\*\*

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## Shape right thumb gusset:

1st rnd: K17 (22-25). Kfb in each of next 2 sts. Knit to end of rnd.



**Kfb:** Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit. 3rd rnd: K17 (22-25). Kfb. K2. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 5th rnd: K17 (22-25). Kfb. K4. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 7th rnd: K17 (22-25). Kfb. K6. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 9th rnd: K17 (22-25). Kfb. K8. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 42 (52-58) sts.



Sizes S/M and L only: 10th rnd: Knit. 11th rnd: K(22-25). Kfb. K10. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. (54-60) sts.

### All sizes:

Next rnd: Knit. Next rnd: K29 (36-39). Slip last 12 (14-14) sts onto length of yarn (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd.

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### INSTRUCTIONS

\*\*\*Next rnd: Knit to end of rnd, casting on 2 sts over slipped sts. 32 (42-48) sts.

Knit in rnds until work after ribbing measures 3¾ (4-4¾)" [9.5 (10-12) cm].

To make 1st finger: Knit first 10 (14-16) sts. Slip these sts onto a length of yarn. K10 (14-16). <u>Cast on</u> 2 sts. Divide these 14 (16-18) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit to end of rnd. Knit in rnds until finger measures 1¾ (2½-2¾)" [4.5 (6-7) cm].

Shape top: Next rnd: (K2tog) 7 (8-9) times. 7 (8-9) sts.

Sizes S/M and L only: Next rnd: Knit. Next rnd: (K2tog) 4 times. K(0-1). (4-5) sts.

All sizes: Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread end through remaining (rem) 7 (4-5) sts. Draw up and fasten securely.

To make 2nd finger: Slip next 3 (5-6) sts from length of yarn. Turn. Cast on 2 sts. Turn. Knit last **3** (5-6) sts. Pick up and knit 2 sts at base of first finger. Divide these 10 (14-16) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit to end of rnd. Knit in rnds until 2nd finger measures 2 (2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>-3)" [5 (7-7.5) cm].

ABBREVIATIONS


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K2tog: Knit next 2 stitches together.

INSTRUCTIONS

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knitting into front and back knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together St(s) = Stitch(es) Tog = Together

Shape top: Next rnd: (K2tog) 5 (7-8) times. 5 (7-8) sts.

Sizes S/M and L only: Next rnd: Knit. Next rnd: (K2tog) (3-4) times. K(1-0). 4 sts.

All sizes: Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem 5 (4-4) sts. Draw up and fasten securely.

To make 3rd finger: Slip next 3 (5-6) sts from length of yarn. Turn. Cast on 2 sts. Turn. Knit last 3 (5-6) sts. Pick up and knit 2 sts at base of second finger. Divide these 10 (14-16) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit to end of rnd.

Knit in rnds until 3rd finger measures 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> (2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>)" [**4.5** (6-7) cm].

Shape top: Next rnd: (K2tog) 5 (7-8) times. 5 (7-8) sts.

Sizes S/M and L only: Next rnd: Knit. Next rnd: (K2tog) (3-4) times. K(1-0). 4 sts.

All sizes: Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem 5 (4-4) sts. Draw up and fasten securely.

To make 4th finger: Slip last 8 sts from thread. Pick up and knit 2 (3-3) sts at base of third finger. Divide these 10 (11-11) sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit to end of rnd. Knit in rnds until 4th finger measures 1¼ (2-2¼)" [3 (5-5.5) cm].

Shape top: Next rnd: (K2tog) 5 times. K0 (1-1). 5 (6-6) sts. Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem 5 (6-6) sts. Draw up and fasten securely.







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### INSTRUCTIONS

**Thumb:** Join yarn to base of thumb, pick up and knit 2 sts. K12 (14-14) from length of yarn. Divide these 14 (16-16) sts onto 3 needles.

Knit in rnds until work from pick up rnd measures 11/2 (21/4-21/2)" [**4** (**5.5-6**) cm].



Sizes S/M and L only: Next rnd: (K2. K2tog) 4 times. 12 sts.

### All sizes:

Next rnd: (K1. K2tog) 4 times. (K2tog) 1 (0-0) time. 9 (8-8) sts. Next rnd: (K2tog) 4 times. K1 (0-0). 5 (4-4) sts.

Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem 5 (4-4) sts. Draw up and fasten securely.\*\*\*

### LEFT GLOVE

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Right Glove, ending before Shape thumb gusset.

Shape left thumb gusset: 1st rnd: K13 (18-21). Kfb in each of next 2 sts. Knit to end of rnd. 2nd and alt rnds: Knit. **3rd rnd:** K13 (18-21). Kfb. K2. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 5th rnd: K13 (18-21). Kfb. K4. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 7th rnd: K13 (18-21). Kfb. K6. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 9th rnd: K13 (18-21). Kfb. K8. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 42 (52-58) sts.

Sizes S/M and L only: 11th rnd: K(18-21). Kfb. K10. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. (54-60) sts.

All sizes: Next rnd: Knit. Next rnd: K25 (32-35). Slip last 12 (14-14) sts onto length of yarn (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd.
