MATERIALS

Patons[®] Classic Wool Worsted[™] (3.5 oz/100 g; 210 yds/192 m) Cognac Heather (77532) 2 balls

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

Alt = Alternate(ing) **Approx** = Approximately **C2F** = Knit into front loop of 2nd stitch on left-hand needle, then knit 1st stitch, slipping both stitches off needle together

C2L = Purl through back loop of 2nd stitch on lefthand needle (behind first stitch), then knit first stitch,

slipping both stitches off needle together **C2R** = Knit into front loop of 2nd stitch on left-hand needle, then purl first stitch, slipping both stitches off needle together **Cont** = Continue(ity) K = Knit

K2toq = Knit next 2 stitches together $\mathbf{P} = Purl$ **P2tog** = Purl next 2 stitches together Pat = Pattern **Rem** = Remaining **Rep** = Repeat **RS** = Right side St(s) = Stitch(es) WS = Wrong side

SIZE

One size to fit average woman's head.

GAUGE

stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 114 sts. **1st row:** (RS). K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to 4 sts. P2. K1. P1. end of row. 2nd row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end

of row.

3rd row: K1. *C2L. C2R. Rep from * to last st. K1.

4th row: P1. K1. *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 10th row: As 2nd row. 4 sts. P2. K1. P1.

5th row: K1. P1. *C2F. P2. Rep from * to These 12 rows form pat. last 4 sts. C2F. P1. K1.

6th row: As 4th row.

7th row: K1. *C2R. C2L. Rep from * to last with 10th row of pat. st. K1.

8th row: As 2nd row. Rep these 8 rows once more. Next row: (Fold ridge). Purl.

Proceed as follows, reversing rows from RS to WS as follows: **1st row:** (RS). K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row. 2nd row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row. 18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in **3rd and 4th rows:** As 1st and 2nd rows once more. 5th row: K1. *C2L. C2R. Rep from * to last st. K1. 6th row: P1. K1. *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 7th row: K1. P1. *C2F. P2. Rep from * to last 4 sts. C2F. P1. K1. 8th row: As 6th row. **9th row:** K1. *C2R. C2L. Rep from * to last st. K1. 11th and 12th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows. Cont in pat until work from **fold ridge** measures approx 5¹/₂" [14 cm], ending

> Shape top: 1st row: (RS). K2. P2. K2. *P2tog. K2. (P2. K2) twice. Rep from * to end of row, 105 sts.

> 2nd and alt rows: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear.



ATTICE TWIST HAT | KNIT

3rd row: K2. P2. K2. *P1. K2. P2tog. K2. P2.
K2. Rep from * to end of row. 96 sts.
5th row: K2. P2tog. K2. *(P1. K2) twice.
P2tog. K2. Rep from * to end of row. 86 sts.
7th row: K2. P1. K2. *P1. K2tog. (P1. K2)
twice. Rep from * to end of row. 77 sts.
9th row: K2. P1. K2tog. *P1. K1. P1. K2tog.
P1. K2. Rep from * to end of row. 67 sts.
11th row: K2tog. P1. K1. *(P1. K1) twice.
P1. K2tog. Rep from * to end of row. 57 sts.
13th row: K1. *K2tog. Rep from * to end of row. 29 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end through rem sts. Pull tightly. Fasten securely. Sew center back seam, reversing seam for cuff turnback.

Pompom: Wind yarn around 4 fingers 60 times. Tie tightly in the middle and leave a long end for attaching to top of Hat. Cut loops at both ends and trim to form pompom. Sew to top of Hat.
