



## MATERIALS

**Patons® Shetland Chunky™** (100 g/3.5 oz; 136 m/148 yds)

Aran (78008)

**1 ball**

**Bernat® Faux Fur Pompom™** Aubergine (01323)

Sizes U.S. 9 (5.5 mm) and U.S. 10 (6 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Cable needle.

**Alt** = Alternate(ing)

**Beg** = Beginning

**C8B** = Slip next 4 stitches

onto cable needle and

leave at back of work. K4,

then K4 from cable needle

**C8F** = Slip next 4 stitches

onto cable needle and

leave at front of work. K4,

then K4 from cable needle

**K** = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2

stitches together

**M1** = Make 1 stitch by pick-

ing up horizontal loop ly-

ing before next stitch and

knitting into back of loop



**RS** = Right side

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rem** = Remaining

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side



INTERMEDIATE

## SIZE

One size to fit average woman.

## GAUGE

15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

With smaller needles, cast on 73 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**2nd row:** \*P1. K1. Rep from \* to last st. P1.

Rep last 2 rows (K1. P1) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending with a 2nd row.

Change to larger needles.

**1st row:** (RS). K3. \*M1. K2. M1. K3. Rep from \* to end of row. 101 sts.

**2nd and alt rows:** Purl.

**3rd row:** K5. \*C8F. K4. Rep from \* to end of row.

**4th to 10th rows:** Beg with a purl row, work 7 rows in stocking st.

**11th row:** (RS). K1. \*C8B. K4. Rep from \* to last 4 sts. K4.

**13th row:** Knit.

**15th and 17th rows:** knit.

**19th to 27th rows:** Rep 3rd to 11th rows once more.

**28th row:** Purl.

**Shape top: 1st row:** (RS). K1. \*K2tog. K3. Rep from \* to end of row. 81 sts.

**2nd and alt rows:** Purl.

**3rd row:** K1. \*K2tog. K2. Rep from \* to end of row. 61 sts.

**5th row:** K1. \*K2tog. K1. Rep from \* to end of row. 41 sts.

**7th row:** K1. \*K2tog. Rep from \* to end of row. 21 sts. Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread yarn through rem sts and fasten securely. Sew back seam.

Sew Pompom to top of Hat.
