KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Begin(ning) **K** = Knit **K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$ **Rem** = Remain(ing)(s) **Rep** = Repeat Rnd(s) = Round(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es) **Tog** = Together

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

13 sts and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

HAT

With smaller set of needles and A, cast on 68 sts. Divide sts on 3 needles (24 sts on first 2 needles and 20 sts on 3rd needle). Join in rnd, placing marker on first st. 1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd (K2. P2) ribbing for 2" [5 cm].

Change to larger set of needles and knit next rnd. See Chart on page 2. First rnd of Chart is complete. Knit Chart to end of chart, *reading rnds* from **right** to **left** and noting 2-st rep will be worked 34 times.

Shape top: 1st rnd: With D, *K15. K2tog. Rep from * around. 64 sts. 2nd rnd: *K6. K2tog. Rep from * around. 56 sts.

3rd rnd: *K5. K2tog. Rep from * around. 48 sts.
4th rnd: *K4. K2tog. Rep from * around. 40 sts.
5th rnd: *K3. K2tog. Rep from * around. 32 sts.
6th rnd: *K2. K2tog. Rep from * around. 24 sts.
7th rnd: *K1. K2tog. Rep from * around. 16 sts.
8th rnd: (K2tog) 8 times. 8 sts.
Break yarn leaving a long end.
Draw end tightly through rem sts

Pompom: With 1 strand each of A, B, C, and D held tog, wind yarn around 4 fingers 30 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape. Sew to top of Hat.
