## ABBREVIATIONS

**Beg** = Begin(ning)  
**K** = Knit  
**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

**P** = Purl  
**Rem** = Remain(ing)(s)  
**Rep** = Repeat  
**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)  
**Tog** = Together

## SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

Rep last rnd (K2. P2) ribbing for 2" [5 cm].

## GAUGE

13 sts and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

Change to larger set of needles and knit next rnd.

See Chart on page 2.

First rnd of Chart is complete. Knit Chart to end of chart, *reading rnds from right to left* and noting 2-st rep will be worked 34 times.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### HAT

With smaller set of needles and A, cast on 68 sts. Divide sts on 3 needles (24 sts on first 2 needles and 20 sts on 3rd needle). Join in rnd, placing marker on first st.

**1st rnd:** \*K2. P2. Rep from \* around.

**Shape top: 1st rnd:** With D, \*K15. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 64 sts.

**2nd rnd:** \*K6. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 56 sts.

## MATERIALS

**Patons® Classic Wool Roving™** (100 g/3.5 oz; 109 m/120 yds)

**Contrast A** Pacific Teal (77203) **1 ball or 55 m/50.5 yds**

**Contrast B** Low Tide (77219) **1 ball or 22 m/20 yds**

**Contrast C** Yellow (77615) **1 ball or 22 m/20 yds**

**Contrast D** Aran (77008) **1 ball or 40 m/36.5 yds**

Set of 4 sizes 10 (6 mm) and U.S. 10½ (6.5 mm) Susan Bates® double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® stitch markers. Susan Bates® yarn needle..

**3rd rnd:** \*K5. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 48 sts.

**4th rnd:** \*K4. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 40 sts.

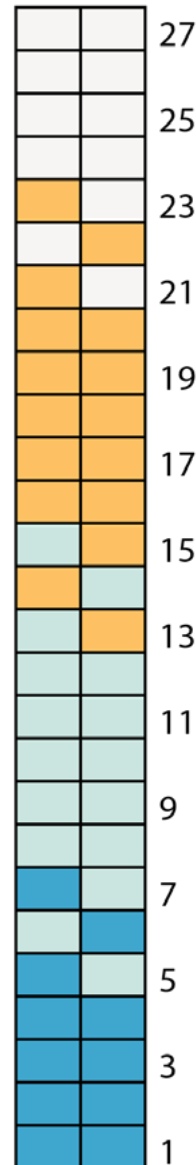
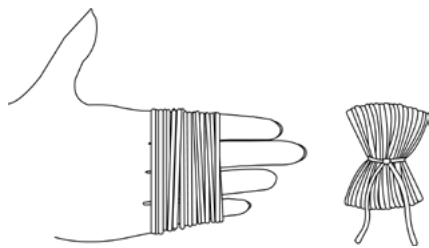
**5th rnd:** \*K3. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 32 sts.





**6th rnd:** \*K2. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 24 sts.

**7th rnd:** \*K1. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 16 sts.

**8th rnd:** (K2tog) 8 times. 8 sts.  
Break yarn leaving a long end.  
Draw end tightly through rem sts  
and fasten securely.

**Pompom:** With 1 strand each of A, B, C, and D held tog, wind yarn around 4 fingers 30 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape. Sew to top of Hat.
