Size U.S. 7 [4.5 mm] Susan Bates[®] Silvalume[®] circular knitting needle 16" [40.5 cm] long. Set of 4 size U.S. 7 [4.5 mm] Susan Bates[®] doublepointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates[®] yarn needle. Susan Bates[®] stitch marker.

ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternat(e)(ing) Approx = Approximately **Beg** = Beginning **BrDecL**= Brioche left decrease. (See photos on page 3). **BrDecR** = Brioche right decrease. (See photos on page 4). **BrK1** = Brioche knit stitch. Knit the next stitch together with accompanying yarn over. (See photos on page 5).

BrP1 = Brioche purl stitch. Purl the next stitch together with accompanying yarn over. (See photos on page 5). K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together Pat = Pattern P = Purl Rem = Remain(ing) Rep = Repeat Rnd(s) = Round(s) RS = Right side **Sl1yo** = Slip next stitch purl-wise with varn in front of work, bringing yarn over needle (and over slipped st) to back of work. Yarn is in place to work a knit stitch. If SI1yo precedes a purl stitch, bring yarn under needle to front of work to maintain yo before working purl stitch. GAUGE

17 sts and 40 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Brioche Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

With A and circular needle, cast on 80 sts. Place a st marker on needle after last st cast on. Join in rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Set Up (see chart shown right). Set-up rnd 1: With A, *P1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around. Set-up rnd 2: With B, *Sl1yo. BrK1. Rep from * around.

Brim

1st rnd: With A, *BrP1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around. **2nd rnd:** With B, *Sl1yo. BrK1. Rep from * around. Rep last 2 rnds until Brim measures 2½" [6.5 cm], ending after a 2nd rnd.

Main Brioche Pat


1st rnd: With A, *BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around. **2nd rnd:** With B, *Sl1yo. BrP1. Rep from * around.

Rep last 2 rnds for Main Brioche Pat until work from beg measures approx. 10" [25.5 cm], ending after a 2nd rnd. Shape Crown

Note: Change to double-pointed needles as necessary.

1st rnd: With A, [BrDecL. Sl1yo. (BrK1. Sl1yo) 6 times. BrDecR. Sl1yo] 4 times. 64 sts. 2nd and alt rnds: With B, *Sl1yo. BrP1. Rep from * around. 3rd rnd: With A, *BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around. 5th rnd: With A, [BrDecL. Sl1vo. (BrK1. Sl1yo) 4 times. BrDecR. Sl1yo] 4 times. 48 sts. 7th rnd: As 3rd rnd. 9th rnd: With A, [BrDecL. Sl1yo. (BrK1. Sl1yo) twice. BrDecR. Sl1yo] 4 times. 32 sts. 11th rnd: As 3rd rnd. 13th rnd: With A, (BrDecL. Sl1yo. BrDecR. Sl1yo) 4 times. 16 sts. 15th rnd: As 3rd rnd. 17th rnd: With A, *BrDecL. Sl1yo. Rep from * around. 8 sts.

Break yarn leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten securely





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BRIOCHE LEFT DECREASE


BrDecL = Worked over 3 stitches (**A**, **B**, **C**).




4) 2 stitches decreased.

3) Pass both strands of slipped stitch (**A**) over.




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
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BRIOCHE RIGHT DECREASE

BrDecR = Worked over 3 stitches (**A**, **B**, **C**).




1) Slip next stitch (A) knit-wise with yarn at back of work (Sl1yo).




5) ... and move stitch to left-hand needle.







4a) Pass slipped stitch (A) over stitch just knit (**B**)...

6) Pass second stitch on left-hand needle (C) over first stitch (B).








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BrK1 = Knit next stitch together with accompanying yarn over.
