MATERIALS

Patons® Alpaca Blend™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 155 yds/142 m)

Butternut (01023)

2 balls

Size U.S. $10\frac{1}{2}$ (6.5 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Cont = Continue

 $\mathbf{K} = Knit$

 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sl1Kwyib = Slip next stitch

knitwise with yarn in back of work

Sl1Pwyif = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in front of

work

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

6½" x 82" [16.5 x 208 cm]

GAUGE

15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 28 sts.

1st row (RS): Sl1Kwyib. Knit to end of row.

2nd row (WS): Sl1Pwyif. P2. *K2. P3. Rep from * to end of row.

P3. Rep from * to end of row. These 2 rows form pat. Cont in pat until scarf measures 82" [208 cm] when gently stretched, ending on a WS row.

Bind off in pat. Weave in ends and block to dimensions.



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Tassels (make 4)

Wrap yarn around 6" [15 cm] piece of cardboard 15 times. Tie securely at one end. Cut across opposite end. Wrap yarn twice around Tassel 1" [2.5 cm] from tied end. Fasten securely. Trim Tassel to approx 4" [10 cm]. Attach Tassel to each corner of scarf.
