Contrast A Blush (85416)
7 balls
Contrast B Stone (85046) 7 balls
Size U.S. 4 ( 3.5 mm ) circular knitting needle 36" [ 91.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Cable needle.

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## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 24 " x 60" [61 x 152.5 cm ]

## GAUGE

19 sts and 48 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: The wrap (yarn over) created by Sl1yo does not count as a separate stitch and should be treated as one stitch along with slipped stitch it accompanies.

## 三 Patons allan GARDENS KNIT BRIOCHE SHAWL

(With A, cast on 1 st. With B, cast on 1 st) 56 times. With $A$, cast on 1 st. 113 sts. Do not join. Work back and forth across needle as follows (see Chart on page 2):
1st row: *With A, K1. Sl1yo. Rep from * to last st. K1. Do not turn. Slide sts to other end of needle.
2nd row: *With B, SI1yo. BrP1. Rep from * to last st. SI1yo. Turn.
3rd row: *With A, BrP1. Sl1yo. Rep from * to last st. BrP1. Do not turn. Slide sts to other end of needle.
4th row: *With B, SI1yo. BrK1. Rep from * to last st. SI1yo. Turn.
5th row: *With A, (BrK1. SI1yo) twice. BrDecR. SI1yo. [(BrK1. yo) twice. BrK1] all in next st. Sl1yo. BrDecL. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * to last st. BrK1. Do not turn. Slide sts to other end of needle.
6th row: *With B, (Sl1yo. BrP1) 3 times. (Sl1yo. P1) twice. (Sl1yo. BrP1) 3 times. Rep from * to last st. Sl1yo. Turn.
7th and 8th rows: As 3rd and 4th rows.
9th row: *With A, BrK1. Sl1yo. BrDecR. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. [(Brk1. yo) twice. Brk1] all in next st. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. BrDecL. Sl1yo. Rep from * to last st. BrK1. Do not turn. Slide sts to other end of needle.

10th to 12th rows: As 6th to 8th rows.
13th row: *With A, BrK1. SI1yo. Rep from * to last st. BrK1. Do not turn. Slide sts to other end of needle.
14th to 17th rows: As 2nd to 5th rows.
18th row: *With B, Sl1yo. BrP1. Sl1yo. BrPDecR. Sl1yo. (P1. Sl1yo) twice. BrPDecR. Sl1yo. BrP1. Rep from * to last st. Sl1yo. Turn. 85 sts. 19th row: As 3rd row.
20th row: *With B, Sl1yo. (BrK1. yo. BrK1) all in next st. (Sl1yo. BrK1) 4 times. Sl1yo. (BrK1. yo. BrK1) all in next st. Rep from * to last st. Sl1yo. Turn. 113 sts.
21st row: *With A, BrK1. SI1yo. K1. (Sl1yo. BrK1) 5 times. Sl1yo. K1. Sl1yo. Rep from * to last st. BrK1.
Do not turn. Slide sts to other end of needle.
22nd to 24th rows: As 2nd to 4th rows.
25th row: *With A, (BrK1. SI1yo) twice. BrDecL. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. BrDecR. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * to last st. BrK1. Do not turn. Slide sts to other end of needle. 85 sts.
26th to 28th row: As 2nd to 4th rows.
29th row: *With A, BrK1. SI1yo. (BrK1. yo. BrK1) all in next st. Sl1yo.

BrDbIDec. Sl1yo. (BrK1. yo. BrK1) all in next st. Sl1yo. Rep from * to last st. BrK1. Do not turn. Slide sts to other end of needle.
30th row: *With B, Sl1yo. BrP1. Sl1yo. P1. (Sl1yo. BrP1) twice. Sl1yo. P1. Sl1yo. BrP1. Rep from * to last st. Sllyo. Turn.
31st row: As 3rd row.
32nd row: *With B, SI1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. (BrK1. yo. BrK1) all in next st. (SI1yo. BrK1) twice. Sl1yo. (BrK1. yo. BrK1) all in next st. Sl1yo. BrK1. Rep from * to last st. Sllyo. Turn.
33rd row: *With A, (BrK1. SI1yo) twice. K1. (Sl1yo. BrK1) 3 times. Sl1yo. K1. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * to last st. BrK1. Do not turn. Slide sts to other end of needle. 113 sts.
34th to 36th rows: As 2nd to 4th rows.
37th row: As 13th row.
Rep 2nd to 37th rows for pat.
Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 60 " $[152.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on a 36th row of pat.
Cast off row: With A, BrK1. K1. Pass 1st st over next st. BrK1. *Pass 1st st over next st. K1. Pass 1st st over next st. BrK1. Rep from * to last st. Fasten off.

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## 三 Patons" allan gardens knit brioche shawL

Sl1yo = Slip next stitch purl-wise with yarn in front of work, bringing yarn over needle (and over slipped stitch) to back of work. Yarn is in place to work a BrK1 stitch. If SI1yo precedes a BrP1 stitch, bring yarn under needle to front of work to maintain yo before working BrP1 stitch.


Sl1yo before BrP1


BrK1 = Knit next stitch together with accompanying yarn over.


BrP1 = Purl next stitch together with accompanying yarn over.

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## 三 Patons allan gardens knit brioche shawl

## BRIOCHE LEFT DECREASE

BrDecL = Worked over 3 stitches
(A, B, C).

4) 2 stitches decreased.


1) Slip next stitch (A) knit-wise with yarn at back of work (Sl1yo).

2) BrK2tog (B,C) through all strands.

3) Pass both strands of slipped stitch (A) over.

## BRIOCHE RIGHT DECREASE

BrDecR = Worked over 3 stitches (A, B, C).


4b) ...


1) Slip next stitch (A) knit-wise with yarn at back of work (SI1yo).

2) ... and move stitch to left-hand needle.

3) Knit next stitch (B).

4) Pass second stitch on left-hand needle (C) over first stitch (B).


4a) Pass slipped stitch (A) over stitch just knit (B)...

7) Move stitch to right-hand needle. 2 stitches decreased.

BRIOCHE DOUBLE DECREASE

BrDbIDec $=[$ Worked over
5 stitches (A, B, C, D, E)].


4a) Pass 2 slipped stitches (A and B) over just-knit stitch (D)...


1) Slip next 2 stitches (A and B) knit-wise one at a time with yarn at back of work.

2) Slip next stitch (C) to cable needle and leave at front of work.

5) ... and move stitch to left-hand needle.

3) Knit next stitch (D).


6a) Pass second stitch on left-hand needle (E) over first stitch (D)...

7) ... and move stitch to right-hand needle.

8) Slip stitch from cable needle (C) to left-hand needle.

9) Slip last-worked stitch (D) from right-hand needle to left-hand needle.

10) Pass second stitch on left-hand needle (C) over first stitch (D).


Move stitch to right-hand needle. 4 stitches decreased.

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## BRIOCHE PURLED RIGHT DECREASE

BrPDecR = Worked over 3 stitches (A, B, C).

1a) BrP2tog (A and $\mathbf{B}$ ) through all
