Cr4B = Slip next stitch onto cable needle and leave at back of work. $K 3$, then P1 from cable needle. Cr4F = Slip next 3 stitches onto cable needle and leave at front of work. P1, then K3 from cable needle.
Cr7F = Slip next 4 stitches onto cable needle and leave at front of work. K3. Slip purl st from cable needle and purl it, then knit rem 3 sts from cable needle.
Cont = Continue(ity)
Dec = Decrease(ing)
Inc = Increase(ing)

## GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st with larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for XS/S. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written XS/S (M-L-XL-2/3XL-4/5XL). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

PANEL PAT A (worked over 9 sts. See chart on page 6).
1st row: (RS). K9.
2nd and alt rows: P9.
3rd row: C6B. K3.
5th row: K9.
7th row: K3. C6F.
8th row: P9.
These 8 rows form Panel Pat A.

PANEL PAT B (worked over 23 sts. See chart on page 6).
1 st row: (RS). P2. Cr4F. (P1. K1) 5 times. P1. Cr4B. P2.
2nd and alt rows: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear. 3rd row: P3. Cr4F. (P1. K1) 4 times. P1. Cr4B. P3.
5th row: P4. Cr4F. (P1. K1) 3 times. P1. Cr4B. P4.
7th row: P5. Cr4F. (P1. K1) twice. P1. Cr4B. P5.
9th row: P6. Cr4F. P1. K1. P1. Cr4B. P6.
11th row: P7. Cr4F. P1. Cr4B. P7.
13th row: P8. Cr7F. P8.
15th row: P7. Cr4B. K1. Cr4F. P7.
17th row: P6. Cr4B. K1. P1. K1. Cr4F. P6.
19th row: P5. Cr4B. (K1. P1) twice. K1. Cr4F. P5.
21st row: P4. Cr4B. (K1. P1) 3 times. K1. Cr4F. P4.
23rd row: P3. Cr4B. (K1. P1) 4 times. K1. Cr4F. P3.
25th row: P2. Cr4B. (K1. P1) 5 times. K1. Cr4F. P2.
26th row: As 2nd row.
These 26 rows form Panel Pat B.

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Note: Work all pieces back and forth in rows on circular needles.

## BACK

With smaller needle, cast on 94 (98-106-114-130-142) sts.
1st row: (RS). K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for $11 / 2$ " 4 cm ], ending on a RS row.
Inc row: (WS). *Rib across 6 (7-7-6-9-7) sts. M1. Rep from * 12 (12-12-16-12-16) times more. Rib to end of row. 107 (111-119-131-143159) sts.

Change to larger needle and proceed in pat as follows:
1st row: (RS). K1. (P1. K1) 6 (7-9-12-15-19) times. P2. Work 1st row Panel Pat A. P2. (K3. Work 1st row Panel Pat B) twice. K3. P2. Work 1st row Panel Pat A. P2. (K1. P1) 6 (7-9-12-15-19) times. K1.
2nd row: P1. (K1. P1) 6 (7-9-12-15-
19) times. K2. Work 2nd row Panel Pat A. K2. (P3. Work 2nd row Panel Pat B) twice. P3. K2. Work 2nd row Panel Pat A. K2. (P1. K1) 6 (7-9-12-15-19) times. P1.

3rd row: P1. (K1. P1) 6 (7-9-12 15-19) times. P2. Work 3rd row Panel Pat A. P2. (Wrap 3. Work 3rd row Panel Pat B) twice. Wrap 3. P2. Work 3rd row Panel Pat A. P2. (P1. K1) 6 (7-9-12-15-19) times. P1.
4th row: K1. (P1. K1) 6 (7-9-12-1519) times. K2. Work 4th row Panel Pat A. K2. (P3. Work 4th row Panel Pat B) twice. P3. K2. Work 4th row Panel Pat A. K2. (K1. P1) 6 (7-9-12-15-19) times. K1.
These 4 rows form Irish Moss St pat at sides and Wrap St pat.
Panel Pats $A$ and $B$ are now in position.

Cont in pat, keeping cont of panel pats, until work from beg measures $121 / 2\left(13-13^{1 / 2}-13^{11 / 2-141 / 2-15}\right)$ " [32 (33-34.5-34.5-37-38) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape armholes: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 7 (8-9-8-9-12) sts beg next 2 (2-2-4-4-4) rows. 93 (95-101-99-107-111) sts.
Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and following alt rows until there are 81 (81-85-85-89-89) sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures $71 ⁄ 2(8-81 / 2-9-91 / 2-10)$ " [19 (20.5-21.5-23-24-25.5) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulders: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 9 (9-10-10-10-10) sts at beg of next 4 rows. Leave rem 45 (45-45-45-49-49) sts on a st holder.

## LEFT FRONT

With smaller needle cast on 47 (51-55-59-63-71) sts.
1st row: (RS). *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.
2nd row: P3. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for $11 / 2$ " 4 cm ], ending on a RS row.
Inc row: (WS). *Rib across 6 (10-11-8-7-7) sts. M1. Rep from * 5 (3-3-5-7-7) times more. Rib to end of row. 53 (55-59-65-71-79) sts.

Change to larger needle and proceed in pat as follows:
1st row: (RS). K1. (P1. K1) 6 (7-9-12-15-19) times. P2. Work 1st row Panel Pat A. P2. K3. Work 1st row Panel Pat B. P1.

2nd row: K1. Work 2nd row Panel Pat B. P3. K2. Work 2nd row Panel Pat A. K2. (P1. K1) 6 (7-9-12-15-19) times. P1.
3rd row: P1. (K1. P1) 6 (7-9-12-1519) times. P2. Work 3rd row Panel Pat A. P2. Wrap 3. Work 3rd row Panel Pat B. P1.
4th row: K1. Work 4th row Panel Pat B. P3. K2. Work 4th row Panel Pat A. K2. (K1. P1) 6 (7-9-12-15-19) times. K1.
These 4 rows form Irish Moss St pat at side and Wrap St pat. Panel Pats $A$ and $B$ are now in position.

Cont in pat, keeping cont of panel pats, until work from beg measures $121 / 2\left(13-131 / 2-131 / 2-14 \frac{1}{2}-15\right)$ " [32 (33-34.5-34.5-37-38) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape armhole: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 7 (8-9-8-9-12) sts beg next row. 46 (47-50-57-62-67) sts. Work 1 row even in pat.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Keeping cont of pat, cast off (8-912) sts beg next row. (49-53-55) sts. Work 1 row even in pat.

All Sizes: Shape front and armhole: Next row: K2tog (armhole edge). Pat to last 2 sts. K2tog (front edge).
Next row: Work even in pat.
Rep last 2 rows 5 (6-7-6-8-10) times more. 34 (33-34-35-35-33) sts.
Dec 1 st at front edge only on following alt rows until there are 18 (18-20-20-20-20) sts.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulder: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 9 (9-10-10-10-10) sts beg next row. Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off rem 9 (9-10-10-1010) sts.

## RIGHT FRONT

With smaller needles cast on 47 (51-55-59-63-71) sts.
1st row: (RS). K3. *P2. K2. Rep from

* to end of row.

2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 3 sts. P3.
Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for $11 / 2$ " 4 cm ], ending on a RS row.

Inc row: (WS). *Rib across 6 (10-11-8-7-7) sts. M1. Rep from * 5 (3-3-5-7-7) times more. Rib to end of row. 53 (55-59-65-71-79) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows:
1st row: (RS). P1. Work 1st row Panel Pat B. K3. P2. Work 1st row Panel Pat A. P2. (K1. P1) 6 (7-9-12-15-19) times. K1.
2nd row: P1. (K1. P1) 6 (7-9-12-1519) times. K2. Work 2nd row Panel Pat A. K2. P3. Work 2nd row Pane Pat B. K1.
3rd row: P1. Work 3rd row Panel Pat B. Wrap 3. P2. Work 3rd row Panel Pat A. P2. (P1. K1) 6 (7-9-12-15-19) times. P1.
4th row: K1. (P1. K1) 6 (7-9-12-1519) times. K2. Work 4th row Panel Pat A. K2. P3. Work 4th row Panel Pat B. K1.
These 4 rows form Irish Moss St pat at side and Wrap St pat. Panel Pats $A$ and $B$ are now in position.

Cont in pat, keeping cont of panel pats, until work from beg measures $121 / 2(13-131 / 2-131 / 2-141 / 2-15)$ " [32 (33-34.5-34.5-37-38) cm], ending on a RS row.

Shape armhole: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 7 (8-9-8-9-12) sts beg next row. 46 (47-50-57-62-67) sts.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Work 1 row even in pat.
Keeping cont of pat, cast off (8-912) sts beg next row. (49-53-55) sts.

All Sizes: Shape front and armhole: Next row: K2tog (front edge). Pat to last 2 sts. K2tog (armhole edge).
Next row: Work even in pat.
Rep last 2 rows 5 (6-7-6-8-10) times more. 34 (33-34-35-35-33) sts.
Dec 1 st at front edge only on following alt rows until there are 18 (18-20-20-20-20) sts.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending ona RS row.

Shape shoulder: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 9 (9-10-10-10-10) sts beg next row. Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off rem 9 (9-10-10-1010) sts.

## SLEEVES

With smaller needle cast on 42 (42-46-46-50-50) sts and work $11 / 2$ " 4 cm ] in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back, ending on a RS row. Inc row: (WS). Rib across 4 (4-6-6-8-8) sts. (M1. Rib across 2 sts) 17 times. Rib to end of row. 59 (59-63-63-67-67) sts.

Change to larger needle and proceed in pat as follows:
1st row: (RS). (P1. K1) 1 (1-2-2-3-3) time(s). P2. Work 1st row Panel Pat A. P2. K3. Work 1st row Panel Pat B. K3. P2. Work 1st row Panel Pat A. P2. (K1. P1) 1 (1-2-2-3-3) time(s).
2nd row: (K1. P1) 1 (1-2-2-3-3) time(s). K2. Work 2nd row Panel Pat A. K2. P3. Work 2nd row Panel Pat B. P3. K2. Work 2nd row Panel Pat A. K2. (P1. K1) 1 (1-2-2-3-3) time(s). 3rd row: (K1. P1) 1 (1-2-2-3-3) time(s). P2. Work 3rd row Panel Pat A. P2. Wrap 3. Work 3rd row Panel Pat B. Wrap 3. P2. Work 3rd row Panel Pat A. P2. (P1. K1) 1 (1-2-2-3-3) time(s).
4th row: (P1. K1) 1 (1-2-2-3-3) time(s). K2. Work 4th row Panel Pat A. K2. P3. Work 4th row Panel Pat B. P3. K2. Work 4th row Panel Pat A. K2. (K1.P1) 1 (1-2-2-3-3) time(s).

## Yarnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

These 4 rows form Irish Moss St pat at sides and Wrap St pat. Panel Pats $A$ and $B$ are now in position.

Keeping cont of pat, inc 1 st each end of needle on next and following 8th rows until there are 75 (79-83-87-87-91) sts, taking inc sts into Irish Moss St pat.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures 18 " [ 45.5 cm ], ending on a WS row.

Shape top: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 7 (8-9-8-9-12) sts beg next 2 rows. 61 (63-65-71-69-67) sts.
1st row: (RS). ssk. Pat to last 2 sts. K2tog.
2nd row: Work even in pat.
Rep last 2 rows until there are 39 (39-33-41-31-23) sts, ending on a RS row.

1st row: (WS). P2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. P2tog.
2nd row: ssk. Pat to last 2 sts. K2tog.
Rep last 2 rows until there are 13 (13-15-15-17-17) sts, ending on a WS row. Cast off.

## FINISHING

Pin all garment pieces to measurements and cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Button and Buttonhole Band: Sew shoulder seams.
With RS facing and smaller circular needle, pick up and knit 70 (72-76-76-82-84) sts up Right Front edge to beg of front shaping. Pick up and knit 40 (42-46-48-50-52) sts up front neck edge. K45 (45-45-45-49-49) from Back st holder, dec 7 sts evenly across. Pick up and knit 40 (42-46-48-50-52) sts down Left Front neck edge to beg of front shaping and 70 (72-76-76-82-84) sts down Left Front edge to cast on edge. 258 (266-282-286-306-314) sts. Do not join.
Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: 1st to 3rd rows: Beg on a 2nd row, work 3 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back.
4th row: (RS). (Buttonhole row). Rib across 2 (3-2-2-2-3) sts. *Cast off 2 sts. Rib 9 (9-10-10-11-11) (including st on needle after cast off ). Rep from * 5 times more. Cast off 2 sts. Rib to end of row.

5th row: Rib (7 buttonholes), casting on 2 sts over cast-off sts. Work a further 2 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing. Cast off in ribbing.

Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams. Sew buttons to correspond to buttonholes.


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
