### Materials

Patons Shetland Chunky (100 g/3.5 oz; 114 m/125 yds) Pullover

Sizes XS S M L XL Aran (78008) 6 7 8 8 9 balls

Scarf

Aran (78008) 3 balls

Sizes 5.5 mm (U.S. 9) and 6 mm (U.S. 10) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain tension.** Cable needle. 2 stitch holders.

## Tension

15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

# Stitch Glossary

**C8B** = slip next 4 sts onto a cable needle and leave at back of work. K4, then K4 from cable needle.

## Instructions

### Pullover

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ).

#### **BACK**

\*\*With smaller needles, cast on 66 (**70**-74-**78**-82) sts. **1st row:** (RS). K2. \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to end of row. **2nd row:** P2. \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to end of row.

These 2 rows form (K2. P2) ribbing.

Work a further 6 rows (K2. P2) ribbing, inc 6 (**6**-6-**6**-4) sts evenly across last row. 72 (**76**-80-**84**-86) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows: **1st row:** (RS). P14 (**16**-16-**18**-19). [K8. P10 (**10**-12-**12**-12)] twice. K8. P14 (**16**-16-**18**-19).

**2nd and alt rows:** K14 (**16**-16-**18**-19). [P8. K10 (**10**-12-**12**-12)] twice. P8. K14 (**16**-16-**18**-19).

**3rd row:** P14 (**16**-16-**18**-19). [C8B. P10 (**10**-12-**12**-12)] twice. C8B. P14 (**16**-16-**18**-19).

5th, 7th and 9th rows: As 1st row.

**10th row:** As 2nd row.

These 10 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures 12 (**12**-12½-**12**½-12½)" [30.5 (**30.5**-32-**32**-32) cm], ending with a WS row.

**Shape armholes:** Keeping cont of pat, cast off 6 (7-8-**8**-8) sts beg next 2 rows. 60 (**62**-64-**68**-70) sts.

Dec 1 st each end of next and following alt rows until there are 48 (48-50-50-52) sts.\*\*



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Cont even in pat until armhole measures 7½ (8-8-8½-8½)" [19 (**20.5**-20.5-**21.5**-21.5) cm], ending with a WS row.

**Shape shoulders:** Keeping cont of pat, cast off 8 (**8**-8-**9**) sts beg next 2 rows. Leave rem 32 (**32**-34-**34**-34) sts on a st holder.

#### **FRONT**

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Back.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures 8 rows less than Back to shoulders, ending with RS facing for next row.

Neck shaping: Next row: Pat across 14 (14-14-14-15) sts (neck edge). Turn. Leave rem sts on a spare needle. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 6 rows. 8 (8-8-8-9) sts. Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off.

With RS of work facing, slip next 20 (**20**-22-**22**-22) sts from spare needle onto a st holder. Join yarn to rem sts and pat to end of row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 6 rows. 8 (8-8-8-9) sts. Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off.

#### **SLEEVES**

With smaller needles, cast on 30 (**30**-34-**34**-34) sts and work 8 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back, inc 2 (**2**-2-**2**-4) sts evenly across last row. 32 (**32**-36-**36**-38) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows: **1st row:** (RS). P12 (**12**-14-**14**-15). K8. P12 (**12**-14-**14**-15).

**2nd and alt rows:** K12 (**12**-14-**14**-15). P8. K12 (**12**-14-15)

3rd row: P12 (12-14-14-15). C8B. P12 (12-14-14-15). 5th, 7th and 9th rows: As 1st row.

**10th row:** As 2nd row.

These 10 rows form pat.

Cont in pat, inc 1 st each end of needle on next and following 8th (6th-8th-8th-10th) rows until there are 50 (42-42-50-54) sts.

**Sizes S, M and L only:** Inc 1 st each end of needle on following (8th-10th-10th) rows until there are (52-52-54) sts.

**All Sizes:** Cont even in pat until work from beg measures 18 (18½-18½-19-19½)" [45.5 (47-47-48-49.5) cm], ending with a WS row.

**Shape top:** Cast off 3 (4-4-4-4) sts beg next 2 rows. 44 (44-44-46) sts.

Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and following alt rows until there are 26 (22-22-22) sts, then on every row until there are 12 sts. End with WS for next row. Cast off.

#### **FINISHING**

Pin all garment pieces to measurements and cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

**Neckband:** Sew right shoulder seam. With RS of work facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit 8 sts down Left Front neck edge. K20 (**20**-22-**22**-22) from Front st holder. Pick up and knit 8 sts up Right Front neck edge. K32 (**32**-34-**34**-34) from Back st holder dec 2 sts evenly across. 66 (**66**-70-**70**-70) sts.

Beg on a 2nd row, work 5 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back. Cast off in ribbing. Sew left shoulder and neckband seam.

Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

## Scarf

Cast on 31 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K1. \*P1. K1. Rep from \* to end of row. Last row forms seed st pat.

Work a further 3 rows in seed st pat.

Proceed in pat as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). (K1. P1) twice. (K10. P1. K1. P1) twice. K1. **2nd and alt rows:** \*(K1. P1) twice. K1. P8. Rep from \* once more. (K1. P1) twice. K1.

**3rd row:** (K1. P1) twice. \*K1. C8B. (K1. P1) twice. Rep from \* once more. K1.

5th, 7th and 9th rows: As 1st row.

10th row: As 2nd row.

These 10 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 59" [150 cm], ending on a 6th row of pat.

Work 4 rows in seed st pat. Cast off in pat.
