## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

FRONT and BACK (make alike).
Cast on 75 (81-90-96-111123) sts.

1st row: (RS). P1. *K1. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K1. P1.
2nd row: K1. *P1. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P1. K1.
Rep last 2 rows of (K1. P2) ribbing once more.

Proceed in Zig-Zag pat as follows: 1st row: (RS). *C2R. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: *K2. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
3rd row: P2. *C2R. P1. Rep from * to last st. P1.
4th row: *P1. K2. Rep from * to end of row. 5th row: P1. *C2R. P1. Rep from * to last 2 sts. C2R.

6th row: K1. *P1. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P1. K1.
7th to 12th rows: As 1st to 6th rows once more.
13th row: *P1. C2L. Rep from * to end of row.
14th row: As 4th row.
15th row: K1. *P1. C2L. Rep from

* to last 2 sts. P2.

16th row: As 2nd row.
17th row: *C2L. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
18th row: As 6th row.
19th to 24th rows: As 13th to 18th rows once more.
These 24 rows form Zig-Zag pat.
Cont in pat until work from beg measures 25 (25-26-26-27-28)" [63.5 (63.5-66-66-68.5-71) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulders and Collar: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 15 (17-21-24-30-34) sts beg next 2 rows. 45 (47-48-48-51-55) sts.
Dec 1 st each end of needle on next 10 rows. 25 (27-28-28-3135) sts.

Work 2 rows even in pat. Cast off.

## SLEEVES

Cast on 36 (39-39-42-45-45) sts.
1st row: (RS). P1. *K1. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K1. P1.
2nd row: K1. *P1. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P1. K1.
Rep last 2 rows of (K1. P2) ribbing once more.

Proceed in Zig-Zag pat as given for Front and Back for 12 rows.

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only: Cont in pat, inc 1 st each end of needle on next and every following 4th row until there are 52 (53-57-60) sts, then every following 6th row until there are 56 (59-61-64) sts, taking inc sts into pat.

Sizes $2 / 3 X L$ and $4 / 5 \mathrm{XL}$ only: Cont in pat, inc 1 st each end of needle on next and every following alt row until there are (51-71) sts, then every following 4th row until there are (73-81) sts, taking inc sts into pat.

All sizes: Cont even in pat until work from beg measures $161 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ [ 42 cm ], ending on a WS row.

Shape top: Cast off 3 (3-3-3-44) sts beg next 10 rows. Cast off rem 26 (29-31-34-33-41) sts.

## FINISHING

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry. Sew shoulder and Collar seams. Place markers 8 ( $\left.81 / 2-81 / 2-9-91 / 2-10^{1 / 2}\right)^{\prime \prime}[20.5$ (21.5-21.5-23-24-261.5) cm] down from shoulder seams. Sew sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.
