Sizes U.S. 5 (3.75 mm) and U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles. Size U.S. 5 (3.75 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge. 3 stitch holders. Stitch markers. 9 buttons size 3/8" [9 mm]. Yarn needle. Optional: Sticky-back water soluble fabric stabilizer to transfer embroidery motif.



# **Patons** KNIT EMBROIDERED CARDIGAN

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## **GAUGE**

22 sts and 27 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

#### **BACK**

With smaller needles, cast on **102** (**114-122-134-154-170**) sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to end of row.

**2nd row:** P2. \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a WS row and inc 2 (2-4-4-6-6) sts evenly across last row. 104 (116-126-138-160-176) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures 13 (13-14-15-15-16)" [33 (33-35.5-38-38-40.5) cm], ending on a purl row.

**Shape armholes:** Cast off **7** (9-11-13-15-18) sts beg next 2 rows. **90** (98-104-112-130-140) sts.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: 1st row: (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to last 5 sts. ssk. K3.

**2nd row:** P3. P2togtbl. Purl to last 5 sts. P2tog. P3.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. (114-124) sts.

**All sizes: 1st row:** (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to last 5 sts. ssk. K3.

2nd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **2** (5-7-9-7-8) times more. **84** (86-88-92-98-106) sts.

Proceed as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to last 5 sts. ssk. K3.

**2nd to 4th rows:** Work even in stocking st.

Rep last 4 rows twice more. **78** (**80**-**82-86-92-100**) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures 7¼ (7½-8-8½-9½-10½)" [18.5 (19-20.5-21.5-24-26.5) cm], ending on a purl row.

Shape back neck and shoulders Right side: 1st row: (RS). K20 (21-21-21-25). K2tog. Turn, leaving rem sts on a spare needle.

**2nd row:** P2tog. Purl to end of row. **20** (21-21-21-25) sts.

Shoulder shaping: 3rd row: Cast off 10 (10-10-10-12) sts. Knit to end of row.

4th row: Purl.

With RS facing, slip next 34 (34-36-40-46-46) sts onto st holder.

**Left side: 1st row:** Rejoin yarn to rem sts. ssk. Knit to end of row. **2nd row:** Purl to last 2 sts. P2togtbl. **3rd row:** Knit.

**Shoulder shaping: 4th row:** Cast off **10** (**10-10-10-12**) sts. Purl to end of row.

5th row: Knit.

Cast off rem **10** (11-11-11-11-13) sts.

#### LEFT FRONT

\*\*With smaller needles, cast on **50** (**54-62-66-78-86**) sts.

Work 3" [7.5 cm] in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back, ending on a WS row and inc 2 (4-2-4-2-2) sts evenly across last row. 52 (58-64-70-80-88) sts.\*\*

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures 13 (13-14-15-15-16)" [33 (33-35.5-38-38-40.5) cm], ending on a purl row.

**Shape armhole: 1st row:** (RS). Cast off **7** (9-11-13-15-18) sts. Knit to end of row. **45** (49-53-57-65-70) sts.

2nd row: Purl.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: 1st row: (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

**2nd row:** Purl to last 5 sts. P2tog. P3.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. (57-62) sts.



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All sizes: 1st row: (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

2nd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 2 (5-7-9-7-8) times more. 42 (43-45-47-49-53) sts.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

2nd to 4th rows: Work even in

stocking st.

Rep last 4 rows twice more. 39 (40-42-44-46-50) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures 4" [10 cm] less than Back before shoulder shaping, ending on a purl row.

**Shape front neck: 1st row:** (RS). K25 (26-26-26-30). K2tog. K1. **Turn**, leaving rem **11** (**11-13-15-17-**17) sts on a st holder.

**2nd row:** P1. P2tog. Purl to end of row.

**3rd row:** Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. Rep last 2 rows once more. 23 (24-24-24-28) sts.

Proceed as follows: 1st row: (WS). Purl.

**2nd row:** Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. Rep last 2 rows twice more. 20 (21-21-21-25) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending on a purl row.

**Shape shoulder: 1st row:** (RS). Cast off 10 (10-10-10-12) sts. Knit to end of row.

2nd row: Purl.

Cast off rem 10 (11-111-11-11-13) sts.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Left Front.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures 13 (13-14-15-15-16)" [33 (33-35.5-38-38-40.5) cm], ending on a knit row.

Shape armhole: 1st row: (WS). Cast off 7 (9-11-13-15-18) sts. Purl to end of row. 45 (49-53-57-65-70) sts.

row: (RS). Knit to last 5 sts. ssk. K3. **2nd row:** P3. P2togtbl. Purl to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. (57-**62**) sts.

**All sizes: 1st row:** (RS). Knit to last 5 sts. ssk. K3.

2nd row: Purl

Rep last 2 rows 2 (5-7-9-7-8) times more. 42 (43-45-47-49-53) sts.

Proceed as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). Knit to last 5 sts. ssk.

2nd to 4th rows: Work even in stocking st.

Rep last 4 rows twice more. 39 (40-42-44-46-50) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures 4" [10 cm] less than Back before shoulder shaping, ending on a knit Purl to end of row. row.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: 1st Shape front neck: 1st row: (WS). P28 (29-29-29-26-33). Turn, leaving rem 11 (11-13-15-17-17) sts on a st holder.

> **2nd row:** K1. ssk. Knit to end of row. **3rd row:** Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl.

> Rep last 2 rows once more, then 2nd row once. 23 (24-24-24-28) sts.

Proceed as follows: 1st row: (WS). Purl.

2nd row: K1. ssk. Knit to end of row. Rep last 2 rows twice more. 20 (21-21-21-25) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending on a knit row.

**Shape shoulder: 1st row:** (WS). Cast off 10 (10-10-10-12) sts.

2nd row: Knit.

Cast off rem 10 (11-11-11-11-13) sts.



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## **SLEEVES**

With smaller needles, cast on 50 (50-54-54-58-62) sts.

Work 3" [7.5 cm] in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back, ending on a WS row and inc 16 (16-16-14-10) sts evenly across last row. 66 (66-70-70-72-72) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st as follows:

1st row: (RS), K3, M1, Knit to last 3 sts. M1. K3.

Cont in stocking st, inc 1 st each end of needle, as before, on every following 14th (10th-8th-6th-4th-4th) row until there are **70** (**70-82**-78-78-100) sts, then every following 16th (12th-10th-8th-6th-6th) row until there are 78 (82-88-94-104-110) sts.

Cont even until work from beg measures 171/2 (171/2-18-18-18-18)" [44.5 (44.5-45.5-45.5-45.5) cm], ending on a purl row.

Shape Cap: Cast off 4 (5-6-7-8-10) sts beg next 2 rows. 70 (72-76-80-88-90) sts.

Work 2 rows even.

Next row: (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to last 5 sts. ssk. K3. 68 (70-74-78-86-88) sts.

Work 3 rows even.

Next row: (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to last 5 sts. ssk. K3.

**Next row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 4 (5-7-9-7-14) times more. 58 (58-58-58-70-58) sts.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to last 5 sts. ssk. K3.

**2nd row:** P3. P2togtbl. Purl to last 5 sts. P2tog. P3.

3rd row: As 1st row

4th row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows 4 (4-4-4-6-4) times more, 28 sts. Cast off.

#### **FINISHING**

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Front and neck Edging: Sew shoulder seams. With RS facing and circular needle, pick up and knit **91** (93-101-109-114-125) sts Sew 9 buttons to left front edge, up right front edge. (K1. yo. K1) in corner of neck edge. PM on "yo" st. K11 (11-13-15-17-17) from right front neck edge st holder, dec 1 st at center. Pick up and knit 30 sts up right front neck edge to shoulder. Pick up and knit 3 sts down right back neck edge. K34 (34-36-40-46-46) from back neck st holder. dec 1 st at center. Pick up and knit 3 sts up left back neck edge. Pick up and knit 30 sts down left front neck edge from shoulder. K11 (11-13-15-17-17) from left front neck edge st holder, dec 1 st at center. (K1. yo. K1) in corner of neck edge. PM on "yo" st. Pick up and knit 91 (93-101-109-114-125) sts down front edge. 307 (311-333-357-377-399) sts.

2nd to 4th rows: [Knit to marked st. (K1. yo. K1) in marked st] twice. Knit to end of row. 319 (323-345-369-389-411) sts.

5th row: K1. \*yo. K2tog. Rep from \* to end of row.

6th row: Knit.

7th row: As 2nd row. Cast off knitwise.

Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

having first button at 2nd "yo" from bottom. Top button at 1st "yo" at top corner and rem 7 buttons spaced evenly between.





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#### **EMBROIDERY**

Using template on page 6 and color guide on page 7, embroider Floral design on either side of Cardigan.

Stems: Using 0877, embroider Stems using Stem Stitch.


STEM STITCH



Leaves: Using 0875, embroider Leaves using Lazy Daisy Stitch.

Flower Petals: Using 0893 and 0279, embroider Flower Petals using Lazy Daisy Stitch.


#### LAZY DAISY STITCH





#### Flower Buds and Flower Centers:

Using 0884, embroider Flower Buds using French Knots. Using 0279 or 0893, embroider Flower Centers using French Knots.


















# **Optional Fabric Stabilizer:**

- Using template, transfer design using a washable fabric pen or printer onto Fabric Stabilizer.
- Peel and stick stabilizer to front of Cardigan Have fun! You may wish to play around with the placement!
- Once in position, work on top of stabilizer, and through fabric of Cardigan as indicated in embroidery instructions.
- When you have completed embroidery, peel up edges and cut away any excess stabilizer to ease in rinsing it away.
- Place Cardigan in warm water, with warm running water over it.
- Once stabilizer has dissolved, squeeze out excess water and lay flat on a towel to dry.
