Sizes U.S. 6 (4 mm) and U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch markers. Yarn needle.

GAUGE

22 sts and 40 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Tweed Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: When working in color block technique, use separate balls of the colors, one for each separate area of color in the design. Start new colors at appropriate points. To change colors, twist the two yarns around each other where they meet on WS to avoid a hole.

BACK

****Ribbing:** With B and smaller needles, cast on 13 sts. Work in garter st (knit every row) until Ribbing, when slightly stretched measures **22 (24-26-29-32-34)**" [**56 (61-66-73.5-81.5-86.5)** cm], noting 1st row is WS and ending on a WS row.

Cast off knitwise. **Do not** break B. Turn work sideways.

With RS facing, smaller needles and B, pick up and knit **122 (132-144-160-176-188)** sts evenly across long edge of ribbing.

Next row: (WS). Knit.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). With B, K1. *Sl1Pwyib. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: K1. *Sl1Pwyif K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

3rd row: (RS). With MC, K1. *K1. Sl1Pwyib. Rep from ***39 (43-47-52-57-61)** times more. With A, rep from * to last st. K1.

4th row: With A, K1. *K1. Sl1Pwyif. Rep from * **19 (20-22-25-28-30)** times more. With MC, rep from * to last st. K1.

Rep 1st to 4th rows for Tweed Pat until work from pick up row measures approx 7" [18 cm], ending on a 4th row.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). With MC, K1. *Sl1Pwyib. K1. Rep from * **39 (43-47-52-57-61)** times more. With A, rep from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: With A, K1. *Sl1Pwyif. K1. Rep from * **19 (20-22-25-28-30)** times more. With MC, rep from * to last st. K1.

3rd row: (RS). With A, K1. *K1. Sl1Pwyib. Rep from * to last st. K1.

4th row: K1. *K1. Sl1Pwyif. Rep from * to last st. K1.**

Rep 1st to 4th rows for Tweed Pat until work from beg measures **19 (20-20-22-22-23)**" [**48.5 (51-51-56-56-58.5)** cm], ending on a WS row. Cast off.

FRONT

Rep from ** to ** as given for Back. Rep 1st to 4th rows for Tweed Pat until work from beg measures **17 (18-18-19-19-20)**" [**43 (45.5-45.5-48.5-48.5-51)** cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape left front neck: 1st row: (RS). Pat across **40 (44-50-56-63-67)** sts. K2tog. **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

2nd row: P2tog. Pat to end of row.

3rd row: Pat to last 2 sts. K2tog. **39 (43-49-55-62-66)** sts.

4th row: Work even in pat. Rep last 2 rows twice more. **37 (41-47-53-60-64)** sts.

Cont even in pat until Front measures same length as Back to shoulder, ending on a WS row. Cast off.

Shape right front neck: 1st row: With RS facing and appropriate color, cast off next **39 (41-41-45-47-51)** sts. Pat to end of row.

2nd row: Pat to last 2 sts. P2togtbl. Turn.

3rd row: ssk. Pat to end of row. **39 (43-49-55-62-66)** sts.

4th row: Work even in pat. Rep last 2 rows twice more. **37 (41-47-53-60-64)** sts.

Cont even in pat until Front measures same length as Back to shoulder, ending on a WS row. Cast off.

SLEEVES

Left Sleeve

Ribbing: With MC and smaller needles, cast on 22 sts.

1st row: (WS). Knit

2nd and 3rd rows: With B, knit.

4th and 5th rows: With MC, knit.

Rep last 4 rows of Stripe Pat until Ribbing, when slightly stretched, measures approx **16 (18-18-20-20-22)" [40.5 (45.5-45.5-51-51-56) cm]**, ending on a RS row. Cast off.

With RS facing, smaller needles and MC, pick up and knit **88 (100-100-110-110-122)** sts evenly across long edge of Ribbing.

Next row: (WS). Knit.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

*****1st row:** (RS). With A, K1. *Sl1Pwyib. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: K1. *Sl1Pwyif. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

3rd row: (RS). With MC, K1. *K1. Sl1Pwyib. Rep from * to last st. K1.

4th row: K1. *K1. Sl1Pwyif. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Rep 1st to 4th rows for Tweed Pat until work from pick up row measures **8 (8-8-10-10-11)" [20.5 (20.5-20.5-25.5-25.5-28) cm]**, ending on a WS row. Cast off.***

Right Sleeve

Ribbing: With A and smaller needles, cast on 22 sts.

1st row: (WS). Knit

2nd and 3rd rows: With B, knit.

4th and 5th rows: With A, Knit.

Rep last 4 rows of Stripe Pat until work when slightly stretched measures approx **16 (18-18-20-20-22)" [40.5 (45.5-45.5-51-51-56) cm]**, ending on a RS row. Cast off.

With RS facing, smaller needles and A, pick up and knit **88 (100-100-110-110-122)** sts evenly across long edge of ribbing.

Next row: (WS). Knit.

Change to larger needles and with A only, work from *** to *** as given for Left Sleeve, omitting color change references.

FINISHING

Pin pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Sew shoulder seams. PM **8 (9-9-10-10-11)" [20.5 (23-23-25.5-25.5-28) cm]** down from shoulders on each side of Back and Front. Sew sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Neck Ribbing: With B and smaller needles, cast on 9 sts.

Work in garter st until Ribbing, when slightly stretched, measures length to fit around neck edge. Beg at left shoulder seam, sew ribbing in position as you work. Sew ends of Neck Ribbing tog.
