Sizes U.S. 8 (5 mm) and U.S. 10 (6 mm) Susan Bates® knitting needles. Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® circular knitting needle 16" [40.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge**. 2 Susan Bates® stitch holders. Susan Bates® stitch markers. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

## SIZES

### To fit chest measurement

**XS/S** 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]  
**M** 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]  
**L** 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]  
**XL** 44-46" [112-117 cm]  
**2/3XL** 48-54" [122-137 cm]  
**4/5XL** 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

### Finished chest

**XS/S** 44" [112 cm]  
**M** 48" [122 cm]  
**L** 51" [129.5 cm]  
**XL** 57" [145 cm]  
**2/3XL** 64" [162.5 cm]  
**4/5XL** 68½" [174 cm]

## GAUGE

14 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch on larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

*The instructions are written for XS/S. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written XS/S (M-L-XL-2/3XL-4/5XL). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.*

## Notes:

- When working from chart, wind small balls of the colors to be used, one for each separate area of color in the design. Start new colors at appropriate points. To change colors, twist the 2 colors around each other where they meet, on the WS to avoid a hole.
- Some parts of the chart are worked in Moss stitch. When referring to chart, take care to note when stitch pattern may change.

## FRONT

\*\*With smaller needles and D, cast on **78 (86-90-102-114-122)** sts.  
**1st row:** (RS). \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.  
**2nd row:** \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. P2. Break D.  
 With A, rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing for 2" [5 cm], ending on a WS row.\*\*

Change to larger needles and proceed in Chart as follows:

**Note:** See page 4 (4-5-5-6-6) for Chart.

**1st row:** (RS). With B, **K12 (16-18-24-30-34)**. With A, \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to end of row.  
 1st row of Chart is complete.

Cont in Chart, *reading RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right*, and noting sections in A (Cocoa) and F (Soft Cream) are worked in Moss Stitch, until row **58 (58-62-62-62-62)** of Chart is complete.

## \*\*\*Shape armholes:

**Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only:** Cast off **4 (6-6-8)** sts at beg of next 2 rows. **70 (74-78-86)** sts at end of 2nd row.

**Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:** Cast off **(6-6)** sts at beg of next 4 rows. **(90-98)** sts at end of 4th row.\*\*\*

**All sizes:** Cont working Chart on these **70 (74-78-86-90-98)** sts until row **82 (82-88-88-94-94)** of Chart is complete.

**Shape left neck:** Keeping cont of Chart, proceed as follows:

**Next row:** (RS). K25 (27-28-32-33-37). K2tog. K1. **Turn.** Place rem sts on st holder.

Cont on these 27 (29-30-34-35-39) sts.

**Next row:** Purl.

**Next row:** Work chart to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 26 (28-29-33-34-38) sts. Rep last 2 rows, dec at neck edge every RS row 5 (5-5-5-6-6) times more. 21 (23-24-28-28-32) sts.

**Shape left shoulder: Next row:** (RS). Cast off 11 (12-12-14-14-16) sts. Work chart to end of row. 10 (11-12-14-14-16) sts.

**Next row:** Purl.

Cast off rem 10 (11-12-14-14-16) sts.

**Shape right neck:** With RS facing, slip center 14 (14-16-16-18-18) sts onto st holder for front neck.

Join D and proceed as follows on rem 28 (30-31-35-36-40) sts:

**Next row:** (RS). K1. ssk. Work chart to end of row. 27 (29-30-34-35-39) sts.

**Next row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows, dec at neck edge every RS row 6 (6-6-6-7-7) times more. 21 (23-24-28-28-32) sts. Knit 1 row.

**Shape right shoulder: Next row:** (WS). Cast off 11 (12-12-14-14-16) sts. Purl to end of row. 10 (11-12-14-14-16) sts.

**Next row:** Knit.

Cast off rem 10 (11-12-14-14-16) sts.

## BACK

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Front.

Change to larger needles and work with A in stocking st (Knit RS rows and Purl WS rows), until Back measures same length as Front to beg of armholes, ending on a purl row.

Work from \*\*\* to \*\*\* as given for Front, omitting any references to Chart.

**All sizes:** Cont even in stocking st on these 70 (74-78-86-90-98) sts until armholes measure same length as Front to beg of shoulder shaping, ending on a purl row.

**Shape shoulders:** Cast off 11 (12-12-14-14-16) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 10 (11-12-14-14-16) sts at beg of following 2 rows. Leave rem 28 (28-30-30-34-34) sts on st holder for back neck.

## SLEEVES

With B and smaller needles, cast on 34 (34-38-38-42-42) sts.

**1st row:** (RS). \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.

**2nd row:** \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. P2. Break B.

With E, rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing for 2" [5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

**Next row:** K1. Kfb. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 36 (36-40-40-44-44) sts. Work 3 rows in stocking st.

Cont in stocking st, inc 1 st each end of row on next row and every following 4th row 4 (4-8-8-6-6) times more to 46 (46-58-58-58-58) sts, then every following 6th row 6 (6-4-4-7-7) times more. 58 (58-66-66-72-72) sts.

Cont even until Sleeve measures 18 (18-18½-18½-19-19)" [45.5 (45.5-47-47-48-48) cm], ending on a purl row.

Cast off knitwise (RS).

PM on either side edge of Sleeve 1 (1¾-1¾-2½-3½-3½)" [2.5 (4.5-4.5-6-9-9) cm] down from cast off edge.

## FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements, Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry. Sew shoulder seams.

**Sew In Sleeves:** PM at center of Sleeve along cast off edge.

With pieces laying flat, and RS facing up, pin Sleeve to shoulder seam matching seam to center Sleeve st marker. Pin edges of Sleeve above side markers along armhole edges of Body, to create square armholes. Ensure top of Sleeve aligns with Body armhole edges, easing into place to fit between markers. Sew in position using mattress stitch.

Sew side and sleeve seams.



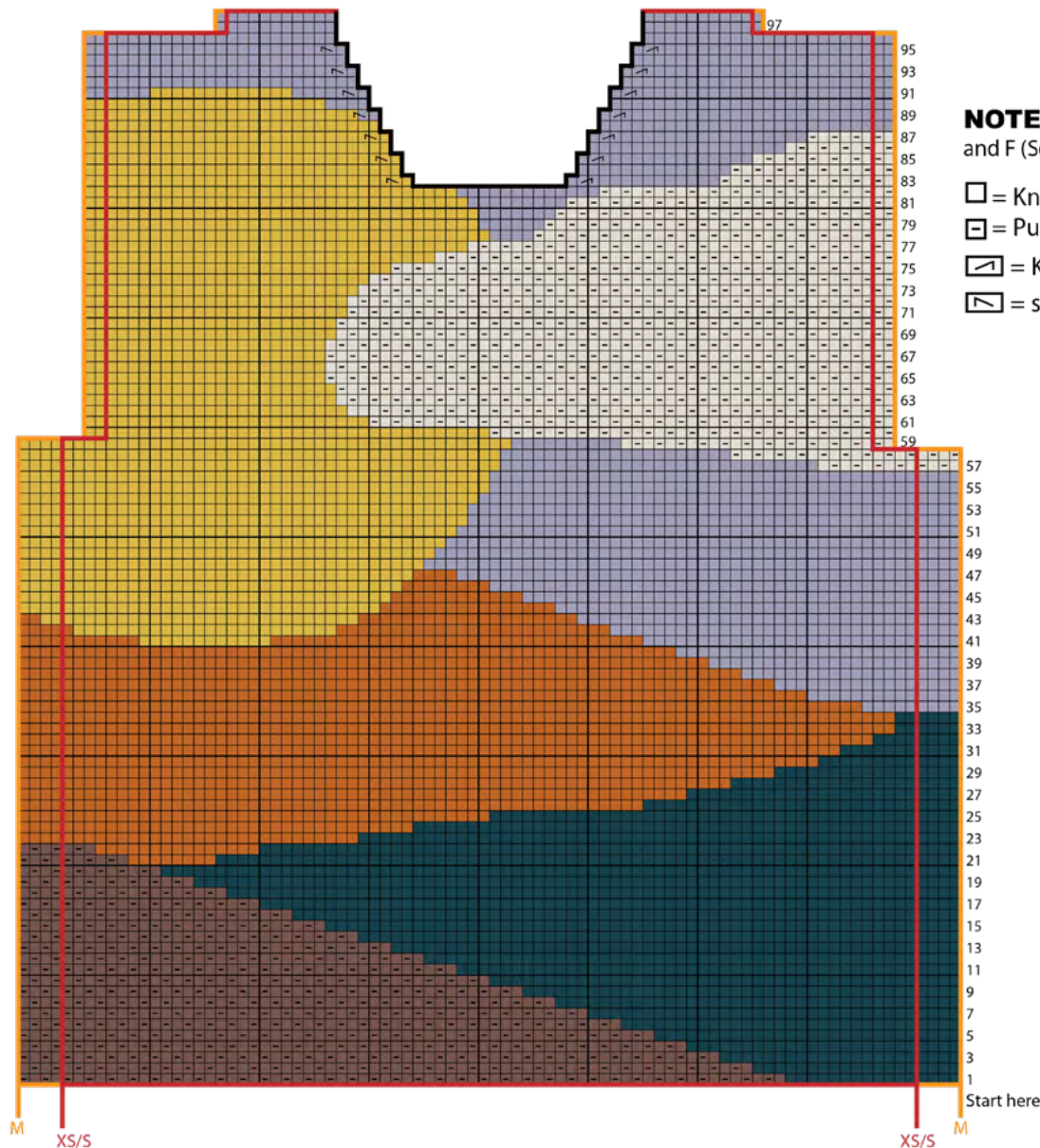
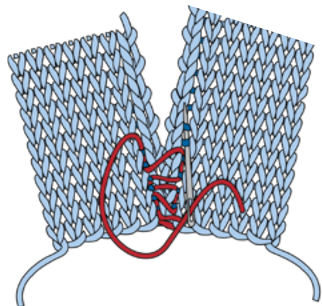
**Neckband:** With RS facing, smaller circular needle and E, beg at left shoulder, pick up and knit **13** (**13-13-14-14-14**) sts down left front neck edge. K**14** (**14-16-16-18-18**) sts from front neck st holder. Pick up and knit **13** (**13-13-14-14-14**) sts up right front neck edge. K**28** (**28-30-30-34-34**) sts from back neck st holder, inc **0** (**0-0-2-0-0**) sts evenly along back neck. **68** (**68-72-76-80-80**) sts. PM. Join in rnd.

**1st rnd:** \*K2. P2. Rep from \* around. Rep last rnd of (K2. P2) ribbing twice more. Break E.

With D, work 2 rnds of (K2. P2) ribbing.

Cast off in ribbing.

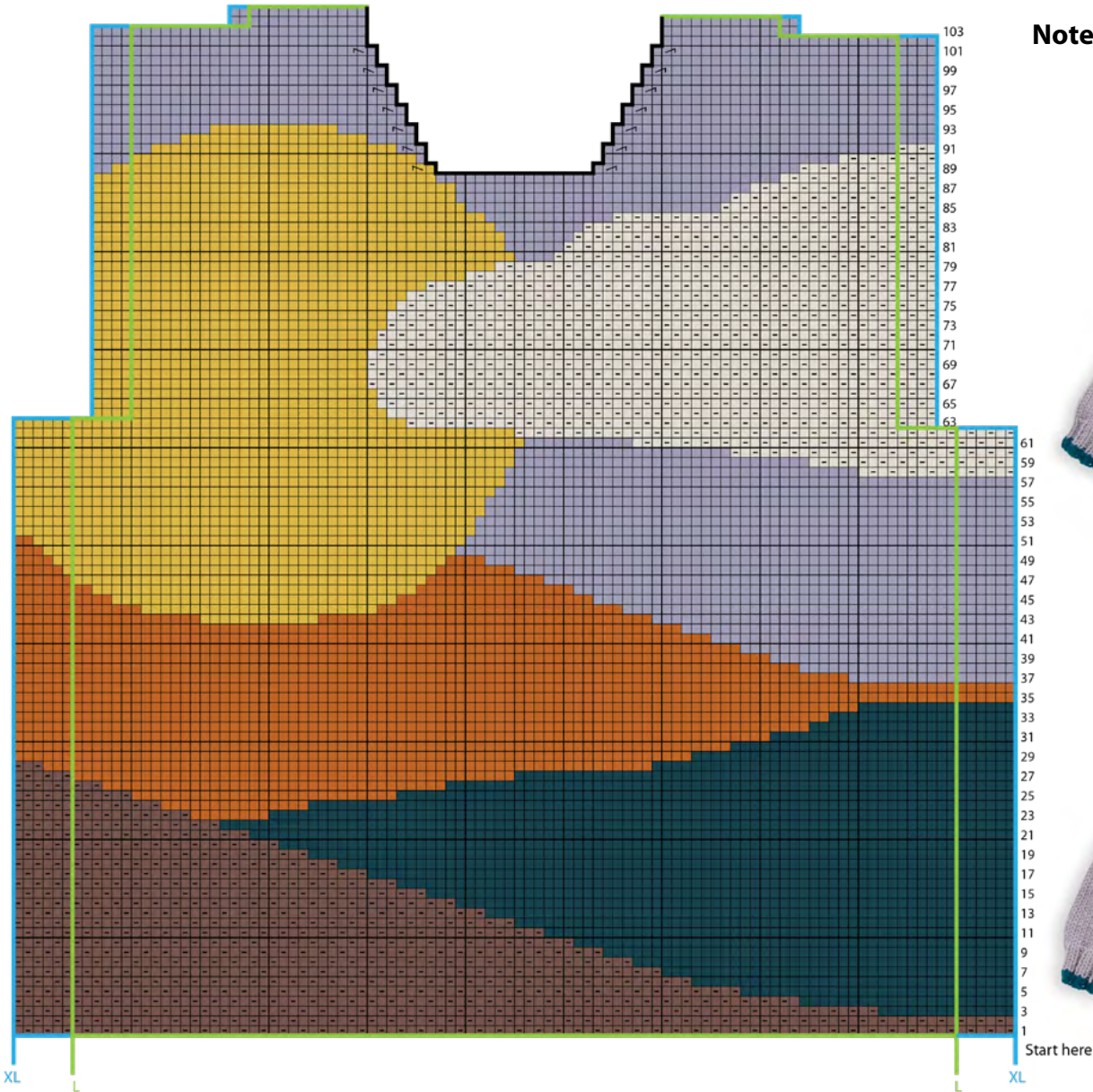
### MATTRESS STITCH DIAGRAM



**NOTE:** Sections worked in B (Cocoa) and F (Soft Cream) are worked in Moss Stitch.

- = Knit on RS rows. Purl on WS rows.
- ◻ = Purl on RS rows. Knit on WS rows.
- ▴ = K2tog
- ▾ = ssk

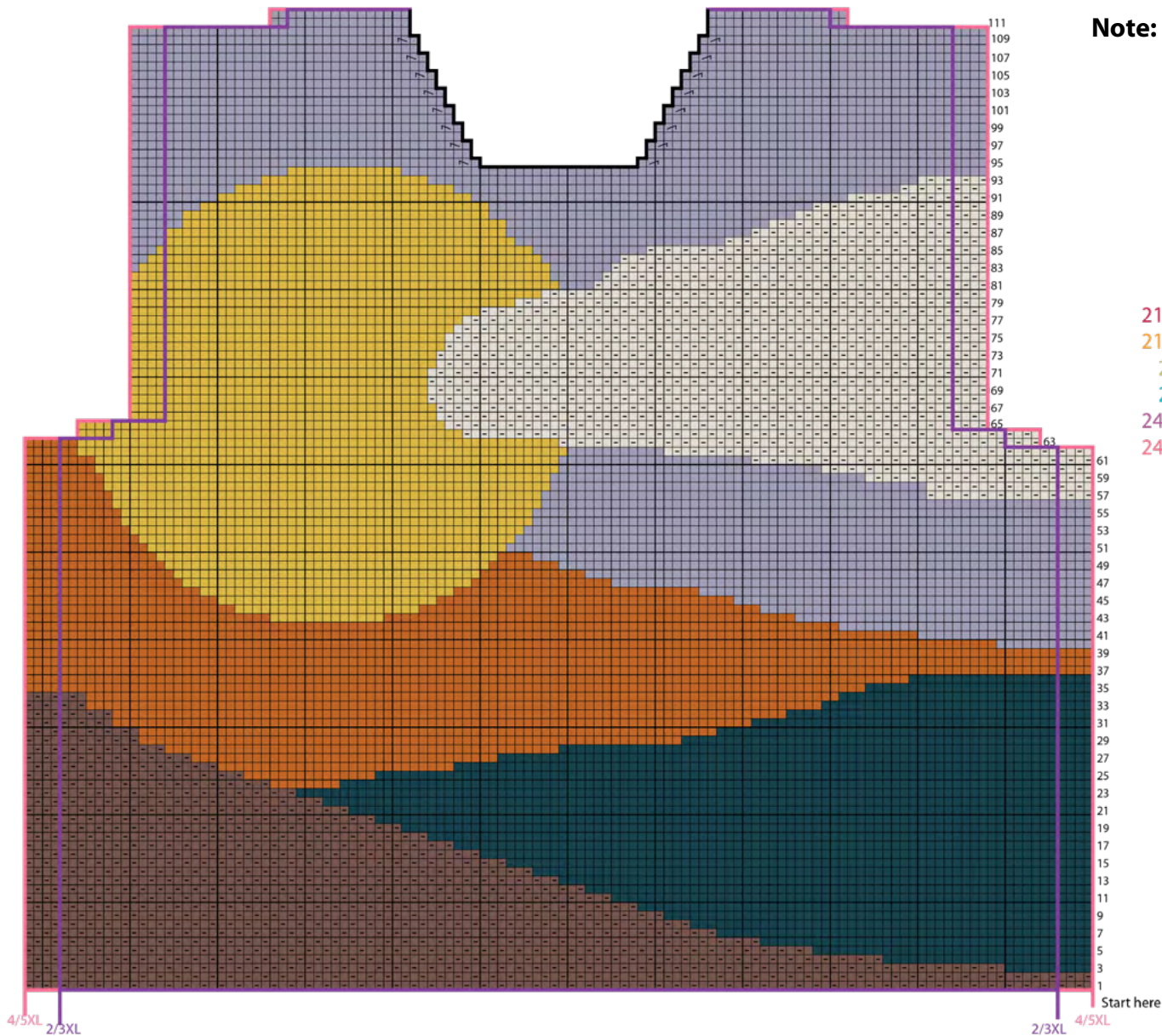
