## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## BACK

Note: Back is approx $1^{1 "}[2.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] longer than Front.
**With pair of needles, cast on 67 (75-83-91-107-123) sts.
1st row: (RS). *K3. P1. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.
2nd row: *P3. K1. Rep from * to last 3 sts. P3.**
Rep last 2 rows (K3. P1) ribbing 6 times more.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5. Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 16 (16-17-17-1819)" [40.5 (40.5-43-43-45.5-48) $\mathrm{cm}]$, ending on a WS row.

Armhole shaping: Cast off 3 (6-7-8-9-10) sts beg next 2 rows. 61
(63-69-75-89-103) sts.
Size $4 / 5$ XL only: Cast off 3 sts beg next 2 rows. 97 sts.

Sizes $2 / 3 X L$ and $4 / 5 \mathrm{XL}$ only: 1 st row: (RS). SI1. K1. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2. (87-95) sts.

2nd row: SI1P. P1. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2. (85-93) sts. Rep last 2 rows (4-5) times more. (69-73) sts.

All sizes: 1st row: (RS). SI1. K1. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2. 59 (61-67-73-67-75) sts.
2nd row: SI1P. Purl to end of row. Rep last 2 rows 6 (7-7-9-4-4) times more. 47 (47-53-55-59-65) sts.

Cont even in stocking st, slipping first st of each row until armholes measure approx 6 ( $61 / 2-61 / 2-7-7-$ 7½)" [15 (16.5-16.5-18-18-19) cm ], ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulders: Cast off 5 (5-6-$6-7-8)$ sts beg next 2 rows, then 4 (4-5-5-6-7) sts beg next 2 rows. Place rem 29 (29-31-33-33-35) sts onto a st holder.

## FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.
Rep last 2 rows (K3. P1) ribbing 3 times more.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5. Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 15 (15-16-16-1718)" [38 (38-40.5-40.5-43-45.5) cm ], ending on a WS row.

Armhole shaping: Cast off 3 (6-7-8-9-11) sts beg next 2 rows. 61 (63-69-75-89-101) sts.

Sizes $2 / 3 X L$ and $4 / 5 X L$ only:
1strow:(RS).SI1.K1.ssk.Knittolast 4 sts. K2tog. K2. (87-99) sts.
2nd row: SI1P. P1. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
Rep last 2 rows (4-5) times more. (69-65) sts.

All sizes: 1 st row: (RS). SI1. K1. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2. 59 (61-67-73) sts. 59 (61-67-73-6763) sts.

2nd row: SI1P. Purl to end of row. Rep last 2 rows 6 (7-7-9-4-5) times more. 47 (47-53-55-59-65) sts.

Cont even in stocking st, slipping first st of each row until armhole measures approx 41/4 (43/4-43/4-51/4-51/4-53/4)" [11 (12-12-13-13$14.5) \mathrm{cm}]$, ending on a WS row.

Neck shaping: 1st row: SI1. K13 (13-15-15-17-19). K2tog. Turn. Leaverem31(31-35-37-39-43) sts on spare needle.
2nd row: P2tog. Purl to end of row.
3rd row: SI1. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
Rep last 2 rows to 9 (9-11-11-13-
15) sts.

Work 1 row even.
Shape shoulder: Cast off 5 (5-6-6-7-8) sts beg next row.
Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 4 (4-5-5-6-7) sts.

With RS facing, slip next 15 (15-17-19-19-21) sts onto a st holder. Join yarn to rem sts.ssk. Knit to end of row. 15 (15-17-17-19-21) sts.
Next row: SI1P. Purl to last 2 sts. P2togtbl.
Next row: ssk. Knit to end of row. Rep last 2 rows to 9 (9-11-11-1315) sts.

Work 2 rows even.

## 兰 Patons' sleeveless knit turtleneck | Knt

Shape shoulder: Cast off 5 (5-6-6-7-8) sts beg next row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 4 (4-5-5-6-7) sts.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew side seams from armhole to top of ribbing leaving sides of ribbing open.

Collar: With RS facing and circular needle, beg at right shoulder, pick up and knit 9 sts down right front neck edge. K15 (15-17-19-19-21) from Front st holder. Pick up and knit 9 sts up left front neck edge. K29 (29-31-33-33-35) from Back neck st holder, dec 2 (2-0-1-1-2) st(s) evenly across. 60 (60-66-69-6972) sts. PM. Join to beg working in rnd.
1st rnd: *K2. P1. Rep from * around.
Rep last rnd until Collar measures 4" [10 cm]. Cast off loosely in pat.
