A WALK IN THE COUNTRY

SIZES

Bust measurement

Small	30-32 ins	[76-81 cm]
Medium	34-36 ins	[86-91 cm]
Large	38-40 ins	[97-102cm]
Extra-Large	42-44 ins	[107-112cm]

Finished bust

Small	38 ins	[97 cm]
Medium	42 ins	[107 cm]
Large	45 ins	[114.5 cm]
Extra-Large	48 ins	[122 cm]

TENSION

19 sts and 25 rows = 4 ins [10 sm] in stocking st.

MATERIALS

Patons Classic Wool (100 g/3.5 oz) or Patons Décor (100 g/3.5 oz)

Size	S	M	L	XL	
(Blue)	4	4	4	5	balls

Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles or size needed to obtain tension.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

BACK

**Cast on 90 (100-106-114) sts.

1st row: (RS). Knit.

2nd row: P0 (0-1-0). K1 (0-2-1).

*P4. K2. Rep from * to last 5 (4-1-5) sts. P4 (4-1-4). K1 (0-0-1).

These 2 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures 17½ (17½-18-18) ins [44.5 (44.5-45.5-45.5) cm] ending with RS facing for next row.

Armhole shaping: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 6 (7-8-9) sts beg next 2 rows.**

Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and following 4 (7-8-10) alt rows. 68 (70-72-74) sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole

measures 8½ (9-9-9½) ins [21.5 (23-23-24) cm] ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off. Place markers for shoulders 18 (18-19-19) sts in from side edges.

FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and following 2 alt rows. 72 (80-84-90) sts.

Work 1 row even.

Neck shaping: Next row: Work 2tog. Pat across 31 (35-37-40) sts. K2tog. K1 (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Next row: P2. Pat to end of row

Next row: Work 2tog. Pat to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Rep last 2 rows 0 (3-4-6) times more. 32 (30-30-29) sts.

Next row: P2. Pat to end of row.

Next row: Pat to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Rep last 2 rows 11 (9-7-6) times more. 20 (20-22-22) sts.

Next row: P2. Pat to end of row.

Next row: Pat to last 2 sts. K2.

Next row: P2. Pat to end of row.

Next row: Pat to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Rep last 4 rows 1 (1-2-2) times more. 18 (18-19-19) sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures same length as Back ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

With RS of work facing, join yarn

to rem sts.

Next row: K1. Sl1. K1. pss0. Pat to last 2 sts. Work 2tog.

Next row: Pat to last 2 sts. P2.

Next row: K1. Sl1. K1. pss0. Pat to last 2 sts. Work 2tog.

Rep last 2 rows 0 (3-4-6) times more. 32 (30-30-29) sts.

Next row: Pat to last 2 sts. P2.

Next row: K1. Sl1. K1. pss0. Pat to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows 11 (9-7-6) times more. 20 (20-22-22) sts.

Next row: Pat to last 2 sts. P2.

Next row: K2. Pat to end of row.

Next row: Pat to last 2 sts. P2.

Next row: K1. Sl1. K1. pss0. Pat to end of row.

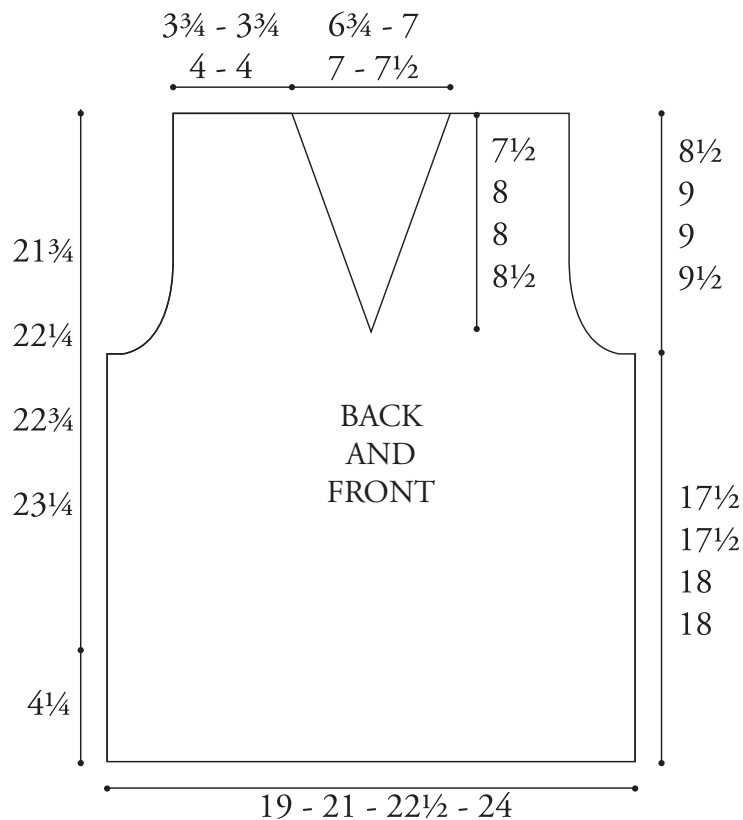
Rep last 4 rows 1 (1-2-2) times more. 18 (18-19-19) sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures same length as Back ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

Pin garment pieces to measurements and cover with a damp cloth. Press lightly with a steam iron. Remove cloth when dry.

Sew shoulder seams. Place markers on front and back side edges $4\frac{1}{4}$ ins [11 cm] up from lower edge. Sew side seams to markers.
