

MATERIALS

Patons[®] Silk Bamboo[™] (65 g/2.2 oz; 93 m/102 yds)

Sizes 2/3XL 4/5XL

Moss (85236) 12 balls

Sizes U.S. 4 (3.5 mm) and U.S. 6 (4 mm) Susan Bates® knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates® Steel Yarn Needle. Susan Bates[®] Split-Lock Stitch Count Markers.

SIZES

To fit bust measurement

28-34" [71-86.5 cm] XS/S M/L 36-42" [91.5-106.5 cm] 44-46" [112-117 cm] XL

2/3XL 48-54"[122-137 cm]

4/5XL 56-62"[142-157.5 cm]

Finished bust

351/2" [96.5 cm] XS/S M/L 44" [112 cm] XL 48½" [127 cm] 2/3XL 57½" [146 cm] 65" [165 cm] 4/5XL

GAUGE

22 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.



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INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

BACK

With smaller needles cast on **98 (122-134-158-182) sts.

Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: Purl.

3rd row: K1. (K2tog) twice. *(yo. K1) 4 times. (K2tog) 4 times. Rep from * to last 9 sts. (yo. K1) 4 times. (K2tog) twice. K1.

4th row: Knit.

These 4 rows form Feather and Fan Pat.**

Note: When determining lengths, allow piece to hang while measuring.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx **22** (**22-23-23-23**)" [**56** (**56-58.5-58.5-58.5**) cm], ending with a 4th row of pat.

***Place pat for neck shaping: 1st row: (RS). Pat 26 (38-38-50-62) sts. K46 (46-58-58-58). Pat 26 (38-38-50-62) sts.

Rep last row 8 times more [keeping center **46** (**46-58-58-58**) sts in garter st].

Shape neck: Next row: (WS). Pat **26** (38-38-50-62) sts. K4. Cast off center **38** (38-50-50-50) sts. K4 (including st on needle after cast off). Pat **26** (38-38-50-62) sts.

Cont in pat on last 26 (38-38-50-62) sts, AT SAME TIME, working garter st across 4 sts at neck edge until work from beg measures 25 (25-26-26)" [63.5 (63.5-66-66-66) cm], ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off **10** (**14-14-18-22**) sts beg next and following alt row.

Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off rem **10** (**14-14-18-22**) sts.

With RS facing, join yarn to rem sts. K4. Pat **26** (38-38-50-62) sts.

Cont in pat on 26 (38-38-50-62) sts, AT SAME TIME, working garter st across 4 sts at neck edge until work from beg measures 25 (25-26-26-26)" [63.5 (63.5-66-66-66) cm], ending with a RS row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off **10** (**14-14-18-22**) sts beg next and following alt row.

Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off rem **10** (14-14-18-22) sts.***

FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 19 (19-20-20-20)" [48 (48-51-51-51) cm], ending with a 4th row of pat.

Work from *** to *** as given for Back.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Place markers on side edges **7½** (8-8½-8½-9)" [**19** (20.5-21.5-21.5-23) cm] down from shoulder seams.

Armbands: With RS of work facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit **77** (**81-85-85-89**) sts evenly between markers. Knit 7 rows (garter st).

Cast off knitwise (WS). Sew side and armband seams.
