## SIZE

Approx 38" x 42" [96.5 x 106.5 cm ].

## MATERIALS

## Patons ${ }^{\circledR}$ Beehive Baby Chunky ${ }^{\text {Tm }}(100 \mathrm{~g} / 3.5 \mathrm{oz} ; 109 \mathrm{~m} / 120 \mathrm{yds})$ Billowy Blue (76143) $\mathbf{8}$ balls

Size 6 mm (U.S. 10) circular knitting needle, $32^{\prime \prime}$ [ 80 cm ] long or size needed to obtain tension.

## TENSION

15 sts and 20 rows $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 138 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, knit 5 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS and inc 5 sts evenly across last row.
143 sts.
Work 6 rows stocking st.
Proceed in pat as follows:
1 st row: (RS). K6. (yf. SI5wyif. yb. K9) 9 times. yf. SI5wyif. yb. K6.
2nd and 4th rows: K4. Purl to last 4 sts. K4.
3rd and 5th rows: As 1st row.
6th row: K4. P4. *Butterfly loop. P13. Rep from * to last 9 sts. Butterfly loop. P4. K4.
7th, 9th and 11 th rows: Knit.
8th, 10th and 12th rows: As 2nd row.
13th, 15th and 17th rows: K4. (K9. yf. SI5wyif. yb) 9 times. K13.
14th and 16th rows: As 2nd row.
18th row: K4. P11. *Butterfly loop. P13. Rep from * to last 16 sts. Butterfly loop. P11. K4.
19th, 21 st and 23rd rows: Knit.
20th, 22nd and 24th rows: As 2nd row.
Rep 1st to 24th rows of Butterfly Pat 7 times more, then 1st to 12th row once more, dec 5 sts evenly across last row. 138 sts.
Knit 5 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS).
