## Patons Canadiana

## ANDREW'S STRIPES (TO KNIT)

## SIZES

Chest measurement: 4 (6-8-10) yrs 23 (25-261/2-28) ins [58.5 (63.5-67.5-71) cm].
Finished chest: 26 (28-30-32) ins [66 (71-76-81.5) cm].

## MATERIALS

Patons ${ }^{\circledR}$ Canadiana ( $100 \mathrm{~g} / 3.5 \mathrm{oz}$ )
1 (1-2-2) ball(s) each of \#00034 (Navy) as A, \#00005
(Cardinal) as B, \#00032 (Bright Royal) as C, \# 00104 (Aran) as $\mathbf{D}$.

Sizes 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) and 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles or size needed to obtain tension. 4 st holders.

## TENSION

18 sts and 24 rows $=4$ ins $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in stocking st with larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

STRIPE PAT (worked in stocking st): Work 6 rows of each color: B, D, A, B, C, D. These 36 rows form Stripe Pat.

## BACK

**With A and smaller needles cast on 58 (62-66-70) sts.
Work 8 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing, inc 1 st at center of last row. 59 (63-67-71) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in Stripe Pat for $81 / 2$ ( $\mathbf{9} 3 / 4-11^{1 / 2}-\mathbf{1 4}$ ) ins [21.5 (25-29-35.5) cm] total length, ending on a 6th (14th-24th-4th) row of Stripe Pat.

Shape raglans: Cast off 2 sts beg next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and every 4th row to 47 (53-5559) sts, then every alt row** to 21 (21-25-25) sts. Leave sts on a st holder.


## FRONT

Work as given for Back to 31 (31-35-35) sts. Next row: Purl.
Shape neck: Next row: (RS). Work 2tog. K9 (neck edge). Turn. Leave rem sts on a spare needle. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 2 rows then on alt rows twice more AT THE SAME TIME, dec 1 st at raglan edge on every alt row to 2 sts.
Next row: Work 2tog. Fasten off.
With RS facing, slip next 9 (9-13-13) sts onto a st holder. Join appropriate color, knit to last 2 sts. Work 2tog. Work as for left side, reversing all shapings.

## SLEEVES

With A and smaller needles, cast on $30(\mathbf{3 4}-34-\mathbf{3 4})$ sts. Work 8 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing, inc 4 (2-2-2) sts evenly across last row. 34 (36-36-36) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in Stripe Pat beg on the 33rd (35th-1st-9th) row of pat, inc 1 st each end of needle on 3rd and every following 4th row until there are 56 (60-64$\mathbf{6 8}$ ) sts. Cont even, ending on a 6th (14th-24th-4th) row of Stripe Pat.

Shape raglans: Cast off 2 sts beg next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and every alt row to 12 (14-1616) sts. Next row: Work 2 tog. Purl to last 2 sts. Work 2 tog. 10 (12-14-14) sts. Leave sts on a st holder.

## FINISHING

Neckband: Sew raglan seams leaving left back raglan seam open. With RS facing, A and smaller needles, K74 (74-8686) around neck edge.

Work 5 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing. Cast off in ribbing. Sew left back raglan and neckband seam. Sew side and sleeve seams.
