# **≜**Patons<sup>®</sup> Canadiana



## FRONT

Work as given for Back to 31 (31-35-35) sts. Next row: Purl.

**Shape neck: Next row:** (RS). Work 2tog. K9 (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a spare needle. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 2 rows then on alt rows twice more AT THE SAME TIME, dec 1 st at raglan edge on every alt row to 2 sts. **Next row:** Work 2tog. Fasten off.

With RS facing, slip next 9 (**9**-13-**13**) sts onto a st holder. Join appropriate color, knit to last 2 sts. Work 2tog. Work as for left side, reversing all shapings.

### **SLEEVES**

With A and smaller needles, cast on 30 (34-34-34) sts. Work 8 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing, inc 4 (2-2-2) sts evenly across last row. 34 (36-36-36) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in Stripe Pat beg on the 33rd (**35th**-1st-**9th**) row of pat, inc 1 st each end of needle on 3rd and every following 4th row until there are 56 (**60**-64-**68**) sts. Cont even, ending on a 6th (**14th**-24th-**4th**) row of Stripe Pat.

**Shape raglans:** Cast off 2 sts beg next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and every alt row to 12 (**14**-16-**16**) sts. **Next row:** Work 2tog. Purl to last 2 sts. Work 2tog. 10 (**12**-14-**14**) sts. Leave sts on a st holder.

## FINISHING

**Neckband:** Sew raglan seams leaving left back raglan seam open. With RS facing, A and smaller needles, K74 (**74**-86-**86**) around neck edge.

Work 5 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing. Cast off in ribbing. Sew left back raglan and neckband seam. Sew side and sleeve seams.

## ANDREW'S STRIPES (TO KNIT)

#### SIZES

**Chest measurement:** 4 (6-8-10) yrs 23 (25-26<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-28) ins [58.5 (63.5-67.5-71) cm].

Finished chest: 26 (28-30-32) ins [66 (71-76-81.5) cm].

#### MATERIALS

**Patons**<sup>®</sup> **Canadiana** (100 g/3.5 oz) 1 (1-2-2) **ball(s)** each of #00034 (Navy) as **A**, #00005 (Cardinal) as **B**, #00032 (Bright Royal) as **C**, # 00104 (Aran) as **D**.

Sizes 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) and 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles or size needed to obtain tension. 4 st holders.

#### **TENSION**

18 sts and 24 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] in stocking st with larger needles.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ).

**STRIPE PAT** (worked in stocking st): Work 6 rows of each color: B, D, A, B, C, D. These 36 rows form Stripe Pat.

#### BACK

\*\*With A and smaller needles cast on 58 (**62**-66-**70**) sts. Work 8 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing, inc 1 st at center of last row. 59 (**63**-67-**71**) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in Stripe Pat for  $8\frac{1}{2}$  (9<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>-11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-14) ins [21.5 (25-29-35.5) cm] total length, ending on a 6th (14th-24th-4th) row of Stripe Pat.

**Shape raglans:** Cast off 2 sts beg next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and every 4th row to 47 (**53**-55-**59**) sts, then every alt row<sup>\*\*</sup> to 21 (**21**-25-**25**) sts. Leave sts on a st holder.
