## HAT AND MITTS:

To fit child ages: 4/6 (8/10) yrs

## MATERIALS

Patons Classic Wool (100 g/3.5 oz) or Patons Decor (100 g/3.5 oz)
JACKET
Size $\quad 4 \quad 6 \quad 8 \quad 10$
Main Color (MC)
(Blue)
$3445 \begin{array}{llll}3 & 4 & \text { balls }\end{array}$
Contrast A (White)
$11111 \begin{array}{llll}1 & 1 & \text { ball }\end{array}$

SKIRT
Size 466810
Main Color (MC) (Blue)
2333 balls
Contrast A (White)
11111 ball

Hat \& Mitts
Size 4/6 8/10
Main Color (MC) (1620)
11 ball
Contrast A (1602) 11 ball

Sizes 3.75 mm (U.S. 5) and 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) knitting needles, sizes 3.75 mm (U.S. 5) and 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) circular knitting needles or size needed to obtain tension. Separating zipper for Jacket. 1 st holder. 1 yd [ 91.5 cm ] of elastic $11 / 4 \mathrm{ins}[3 \mathrm{~cm}]$ wide for Skirt.

## TENSION

20 sts and 26 rows $=4$ ins [ 10 cm ] with larger needles in stocking st.

## ABBREVIATIONS

ML = (Make loop). Knit into the next st do not drop st from needle. yf, wind yarn arnd left thumb, yb, knit into same st (2 sts made). Slip 2 sts just made on to right-hand needle.
$\mathbf{y f}=$ Bring yarn to front of work.
$\mathbf{y b}=$ Bring yarn to back of work.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

## JACKET <br> BACK

With larger needles and MC, cast on 71 (77-81-87) sts.
**Work 1 inch [ 2.5 cm ] in stocking st ending with WS facing for next row.
Next row: (Fold row). Knit. **

Beg with knit row, work in stocking st until work from fold row measures $141 / 2$ ( $16-17 \frac{1}{2}-19$ ) ins [37 (41-44.5-48) cm] ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders: Cast off 8 (8-99) sts beg next 4 rows, then 7 (9-8-9) sts beg following 2 rows. Leave rem 25 (27-29-33) sts onto a st holder.

## LEFT FRONT

With larger needles and MC, cast on 35 (37-39-43) sts.
Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: K2. Purl to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows until work from fold row measures 12 ( $13-141 / 2-16$ ) ins [30.5 (33-37-40.5) cm] ending with WS facing for next row.

Shape neck: Cast off 7 (7-8-9) sts beg next row. Dec 1 sts at neck edge on next and following alt rows to 23 (25-26-27) sts.Cont even until work from fold row
measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 8 (8-9-9) sts beg next and following alt row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 7 (9-8-9) sts.

## RIGHT FRONT

With larger needles and MC, cast on 35 (37-39-43) sts.
Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: Purl to last 2 sts. K2.
Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 12 ( $13-14 \frac{1}{2}-16$ ) ins [ 30.5 (33-37-40.5) cm] ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape neck: Cast off 7 (7-8-9) sts beg next row.
Work 1 row even.
Dec 1 sts at neck edge on next and following alt rows to 23 (25-26-27) sts.

Cont even until work from fold line measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping ending with WS facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 8 (8-9-9) sts beg next and following alt row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 7 (9-8-9) sts.

## SLEEVES

With larger needles and MC, cast on 43 (43-45-45) sts.
Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Beg with knit row, work in stocking st, inc 1 st each end of needle on 3rd and following 4th rows to 71 (75-81-85) sts.
Cont even until work from fold line measures 11 ( $13-14 \frac{1}{2}-16$ ) ins [28 (33-37-41) cm] ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

## COLLAR

Sew shoulder seams. With RS of work facing, A and smaller needles, pick up and knit 20 (22-22-25) sts up right front neck edge, knit across 25 (27-29-33) sts from back st holder dec 2 sts evenly across. Pick up and knit 20 (22-22-25) sts down left front neck edge. 63 (69-71-81) sts.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: (WS). Purl.
2nd row: K1. *ML. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

3rd row: P1. *P2tog. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

4th row: K2. *ML. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.
5th row: P2. *P2tog. P1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

Rep last 4 rows for 3 ins $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] ending with WS facing for next row. Cast off.

## FINISHING

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving to dry.

Place markers on front and back side edges $7\left(7 \frac{1}{2}-8-8 \frac{1}{2}\right)$ ins [18(19-21-22) cm] down from shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew zipper in position. Fold bottom of Back, Fronts and Sleeves along fold row to WS. Sew cast on edge in position.

## SKIRT

Note: Skirt is worked from bottom to top.

With A and larger circular needle, cast on 213 (229-245-261) sts.
Join in rnd and proceed as follows:
**1st rnd: K1. *ML. K1. Rep from * arnd.
2nd rnd: K1. *K2tog. K1. Rep from * arnd.
3rd rnd: K2. *ML. K1. Rep from * to last st. ML.
4th rnd: K2. *K2tog. K1. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2tog.**

Rep from ** to ** twice more.
Dec 1 st at center of last rnd. 212 (228-244-260) sts.
Change to MC and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures 10 ( $\left.111 / 2-12^{1 / 2}-13^{1 / 2}\right)$ ins [25.5 (29-32-34.5) cm].

Shape waistband: *K1. K3tog.
Rep from * arnd. 106 (114-122130) sts.

Change to smaller circular needle and work 3 ins [7.5 cm] in stocking st. Cast off.

## FINISHING

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving to dry.

Fold waistband in half and sew in position, leaving an opening to insert elastic. Cut elastic to measurement and thread elastic through opening. Sew opening closed.

## HAT

With A and larger needles, cast on 93 (105) sts.
**1st row: (RS). K1. *ML. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: P1. *P2tog. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
3rd row: K2. *ML. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.
4th row: P2. *P2tog. P1. Rep from * to last st. P1.**

Rep from ** to ** twice more, dec
4 (5) sts evenly across last row. 89 (100) sts.

Change to MC and proceed as follows:
1st row: K1. *K2tog. K9. Rep from * to end of row. 81 (91) sts.

2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: K1. *K2tog. K8. Rep from * to end of row. 73 (82) sts.

4th row: Purl.
Cont in this manner, dec 8 (9) sts evenly across next and following alt rows until 17 (19) sts rem. Break yarn leaving a long end. Draw end through rem sts and fasten securely.

## MITTS <br> RIGHT MITT

Cuff: With A and larger needles, cast on 33 (37) sts.
Work from ** to ** twice as given for Hat, dec 1 st at center of last row. 32 (36) sts.
Change to MC and work 6 rows in stocking st.

Shape thumb: 1st row: K17 (19). Inc 1 st in each of next 2 sts. Knit to end of row.
2nd and alt rows: Purl.
3rd row: K17 (19). Inc 1 st in next st. K2. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of row.
5th row: K17 (19). Inc 1 st in next st. K4. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of row.
Cont in this manner, having 2 sts more between incs for thumb gusset every alt row to 40 (46) sts. Purl 1 row.

Make thumb: K27 (31). Turn. Cast on 1 st. P10 (12) including cast on st. Turn. Cast on 1 st.

Working on these 11 (13) sts cont even for $11 / 2(13 / 4)$ ins [4 (4.5) cm] ending with RS facing for next row.
Next row: K1. *K2tog. Rep from * to end of row. Break yarn. Thread end through rem sts. Draw up and fasten securely. Sew thumb seam.

With RS of work facing, join yarn to last st on right hand needle. Pick up and knit 2 sts at base of thumb. Knit across sts on left hand needle.
Next row: Purl across, purling tog 2 sts picked up at base of thumb. 32 (36) sts.
Cont even until work from beg measures $41 / 4\left(5^{1 / 4}\right)$ ins [11 (13) cm] ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top: 1st row: K1. SI1K. K1. psso. K10 (12). K2tog. K2. S11K. K1. psso. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.
2nd and alt rows: Purl.
3rd row: K1. SI1K. K1. psso. K8 (10). K2tog. K2. Sl1K. K1. psso. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.
5th row: K1. SI1K. K1. psso. K6 (8). K2tog. K2. SI1K. K1. psso. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.
Cont in this manner, having 2 sts less between decs every alt row to 16 sts. Cast off purlwise. Sew top and side seam.

## LEFT MITT

With A, work cuff as given for Right Mitt.
Change to MC and work 6 rows in stocking st.

Shape thumb: 1st row: K12 (14). Inc 1 st in each of next 2 sts. Knit to end of row.
2nd and alt rows: Purl.
3rd row: K12 (14). Inc 1 st in next st. K2. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of row.
5th row: K12 (14). Inc 1 st in next st. K4. Inc 1 st in next st. Knit to end of row.
Cont in this manner, having 2 sts more between incs for thumb gusset every alt row to 40 (46) sts. Purl 1 row.

Make thumb: K22 (26). Turn. Cast on 1 st. P10 (12) including cast on st.
Turn. Cast on 1 st. Working on these 11 (13) sts, finish thumb and remainder of mitt as given for Right Mitt.


## 三 Patons

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
