## TOASTY STRIPED SET (TO KNIT)

## SIZES <br> LEGWARMERS <br> To fit calf circumference <br> $6 / 8 \quad 16$ ins $\quad[40.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ <br> $10 / 1218$ ins [ 45.5 cm ]

## HAT

To fit child's head size 6/8 (10/12).

## TENSION

20 ts and 26 rows $=4$ ins [ 10 cm ] with larger needles in stocking st.

## MATERIALS

LEGWARMERS
Patons ${ }^{\circledR}$ Canadian (Variegated: $100 \mathrm{~g} / 3.5$ oz; $175 \mathrm{~m} / 192 \mathrm{yds}$ ) Sizes 6/8 10/12
$\begin{array}{llll}\text { Main Color (MC) } & 1 & 1 & \text { ball }\end{array}$
11712 (Happy Camper)
Patons ${ }^{\circledR}$ Canadian (Solids:100 g/3.5 oz; 187m / 205 dds)
$\begin{array}{llll}\text { Contrast A } & 1 & 1 & \text { ball }\end{array}$
10712 (Lime Juice)

HAT
Batons ${ }^{\circledR}$ Canadian (Variegated: $100 \mathrm{~g} / 3.5$ oz; $175 \mathrm{~m} / 192 \mathrm{yds}$ ) Sizes 6/8 10/12
$\begin{array}{llll}\text { Main Color (MC) } & 1 & 1 & \text { ball }\end{array}$
11712 (Happy Camper)
Patons ${ }^{\ominus}$ Canadian (Solids:100 g/3.5 oz; 187m / 205 dds)
$\begin{array}{llll}\text { Contrast A } & 1 & 1 & \text { ball }\end{array}$
10712 (Lime Juice)

Sets of four sizes 4 mm (U.S. 6) and 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) doublepointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain tension.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smaller size. If changes are necessary for larger size the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to both sizes.

LEGWARMERS (make 2).
With smaller needles and A, cast on 48 (60) str. Divide ats evenly on 3 needles. Join in ind, placing marker on first st.
Work in (K2. P2) ribbing until work from beg measures 3 ins [ 7.5 cm ].
Next rd: *K12 (15). M1. Rep from * around. 52 (64) sts.
Change to larger needles.
1st to 5th rods: With MC, knit.
fth rad: With A, knit.
7th rad: With A, purl.
8th rad: With A, knit.
These 8 rads form Pat.

ABBREVIATIONS: www.patonsyarns.com/abbreviations

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 15 (16) ins [38 (40.5) cm], ending with a 4th rnd.
Change to smaller needles.
Next rnd: With A, *K11(14). K2tog. Rep from * around. 48 (60) sts. With A, work in (K2. P2) ribbing for 3 ins [ 7.5 cm ].
Cast off in ribbing.

## HAT

With smaller needles and A, cast on 88 (104) sts. Divide sts evenly on 3 needles. Join in rnd, placing marker on first st.
Work in (K2.P2) ribbing for 2 ins [ 5 cm ].
Next rnd: *K2. M1. Rep from * around. 132 (156) sts.
Change to larger needles.
1st to 5th rnds: With MC, knit.
6th rnd: With A, knit.
7th rnd: With A, purl.
8th rnd: With A, knit.
These 8 rnds form Stripe Pat.
Rep these 8 rnds twice more.
Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, dec as follows:
Next rnd: *K7 (9). ssk. K2tog. Rep from * around. 108 (132) sts.
Work 4 rnds Stripe Pat.
Next rnd: *K5 (7). ssk. K2tog. Rep from * around. 84 (108) sts.
Work 4 rnds Stripe Pat.
Next rnd: *K3 (5). ssk. K2tog. Rep from * around. 60 (84) sts.
Work 4 rnds Stripe Pat.
Next rnd: *K1 (3). ssk. K2tog. Rep from * around. 36 (60) sts.
Work 4 rnds Stripe Pat.
Size 10/12 only: Next rnd: With MC, *K1. ssk. K2tog. Rep from * around. 48 sts.
Work 4 rnds Stripe Pat.
Both sizes: Next rnd: *SI1. K2tog. psso. Rep from * around. 12 (16) sts. Work 1 rnd Stripe Pat.
Next rnd: *K2tog. Rep from * around. 6 (8) sts.
Break yarn. Thread end through rem sts. Draw up tightly and fasten securely.
