## RUGGED TURTLENECK

### SIZES

#### Bust/chest measurement

<b>Small</b>	30-32 ins	[76-81	cm]
<b>Medium</b>	34-36 ins	[86-91	cm]
<b>Large</b>	38-40 ins	[97-102	cm]
<b>X-Large</b>	42-44 ins	[107-112	cm]

#### Finished bust/chest

<b>Small</b>	45 ins	[114.5	cm]
<b>Medium</b>	49 ins	[124.5	cm]
<b>Large</b>	52 ins	[132	cm]
<b>X-Large</b>	56 ins	[142	cm]

### TENSION

20 sts and 38 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] with 4.5 mm needles in pat

### MATERIALS

**Patons Decor** (100 g) or  
**Patons Classic Wool** (100 g/3.5 oz)

Size	S	M	L	XL
<b>Main Color (MC)</b> (Grey)	4	4	5	5 balls
<b>Contrast A</b> (Brown)	3	3	3	4 balls
<b>Contrast B</b> (White)	3	3	3	3 balls

Sizes 4 mm (U.S. 6) and 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain tension.** 2 st holders.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**Sl1P** = slip next st purlways.  
**yf** = take yarn to front of work.  
**yb** = take yarn to back of work.

### INSTRUCTIONS

*The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ).*

### BACK

\*\*With MC and smaller needles, cast on 102 (**110-118-126**) sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to end of row.

**2nd row:** P2. \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to end of row.

Rep these 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for 2½ ins [6 cm], ending on a 2nd row and inc 11 (**13-13-15**) sts evenly across last row. 113 (**123-131-141**) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows:

**1st and 2nd rows:** With MC, knit.

**3rd row:** With A, K1. \*Sl1P. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**4th row:** With A, K1. \*yf. Sl1P. yb. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**5th and 6th rows:** With B, knit.

**7th row:** With MC, K2. \*Sl1P. K1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**8th row:** With MC, K2. \*yf. Sl1P. yb. K1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**9th and 10th rows:** With A, knit.

**11th row:** With B, K1. \*Sl1P. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**12th row:** With B, K1. \*yf. Sl1P. yb. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**13th and 14th rows:** With MC, knit.

**15th row:** With A, K2. \*Sl1P. K1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**16th row:** With A, K2. \*yf. Sl1P. yb. K1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**17th and 18th rows:** With B, knit.

**19th row:** With MC, K1. \*Sl1P. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**20th row:** With MC, K1. \*yf. Sl1P. yb. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**21st and 22nd rows:** With A, knit.

**23rd row:** With B, K2. \*Sl1P. K1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**24th row:** With B, K2. \*yf. Sl1P. yb. K1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

These 24 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures 16½ (**16½-17-17**) ins [42 (**42-43-43**) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

**Armhole shaping:** Cast off 7 (**7-11-12**) sts beg next 2 rows. 99 (**109-109-117**) sts.\*\*

Cont in pat until work from beg measures 25½ (**26-27-27½**) ins [65 (**66-68.5-70**) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

**Shoulder shaping:** Cast off 10 (**11-11-13**) sts beg next 4 rows, then 11 (**13-13-13**) sts beg following 2 rows. Leave rem 37 (**39-39-39**) sts on a st holder.

### FRONT

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Back.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures 22 (**22¼-23¼-23½**) ins [56 (**57-59-59.5**) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

**Neck shaping: Next row:** Pat across 43 (48-48-52) sts (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next and following alt rows until there are 31 (35-35-39) sts.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

**Shoulder shaping:** Cast off 10 (11-11-13) sts beg next and following alt row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 11 (13-13-13) sts.

With RS of work facing slip next 13 sts from spare needle on a st holder. Join yarn to rem sts and pat to end of row.

Keeping cont of pat, dec 1 st at neck edge on next and following alt rows until there are 31 (35-35-39) sts.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

**Shoulder shaping:** Cast off 10 (11-11-13) sts beg next and following alt row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 11 (13-13-13) sts.

## SLEEVES

With MC and smaller needles cast on 46 (46-50-50) sts.

Work 2½ ins [6 cm] in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back, ending on a 2nd row and inc 9 (9-11-11) sts evenly across last row. 55 (55-61-61) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as given for Back, inc 1 st each end of needle on 5th and following 6th rows to 79 (81-87-93) sts, then every following 8th row to 91 (95-101-105) sts, taking inc sts into pat.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures 18½ (19-20¼-21¾) ins [47 (48.5-51.5-55) cm], ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

Place markers on side edges of Sleeves 1¼ (1¼-1¾-2) ins [3 (3-4.5-5) cm] down from cast off edge.

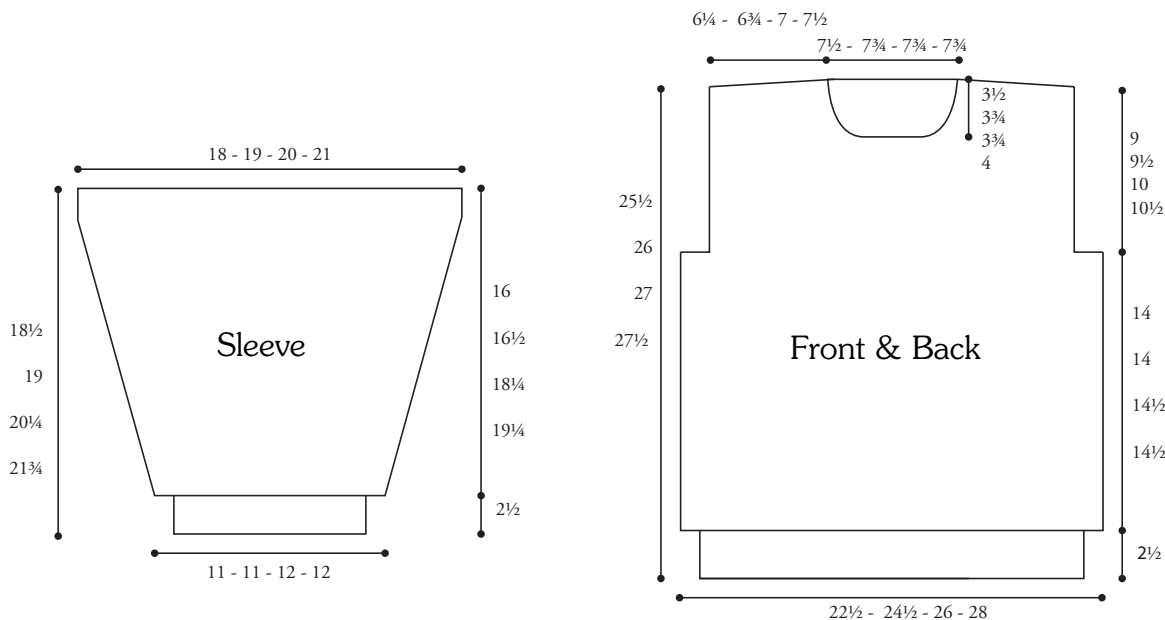
## FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements and cover with damp cloth leaving to dry.

**Collar:** Sew right shoulder seam. With RS of work facing, MC and smaller needles, pick up and knit 26 (27-27-29) sts down left front neck edge. Knit across 13 sts from front st holder. Pick up and knit 26 (27-27-29) sts up right front neck edge. Knit across 37 (39-39-39) sts from back st holder. 102 (106-106-110) sts. Beg and ending on a 2nd row, work 5½ ins [14 cm] in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back.

With larger needles, cont in ribbing until Collar measures 6 ins [15 cm], ending on a 2nd row. Cast off in ribbing. Place a marker on collar seam 3½ ins [9 cm] down from cast off edge. Sew left shoulder and Collar seam, reversing seam at marker for turnback.

Sew in Sleeves placing rows above markers along cast off sts at armholes of Front and Back to form square armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams



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
