



INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With A, work 10 rows stocking st.

With B, work 4 rows stocking st.

With A, knit 4 rows (2 garter ridges).

With C, work 8 rows stocking st.

With D, work 6 rows stocking st.

With C, knit 4 rows (2 garter ridges).

With E, work 12 rows stocking st.

With F, work 6 rows stocking st.

With E, knit 4 rows (2 garter ridges).

With B, work 10 rows stocking st.

With A, work 4 rows stocking st.

With B, knit 4 rows (2 garter ridges).

With D, work 8 rows stocking st.

With C, work 6 row stocking st.

With D, knit 4 rows (2 garter ridges).

With F, work 12 rows stocking st.

With E, work 6 rows stocking st.

With F, knit 4 rows (2 garter ridges).

These 116 rows form Stripe Pat.

With B, cast on 204 sts. **Do not** join in rnd. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit 7 rows, noting 1st row is WS and inc 27 sts evenly across last row. 231 sts.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). With A, K5. K2tog. *K8. (K1. yo. K1) all in next st. K8. S11. K2tog. pssso. Rep from * to last 24 sts. K8. (K1. yo. K1) all in next st. K8. ssk. K5.

2nd and alt rows (except garter ridges): K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last 2 rows, noting garter st ridges, until work from beg measures 60" [152.5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Next row: With appropriate color, knit, dec 27 sts evenly across. 204 sts. Knit 5 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS).

SPICY CHEVRON BLANKET (TO KNIT)

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 60" [127 x 152.5 cm]

MATERIALS

Patons® Canadiana™ (100 g/3.5 oz; 205 yds/187 m)

Contrast A Crantini (10522) **2** **balls**

Contrast B Burgundy (10430) **2** **balls**

Contrast C Fool's Gold (10610) **2** **balls**

Contrast D Burnt Orange (10630) **2** **balls**

Contrast E Cedar Green (10247) **2** **balls**

Contrast F Dk Green Tea (10237) **2** **balls**

Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) circular knitting needle 40" [100 cm] long **or size needed to obtain tension.**

TENSION

19 sts and 25 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

Alt = Alternate(ing)

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dec = Decrease(ing)

Inc = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch.

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Pat = Pattern

Pssso = Pass slipped stitch over

Rep = Repeat

Rnd = Round

S11 = Slip next stitch knitwise

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yo = Yarn over
