



Cables (to knit)

Measurement

Approx 41 x 56 ins [104 x 142 cm]

Materials

Patons® Decor (100 g/3.5 oz)
Main Colour (MC) (Blue) **11 balls**
Contrast A (Variegated) **10 balls**

Size 6 mm (U.S. 10) circular knitting needle 90 cm long **or size needed to obtain tension.** One cable needle.

Tension

19 sts and 18 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] in pat with 2 strands of yarn.

Abbreviation

C11F = slip next 5 sts onto a cable needle and leave at front of work. (K2. P1) twice, then (K2. P1. K2) from cable needle.

Instructions

With 2 strands of MC cast on 205 sts.

Do not join.

Working back and forth across needle, proceed as follows:

***1st row:** (Right side). P1. *K2. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: *K1. P2. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Rep last 2 rows once more.**

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (Right side). With A, P1. (K2. P1) 4 times. [With MC, (K2. P1) 4 times. With A, (K2. P1) 4 times] 8 times.

2nd row: [With A, (K1. P2) 4 times. With MC, (K1. P2) 4 times] 8 times. With A, (K1. P2) 4 times. K1.

3rd, 5th and 7th rows: As 1st row.

9th row: With A, P1. (K2. P1) 4 times. [With MC, C11F. P1. With A, (K2. P1) 4 times] 8 times.

11th, 13th, 15th and 17th rows: As 1st row.

19th row: As 9th row.

21st, 23rd, 25th and 27th rows: As 1st row.

29th row: With A, P1. C11F. P1. [With MC, (K2. P1) 4 times. With A, C11F. P1] 8 times.

31st, 33rd, 35th and 37th rows: As 1st row.

39th row: As 29th row.

40th row: As 2nd row.

These 40 rows complete one pat.

Rep these 40 rows 5 times more, then 1st to 28th rows once.

With MC, rep from ** to ** once. Cast off in ribbing.

FINISHING

Tassels: (make 16). Cut a piece of cardboard 8½ ins [21.5 cm] wide. Wind MC around cardboard 25 times. Break yarn leaving a long end and thread end through a needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops ¾ inch [2 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim ends evenly.

Sew tassels to ends of throw corresponding with each stripe in MC as illustrated.
