PATONS® DECOR STRIPES AND CHECKS

MEASUREMENTS

Afghan: Approx 49 ins x 58 ins
[124.5 x 147 cm] (excluding fringe)

Pillow: Approx 18 ins [45.5 cm]
square

MATERIALS

Patons® Decor (100 g/3.5 oz)

Afghan

Main color (MC): (Navy) **4 balls**

Contrast A: (Blue) **4 balls**

Contrast B: (Burgundy) **4 balls**

Contrast C: (Green) **2 balls**

Contrast D: (Taupe) **1 ball**

Pillow

Main color (MC): (Navy) **2 balls**

Contrast A: (Blue) **1 ball**

Contrast B: (Burgundy) **1 ball**

Contrast C: (Green) **1 ball**

Contrast D: (Taupe) **1 ball**

Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) circular knitting
needle 90 cm long **or size needed to
obtain tension.** 5 buttons and 18 ins
[45.5 cm] square pillow form.

TENSION

18 sts and 24 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] in
stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Afghan

With A, cast on 209 sts. **Do not
join.** Working back and forth across
needle, proceed as follows:

1st to 10th rows: With A, work in
stocking st.

****11th row:** With B, knit.

12th row: With B, purl.

13th row: *With MC, K1. With D,
K1. Rep from * to last st. With MC,
K1.

14th row: *With D, P1. With MC,
P1. Rep from * to last st. With D, P1.

15th row: With C, knit.

16th row: With C, purl.

17th to 26th rows: With MC, work
in stocking st.

27th row: With A, knit.

28th row: With A, purl.

29th and 30th rows: As 13th and
14th rows.

31st row: With A, knit.

32nd row: With A, purl.

33rd to 42nd rows: With B, work in
stocking st.

43rd row: With C, knit.

44th row: With C, purl.

45th and 46th rows: As 13th and
14th rows.

47th row: With C, knit.

48th row: With C, purl.**

Rep last 48 rows 6 times more.

Next 10 rows: With A, work in
stocking st.

Cast off.

SIDE EDGING

With RS of work facing and B, pick
up and knit 217 sts along each side
edge.

1st row: (WS). With B, knit.

2nd and 3rd rows: With C, knit.

4th and 5th rows: With B, knit.

6th and 7th rows: With A, knit.

8th and 9th rows: With B, knit.

10th and 11th rows: With MC,
knit.

12th row: With B, knit.

With B, cast off knitwise.

Fringe: Cut 14 inch [35.5 cm]
lengths of MC, A, B, and C. Taking
6 strands tog, make into fringe in the
following sequence: MC, B, A, C,
beg at lower right corner.

Pillow

FRONT

With A, cast on 81 sts.

Work 6 rows stocking st.

Rep from ** to ** as given for
Afghan.

With A, work 10 rows stocking st.

Rep from ** to ** as given for
Afghan.

With A, work 6 rows stocking st.

Next row: With MC, knit.

Next row: With MC, *K1. P1. Rep
from * to last st. K1.

Last row forms seed st pat.

Rep last row 3 times more.

Next row: (RS). Seed st pat across
4 sts. *Cast off 2 sts. Seed st pat
across 16 sts (including st on needle
after cast off). Rep from * to last
5 sts. Cast off 2 sts. Seed st pat to
end of row.

Next row: Work in seed st pat,
casting on 2 sts over cast off sts.

Work a further 4 rows in seed st pat.
Cast off in pat.

BACK

With MC, cast on 81 sts.

Work 109 rows in stocking st.

Next row: (WS). Knit (fold line).

Work 10 rows in seed st pat. Cast off
in pat.

FINISHING

Sew 3 sides of Front and Back of
Pillow tog beg and ending at fold line
of Back, leaving open at buttonhole
end. Fold Back inside along fold line
and sew sides in position. Sew buttons
to correspond to buttonholes. Insert
pillow form. Close buttons.
