

## MATERIALS

Patons ${ }^{\oplus}$ Inspired ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $5.3 \mathrm{oz} / 150 \mathrm{~g} ; 222 \mathrm{yds} / 203 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Rich Teal (92023) 2 balls
Contrast B Olive (92029) 1 ball
Contrast C Teal (92022) 2 balls
Contrast D Soft Cream (92001) 2 balls
Contrast E Sapphire Teal (92017) 2 balls
Contrast F Honey Spice (92036) 1 ball
Contrast G Raspberry (92038) 1 ball
Size U.S. 10 ( 6 mm ) circular knitting needle 36 " [ 91.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS
Approx = Approximately
Beg $=$ Beginning
Cont $=$ Continue(ity)
K = Knit
$\mathbf{K f b}=$ Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch
K2tog $=$ Knit next 2 stitches
together
P = Purl
P2tog $=$ Purl next 2 stitches together

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $501 / 2$ " $\times 60$ " $[128.5 \times 152.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

## GAUGE

14 sts and 19 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Note:

Digital Chevron Pat is worked over 200 sts - multiple of 38 sts +10 .

## Stripe Pat

With A, work 8 rows.
With B, work 4 rows. With C, work 2 rows.
With D, work 2 rows.
With E, work 8 rows.

P2togtbl = Purl next 2 stitches together through back of loops Pat = Pattern
$\mathbf{P f b}=$ Increase 1 stitch by purling into front and back of next stitch
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
$\mathbf{S t}(\mathbf{s})=$ Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS $=$ Wrong side

With F, work 2 rows.
With G, work 2 rows.
With A, work 4 rows.
With B, work 2 rows.
With C, work 8 rows.
With D, work 4 rows. With E, work 2 rows. With F, work 8 rows. With G, work 2 rows. With A, work 2 rows. With B, work 2 rows. With C, work 8 rows. With D, work 4 rows. With E, work 2 rows. With F, work 2 rows. With G, work 4 rows. These 82 rows form Stripe Pat.

## BLANKET

With D, cast on 200 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Bottom Garter St Edging: 1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: *K10. Kfb. K6. K2tog. K10. K2tog. K6. Kfb. Rep from * to last 10 sts. K10.
Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice more (total of 6 rows). Break D. Join A.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows: 1st row: With A, knit.
2nd row: K4. P6. Pfb. P6. P2togtbl. P10. P2tog. P6. Pfb. *P10. Pfb. P6. P2togtbl. P10. P2tog. P6. Pfb. Rep from * to last 10 sts. P6. K4.
Last 2 rows form Digital Chevron Pat. First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Cont in Digital Chevron Pat, keeping cont of Stripe Pat, until work from beg along side edge measures 59" [150 cm], ending on a WS row. Break yarn. Join D.

## Top Garter St Edging: 1st row:

(RS). With D, knit.
2nd row: *K10. Kfb. K6. K2tog. K10. K2tog. K6. Kfb. Rep from * to last 10 sts. K10.
Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice more (total of 6 rows).
Cast off knitwise.

## FINISHING

Fringe: Cut strands of D 10" [25.5 cm ] long. Taking 3 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe through every $2 n d$ st along edge of Top and Bottom Garter Edging. Trim fringe evenly in same chevron shape as Edging.
