Peaches \& Crème ${ }^{\oplus}$ Cone ( $14 \mathrm{oz} / 400 \mathrm{~g} ; 674 \mathrm{yds} / 616 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Main Color (MC) White (01005) 1 cone or 635 yds/581 m
Peaches \& Crème ${ }^{\oplus}$ ( $2.5 \mathrm{oz} / 70.9 \mathrm{~g} ; 120 \mathrm{yds} / 109 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Pastel Pink (11421)
Contrast B Red (11095)
Contrast C Sunshine (11612)
1 ball or $27 \mathrm{yds} / 25 \mathrm{~m}$

Contrast D Bright Orange (11628)
1 ball or $36 \mathrm{yds} / 33 \mathrm{~m}$

Contrast E Black Currant (11318)
Contrast F Mint (11230)
Size U.S. H/8 ( 5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 21" x 34" [ $53.5 \times 86.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Bath Mat

With MC, ch 69.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 68 sc.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures $34 "[86.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.
Fasten off.

## TAKE IT EASY:

T (make 1 each with B and C-see diagram on page 4):
Start working from top, ch 14.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 13 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

## Fasten off.

Next row: Skip first 5 sc of last row. Join yarn with sl st to next sc. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Turn. Leave rem sts unworked. 3 sc .
Next row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Turn.
Rep last row until T measures 5 " [12.5 cm], ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

A (make 1 each with $F$ and $C$ - see diagram on page 4):
Legs: Start working from top, ch 4. 1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 3 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 5 sc . 3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Turn. 6 sc .
4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Turn. Leave rem sts unworked. 3 sc .
5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Turn.
Rep 5th row until Leg from beg measures 5" [12.5 cm]. ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

With WS facing, join yarn with sl st to rem sc of 3rd row.
1st row: (WS). Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st . 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Turn. 3 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until Leg from beg measures 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

Bar: Ch 4.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 3 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 2 " $[5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on a RS row.
Fasten off.

E (make 1 each with A and E- see diagram on page 4): Ch 18.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 17 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked. 3 sc .
4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 4th row until Arm measures 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

Arms: **With RS facing, skip next 4 sc of 2nd row. Join yarn with sl st to next sc.
1st row: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Turn. 3 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until Arm measures 3" [7.5 cm ], ending on a RS row. Fasten off.**

Rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to ** once more.
K: With D, ch 18. (See diagram on page 4).
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 17 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Fasten off.

Legs: With RS facing, skip first 7 sc . Join D with sl st to next sc.
1st row: (RS). Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Turn. 5 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 2 sc . 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Turn. 6 sc .

Divide for lower leg: 3rd row: Ch 1.2 sc in first sc. Sc2tog. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked. 3 sts.
4th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 2 sc in last sc. Turn.
Rep 3rd and 4th rows until lower Leg measures 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

Upper Leg: With RS facing, join D with sl st to next sc of 2nd row of Legs.
1st row: (RS). Ch 1. Sc2tog. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 3 sts.
2nd row: Ch 1.2 sc in next sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 3 sc .
Rep 1st and 2nd rows until Leg measures 3 " $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

I: With E, ch 4. (See diagram on page 5).
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 3 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 5 " [ 12.5 cm ], ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

## "arnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

Y: Start working from bottom, with F, ch 4. (See diagram on page 5).
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 3 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 2" [5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Arms: 1st row: (RS). Ch 1.2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 5 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 2 sc .2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Turn. 6 sc .

Divide for Right and Left Arms: 3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 3 sc . Turn. Leave rem sts unworked. 4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Turn.
Rep last row until Arm measures $21 / 2$ " 6.5 cm ], ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

Left Arm: With RS facing, join F with sl st to next sc of 2nd row. 1st row: (RS). Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st . 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Turn. 3 sc .

2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Turn.
Rep last row until Arm measures $21 / 22^{\prime \prime}[6.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$, ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

S: With B, ch 37. (See diagram on page 5).
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next ch. ( 2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch) 4 times. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch . (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 ch$) 4$ times. Turn. 36 sts.
2nd row: Ch 1. ( 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Sc2tog) 4 times. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc . ( 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc$) 4$ times. 36 sc . Fasten off.

Using running st, sew all letters to Bathmat as shown in assembly diagram.

## Assembly Diagram



Fringe: Cut strands of $A, B, C, D$, E, and F 8" [20 cm] long. Taking 3 strands of each shade tog, fold in half and knot into fringe across sides of Bathmat as shown in photo. Trim fringe evenly.
