<b>Peaches &amp; Creme®</b> (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)	
<b>Contrast A</b> Ecru (11006)	<b>2 balls or 239 yds/218 m</b>
<b>Contrast B</b> Mint (11230)	<b>1 ball or 46 yds/42 m</b>
<b>Contrast C</b> Bright Orange (11628)	<b>1 ball or 63 yds/57 m</b>
<b>Contrast D</b> Pastel Pink (11421)	<b>1 ball or 64 yds/59 m</b>
<b>Contrast E</b> Bright Blue (11742)	<b>1 ball or 75 yds/69 m</b>
<b>Contrast F</b> Gold (11605)	<b>1 ball or 26 yds/24 m</b>
<b>Contrast G</b> Black Currant (11318)	<b>1 ball or 29 yds/27 m</b>
<b>Contrast H</b> Red (11095)	<b>1 ball or 62 yds/57 m</b>

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
20" [51 cm] square pillow form.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**WS** = Wrong side

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 20" [51 cm] square.

## GAUGE

13 dc and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm]

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- Ch 3 at beg of rnd counts as dc.
- Join each rnd with sl st to top of beg ch-3.
- RS of work is facing when working rnds.

## Stripe Pat

With A, work 1 rnd.

With B, work 1 rnd.

With C, work 1 rnd.

With A, work 1 rnd.

With D, work 1 rnd.

With E, work 1 rnd.

With A, work 1 rnd.

With F, work 1 rnd.

With G, work 1 rnd.

With A, work 1 rnd.

With C, work 1 rnd.

With B, work 1 rnd.

With A, work 1 rnd.

With D, work 1 rnd.

With E, work 1 rnd.

With A, work 1 rnd.

With H, work 1 rnd.

These 17 rnds form Stripe Pat.

**FRONT and BACK** (make 2 pieces alike)

**Notes:**

- Ch 3 at beg of rnd counts as dc.
- Join all rnds with sl st to top of ch 3.

With A, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

**1st rnd:** Ch 3. 2 dc in ring. (Ch 3. 3 dc) 3 times in ring. Ch 3. Join. Fasten off.

**2nd rnd:** Join B with sl st in any ch-3 sp. Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in same sp as last sl st. \*Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 sp. Rep from \* twice more. Ch 1. Join. Fasten off.

**3rd rnd:** Join C with sl st to any corner ch-3 sp. Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in same sp as last sl st. \*Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* twice more. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Join.

**4th rnd:** Join A with sl st to any corner ch-3 sp. Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in same sp as last sl st. \*(Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* twice more. (Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to end of rnd. Ch 1. Join. Fasten off.

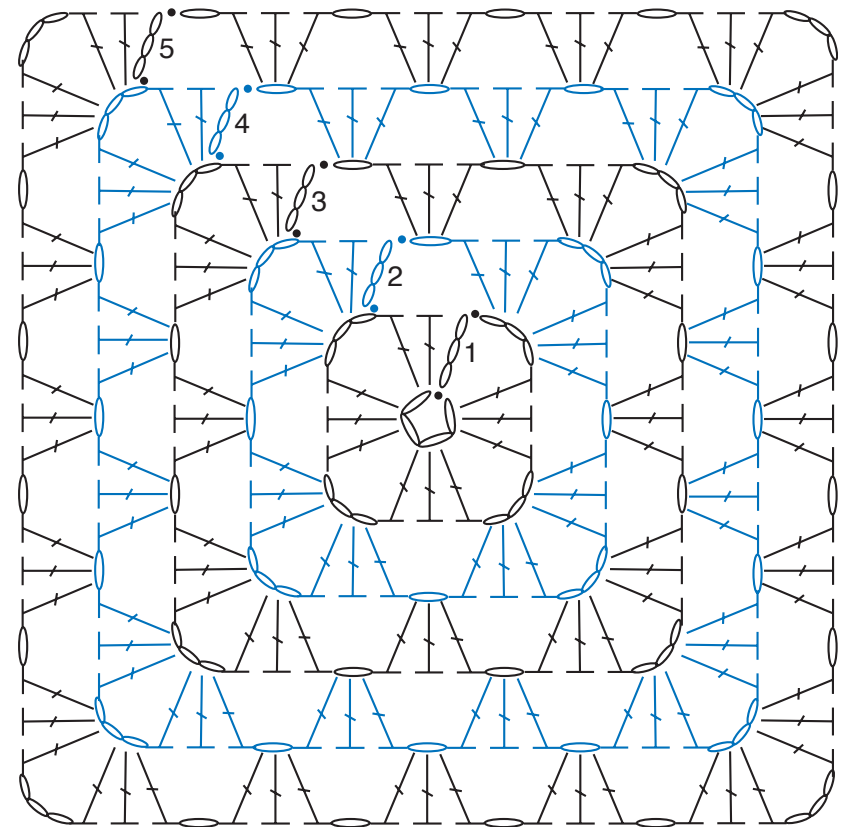
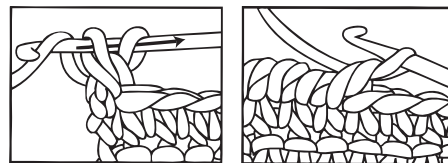
First 4 rnds of Stripe Pat are complete.

Rep 4th rnd until all 17 rnds of Stripe Pat are worked, joining with A at end of last rnd. **Do not** fasten off.

**Next rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each st around, working 5 sc in each corner ch-3 sp. Join. Fasten off.

**Joining rnd:** With WS facing tog, join A with sl st to any sc. *Working through both thicknesses, and working from left to right, instead of from right to left as usual, work reverse sc evenly around 3 sides having 3 sc in each corner sc. Insert pillow form. Work in reverse sc to end of rnd. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.*
