



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through the back loops together.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yo = Yarn over

MEASUREMENT

Approx 10" [25.5 cm] square

GAUGE

20 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Carry color not in use loosely along side of work.

With A, cast on 51 sts (multiple of 12 sts + 3).

Knit 4 rows, noting 1st row is WS.

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (WS). Knit. Break A. Join B.

2nd row: With B, K2. *ssk. K3. yo. K1. yo. K3. K2tog. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

3rd row: Knit. Break B. Join A.

4th row: With A, as 2nd row. Rep last 4 rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 9½" [24 cm], ending on a 4th row of pat.

With A, knit 4 rows (garter st).

Cast off knitwise (WS).

MATERIALS

Peaches & Creme® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Contrast A Mint (11230) or Sunshine (11612) or Pastel Pink (11421) **1 ball or 55 yds/50 m**

Contrast B White (11005) **1 ball or 28 yds/25.5 m**

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle.
