What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Sashay Metallic™: 1 ball each 1961 Icy Mint A and 1990 Icy Peri B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
16mm [US Q]

Large bar and ring (toggle) clasp,
straight pins, sewing needle and
matching thread

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for
this project.



RED HEART® Boutique Sashay Metallic™, Art. E782M, available in 3.5 oz (100g), 30 yd (27m) balls



Woven Necklace

You are used to seeing Sashay yarn used to seeing Sashay yarn used for ruffled scarves, but here is a stunning alternative. Using it as it comes off the ball, first chain it and then weave the chains. In little time you will have the perfect wardrobe accessory.

Necklace measures 27" (68.5 cm) long.
Center woven square measures 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm).

Notes

1. Necklace is made from 6 lengths of yarn worked off the ball (not spread open or ruffled) and then woven together.
2. Refer to weaving diagram to create center square.

NECKLACE

Cords (make 6 – 3 with A and 3 with B)

Leaving a 5" (12.5 cm) tail, ch 38. Fasten off, leaving a 5" (12.5 cm) tail.

Woven Square

Fold **A** cords in half and place on work surface to your left as shown in Weaving Diagram, ensuring that ends are even.

Refer to **Weaving Diagram**. Beginning with cord near folded edge, weave **B** cord under and over **A** cords 3 times. Gently pull **B** cord through until half the cord is woven.

With other end of same **B** cord, weave over and under **A** cords 3 times. Optional: Temporarily secure these cord lengths with sewing pins before weaving remaining cords. Weave remaining **B** cords in the same manner. Adjust cords so all weaving is even and remaining lengths of cords are evenly aligned. Push or pull cords as needed to close any visible spaces between cords.

FINISHING

Tie each pair of cord lengths together in overhand knots at edges of Woven Square, keeping finished lengths even.

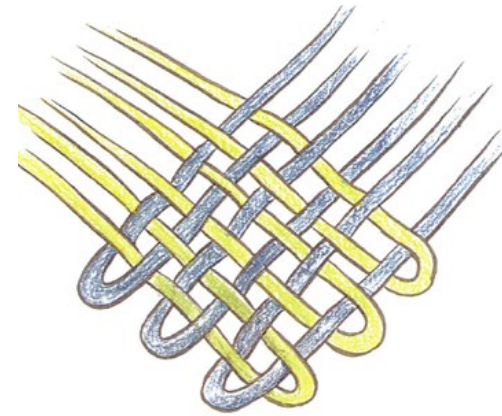
Tie all three **A** tails together in an overhand knot at end of chains; repeat with the three **B** tails. Trim these tails to 2" (5 cm).

Cut a 3" (7.5 cm) length of each yarn and spread open. To encase tail ends, wrap each length of yarn around matching tail and pin in place, turning in cut edge for a smoother finish; sew to secure.

Sew toggle clasp pieces to ends of necklace.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B = Color A, Color B; **ch** = chain.
