What you will need:
RED HEART® Heads Up ${ }^{\text {TM }: ~} 1$ ball each 530 Magenta A and 852 Navy B

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [US I-9]

Stitch markers, yarn needle
GAUGE: 4 repeats and 7 rows dc in pattern $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles/hook to obtain the gauge given.



## Wavy Long Wristers

This clever wavy stitch pattern looks great while keeping arms warm. Choose any two shades of this bulky yarn to quickly crochet a pair for yourself or to gift to your best buds!

Wristers measure 12 " ( 30.5 cm ) long by 8 " ( 20.5 cm ) in circumference.

## Special Stitches

dc2tog $=$ [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

## Note

To change colors, complete last dc with first color, then insert hook into 3rd ch of beginning ch-4. Drop first color and draw new color up through ch and loop on hook, joining round with a slip st. Continue with the new color. Carry the first color inside the piece and bring it up again when needed. Change color at the end of each round.

## WRISTER (Make 2)

With A, ch 24. Being careful not to twist, join with slip st in first ch. Place marker at beginning of round and move up as work progresses.
Round 1 (Right side): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch-1), dc in same ch, *skip 2 ch, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch; repeat from * around, skip last 2 ch-8 repeats. Change color with B.
Round 2: Ch 4, dc in same space, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * around. Change color with A .
Round 3: Repeat Round 2 using color $\mathbf{A}$ Change color with B.
Round 4 (Thumb shaping): Ch 4, dc in same space, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * around to last repeat; ch 6 to form hole for thumb; change color with A-8 repeats, ch-6.
Round 5: Ch 4, dc in same space, ${ }^{\star}(\mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 , dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * around; work (dc, ch 1, dc; dc, ch 1, dc) in last ch-6; change color-10 repeats.

Round 6: Ch 4, dc in same space, ${ }^{*}(\mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 , dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * around; change color.
Round 7: Ch 4, dc in same space, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * around to last 2 repeats; dc in each ch- 1 space; change color-8 repeats, 2 dc .
Round 8: Ch 4, dc in same space, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * around to last 2 dc ; dc2tog; change color-8 repeats, dc2tog.
Round 9: Ch 4, dc in same space, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * around; skip last dc2tog; change color-8 repeats.
Rounds 10-13: Ch 4, dc in same space, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * around; change color.
Round 14 (Increase for forearm): Ch 4, dc in same space, ${ }^{*}$ (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * around; work (dc, ch 1 , dc) in space before joining; change color- 9 repeats.
Rounds 15-17: Ch 4, dc in same space, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * around; change color.
Rounds 18-21: Repeat Rounds 14-17-10 repeats. Fasten off yarn; weave in ends.

$A, B=$ Color $A$, Color B; ch = chain; $\mathbf{c m}=$ centimeters; dc = double crochet; $\mathrm{mm}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{s c}=$ single crochet; $\operatorname{st}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
