## What you will need:

RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Saver®: Color Version 1: 1 skein each of 530 Orchid $\mathrm{A}(\mathrm{MC})$ and 358 Lavender B
Color Version 2: 1 skein each of 505 Aruba Sea A (MC) and 886 Blue B

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 13 sts $=(10 \mathrm{~cm}) ; 8$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in hdc. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

## Tween Style Wristers

These wristers can be crocheted in just one piece, working in one color from start to finish, but you can really step up the style by adding a few stripes as written!

Directions are given for size child's Small. Changes for Medium and Large are in parentheses.

Wristers measure $61 / 2(71 / 2,81 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ ( 16.5 [19, 24] cm) around; 6 ( $61 / 2,61 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ ( 15 [16.5, 16.5] cm) long.

## WRISTER (make 2) <br> Cuff

With A, ch 9 .
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn - 8 sc .
Row 2-21 (24, 27): Ch 1, working in back loop only, sc in each sc across, turn -8 sc.
Assembly: Fold Cuff in half, matching sts in last row with foundation ch at base of row 1 , working through double thickness, slip st in each st across. Turn cuff inside out to hide slip st seam. Do not fasten off.

## Body

Size Small only
Round 1: Ch 1 (does not count as a st here and throughout), working in row-end sts of cuff, hdc in each st around cuff edge hdc; join with slip st in first hdc - 21 hdc. Fasten off A, join B.
Round 2: With B, ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc - 21 sc. Fasten off B, join A.
Round 3-4: With A, ch 1, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in first hdc. Fasten off A, join B.
Round 5: Repeat Round 2
Round 6: With A, ch 1, *hdc in each of next 6 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first hdc - 24 hdc.
Round 7: Ch 1, hdc in first st, skip next 6 sts (for thumb hole), hdc in each of last 17 sts; join with slip st in first hdc - 18 hdc. Fasten off A, join B.

Round 8: Repeat Round 2 - 18 sc. Fasten off $B$, join $A$.
Round 9-10: Repeat Round 3 - 18 hdc. Fasten off $A$, join $B$.
Round 11: Repeat Round 2 - 18 sc. Fasten off B.

## Size Medium only

Round 1: Ch 1 (does not count as a st here and throughout), working in row-end sts of cuff, hdc in each st around cuff edge hdc; join with slip st in first hdc - 24 hdc. Fasten off A, join B.
Round 2: Ch 1, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in first hdc.
Round 3: With B, ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc - 24 sc. Fasten off B, join A.
Round 4-5: With A, ch 1, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in first hdc. Fasten off A, join B.
Round 6: Repeat Round 3
Round 7: With A, ch 1, *hdc in each of next 7 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first hdc - 27 hdc.
Round 8: Ch 1, hdc in first st, skip next 6 sts (for thumb hole), hdc in each of last 20 sts; join with slip st in first hdc - 21 hdc. Fasten off $A$, join B.
Round 9: Repeat Round 3 - 21 sc. Fasten off B, join A.
Round 10-11: Repeat Round 4 - 21 hdc.
Fasten off A, join B.
Round 12: Repeat Round 3 - 21 sc. Fasten off B.

## Size Large only

Round 1: Ch 1 (does not count as a st here and throughout), working in row-end sts of cuff, hdc in each st around cuff edge hdc; join with slip st in first hdc - 27 hdc. Fasten off A, join B.

Continued...

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Round 2: Ch 1, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in first hdc.
Round 3: With B, ch 1 , sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc - 27 sc. Fasten off B, join A.
Round 4-5: With A , ch 1 , hdc in each st around; join with slip st in first hdc. Fasten off A, join B.
Round 6: Repeat Round 3.
Round 7: With MC, ch 1, [hdc into the next 8 stitches, work 2 hdc into the following] 3 times, slip stitch to first hdc to join - 30 hdc. Round 8: Ch 1, hdc in first st, skip next 7 sts (for thumb hole), hdc in each of last 20 sts; join with slip st in first hdc - 23 hdc. Fasten off $A$, join B.
Round 9: Repeat Round 3 - 23 sc. Fasten off B, join A.
Round 10-11: Repeat Round 4 - 23 hdc.
Fasten off $\mathbf{A}$, join $\mathbf{B}$
Round 12: Repeat Round $3-23 \mathrm{sc}$. Fasten off B.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
