What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Treasure™: 1 ball of 1901 Mosaic

Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks: 6.0mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle Three ¾" (2 cm) buttons

GAUGE: 15 sts and 8 rows in pattern = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Button Up Neck Warmer

This quick to crochet accessory can be made in any color of this beautiful yarn that changes shades as you stitch. It's perfect to give as a gift!

One size fits most

Neck warmer measures 6¼ wide x 29" long (16 x 73.5 cm)

STITCH PATTERN

Ch a multiple of 7 + 3.

Row 1 (wrong side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, ch 2, skip next 2 ch, sc in next ch, *ch 3, skip next ch, sc in next ch, ch 4, skip next 4 ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across to last 5 ch, ch 3, skip next ch, sc in next ch, ch 2, skip next 2 ch, sc in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 2, *4 dc in next ch-4 space, ch 2, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 2; rep from * across, ending with 2 dc in last ch-2 space, dc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in next ch-2 space, ch 3, sc in next ch-2 space, *ch 4, sc in next ch-2 space, ch 3, sc in next ch-2 space; repeat from * across, ending with ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in top of ch-3 turning ch, turn.

Repeat Rows 2-3 for pattern.

NECK WARMER

Ch 24.

Work in stitch pattern until piece measures 29" (73.5) from beginning, ending with Row 2 of pattern. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew 3 buttons evenly spaced along foundation-chain end of scarf. Fold scarf so that foundation chain end lies alongside last 6" (15.2 cm) of scarf (see photo). Button, using ch-2 spaces along edge of scarf as buttonholes.

Abbreviations

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
