

WARM & SHINE SCARF & HEADBAND | CROCHET

SHOP KIT



Warm & Shine Scarf & Headband

Create this matching hat and headband with a little sparkle. It is made with two colors using a super fine weight yarn. Perfect for Fall, Winter or Spring.

Designed by Joyce Bragg.

Scarf measures $4\frac{1}{2}$ " wide x 48" long. Headband measures: 4" wide x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ (20)" long.

RED HEART® Stardust: 2 skeins 1805 Blue **A**; 1 skein

1623 Green **B**.

Crochet Hook: 4.25 mm [US G-7].

Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4"; 14 rows = 4". CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

3-hdc cluster (cl) = [Yo, insert hook in space, yo, draw yarn through st] 3 times in same space, yo, draw yarn through 7 loops on hook.

Foundation single crochet (fsc) = First St: Ch 2, insert hook under top 2 strands of first ch, yo, draw up a loop, yo, draw through 1 loop, yo, draw through both loops (first fsc complete). Remaining sts: Insert hook under both loops of previous st, yo, draw up a loop, yo, draw through 1 loop, yo, draw through both loops.

NOTE: Chain 2 counts as hdc throughout. All stitches are worked into the top and the back loop of the indicated stitch to form a ridge in the completed row.

SCARF

With **A**, fsc 24; ch 1, turn to work into sc side of foundation ch.

Row 1: Hdc in the next 2 sts, *ch 1, skip next st, cl in next st, ch 1, skip next st, hdc in the next 5 sts; repeat from * once; ch 1, skip next st, cl in the next st, skip next st, hdc in the next 3 sts; ch 2, turn – 3 cl, 6 ch-1 spaces, 16 hdc sts.

Row 2: Hdc in the next 2 sts, *cl in ch-1 space, ch 1, cl in the next ch-1 space, hdc in the next 5 sts; repeat from * once; cl in ch-1 space, ch 1, cl in the next ch-1 space, hdc in the next 3 sts; ch 2, turn – 6 cl, 3 ch-1 spaces, 16 hdc sts.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 following the scarf stripe sequence until scarf measures 48 inches long. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Scarf Stripe Sequence: Work 9 rows with **A**, 3 rows with **B**, 3 rows with **A**, 3 rows with **B**, *15 rows with **A**, 7 rows with **B**, 15 rows with **A**, 3 rows with **B**, 3 rows with **A**, 3 rows with **B**, repeat from * three times, then 9 rows with **A**.

FINISHING

Fringe

Cut 12 10" long strands of **A** and **B*** Holding 2 strands of **A** and 2 strands of **B** together, fold in half. Insert hook in first ch of foundation row, pull up loop, then pull all strands through loop. Skip 3 ch and repeat from * 5 times. Attach fringe to the stitches on the opposite end of scarf in the same manner.





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HEADBAND

With A, Fsc 20; ch 2, turn to work into sc side of foundation ch.

Row 1: Hdc in the next 4 sts, *ch 1, skip next st, cl in the next st, ch 1, skip next st, hdc in the next 5 sts; repeat from * across; ch 2, turn – 2 cl, 4 ch-1 spaces, 15 hdc sts.

Row 2: Hdc in the next 4 sts, *cl in the next ch-1 space, ch 1, skip next st, cl in the next ch-1 space, hdc in the next 5 sts; repeat from * across; ch 2, turn – 4 cl, 2 ch-1 spaces, 15 hdc sts.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 following the headband stripe sequence until piece measures 18½" (20") long. Fasten off.

Headband Stripe Sequence: For 18½" (20") headband, work 9 (12) rows with **A**, 3 rows with **B**, 3 rows with **A**, 3 rows with **B**, 9 rows with **A**, 3 rows with **B**, 3 rows with **A**, 3 rows with **B**, 3 rows with **A**, 3 rows with **B**, 9 (12) rows with **A**.

Lining

With **A**, fsc 20; ch 3, turn to work into sc side of foundation ch.

Row 1: Dc in each st across; ch 3, turn - 20 sts

Repeat Row 1 until piece measures 18½" (20") long. Fasten off.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, sew long edges of both pieces together. Turn inside out. Sew ends of lining edge together, inserting needle in each st on each end. Sew the outside edges together in the same manner. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C etc; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
