## Funky Spats

Keep your ankles warm while polishing off your look with these crocheted spats! This is a great gift for the fashion savvy!

## LW2410



Ankle Circumference: 11 (12, 13)"
Spat Length: 5½"
STITCH NATION® "Full O'Sheep ${ }^{\text {TM } ": ~} 1$ Ball each 2925
Passionfruit A and 2012 Black Sheep B.

GAUGE: 13 hdc = 4"; 14 rows = 4" using smaller hook. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## LEFT SPAT <br> Foot Edge

With A, ch $47(50,54)$.
Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each ch across.
Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), turn, hdc in each hdc across - $45(48,52)$ hdc.
Rows 3-4: Repeat Row 2.
Rows 5-13: Ch 2, turn, skip next hdc, hdc in each hdc across - $36(39,43)$ hdc.
Row 14: Ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across.

## Ruffle Edging

Row 15: Change to B, ch 1, turn to work along side edge, work 15 hdc evenly spaced along rows of side edge, ch 1 , turn to work opposite foundation ch, hdc in each st across, ch 1 , turn to work along opposite side edge, work 15 hdc evenly spaced along rows of side edge. Leave sts of Row 14 unworked.
Row 16: Ch 3, turn, skip first hdc, work 3 dc in each hdc along one side and bottom edges. Leave remaining side edge unworked.
Fasten off.
Row 17: Join $\mathbf{A}$ in first st of Row 1, ch 1, hdc in each st along side, bottom and remaining side edge.
Fasten off.

## RIGHT SPAT

Work as for Left Spat through Row 14.

## Ruffle Edging

Row 15: Change to $B$, ch 1 , turn to work along side edge, work 15 hdc evenly spaced along rows of side edge, ch 1 , turn to work opposite foundation ch, hdc in each st across, ch 1 , turn to work along opposite side edge, work 15 hdc evenly spaced along rows of side edge. Fasten off. Leave sts of Row 14 unworked.
Row 16: Join B in first st of Row 15, ch 3, work 3 dc in each st along side and bottom edge. Leave remaining side edge unworked.
Row 17: Join A in first st of Row 16, ch 2, hdc in each st along side, bottom and remaining side edge.
Fasten off.

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8].
Yarn needle, 6 buttons, 3/4" diameter.

FINISHING
Sew 3 buttons evenly spaced along side without Ruffle.
Push buttons through sts to close.
Weave in ends.


STITCH NATION by Debbie Stoller ${ }^{\text {TM }}$
"Full o' Sheep ${ }^{\text {TM " }}$ Art. T100 available in $3.5 \mathrm{oz}(100 \mathrm{~g}) ; 155 \mathrm{yd}(142 \mathrm{~m})$ balls.

Abbreviations: A, B, C = Color A, B, C; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es).
