



Ruffled Hip Belt

Take a plain outfit from boring to lively with this crocheted belt. This one is embellished with cowrie shells, but you can use beads or other craft store findings.

Designed by Double Stitch.

Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium and Large are in parentheses.

Belt Length (without ties) = $25\frac{1}{2}(27\frac{3}{4}, 30)$ ".

RED HEART® "Soft Yarn": 1 ball each 9388 Wheat **A**, 9937 Garden Print **B**, and 9522 Leaf **C**.

Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]. Yarn needle, 8 to 10 cowrie shells.

GAUGE: 14 sts = 4"; 20 rows = 4" in sc. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

BELT

With A, ch 90 (98, 106).

Row 1 (Right Side): Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn – 89 (97, 105) hdc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each hdc across; turn.

Rows 3 and 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn. Fasten off at end of Row 4.

Row 5: With right side facing, skip first 5 sc, join **B** in next sc; ch 1, sc in each sc across to last 5 sc; TURN, leaving remaining 5 sc unworked – 79 (87, 95) sc.

Rows 6-8: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn. Fasten off at end of Row 8.

Ruffle Trim-Row 9: With right side facing, join **C** in first sc of Row 8; ch 3, 2 dc in same sc, 3 dc in each sc across;

Row 10: Ch 1, hdc in each dc across. Fasten off.

Top Ties

With **C**, ch 80, with right side facing, sc in each ch across foundation ch, ch 80. Fasten off.

Bottom Tie

Join **C** in next free sc of Row 4; ch 1, sc in same sc and in next 4 sc, ch 80. Fasten off.

Repeat Bottom Tie on opposite side. Weave in all ends.

Embellishment

Sew cowrie shells evenly across (about 1 inch apart) on right side, along the length of the belt just above Row 5.

ABBREVIATIONS: A, B, C = color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
