Crochet Change Purse

This easy beginner project is perfect for coins, stitch markers, or any little treasures. Crochet it for gifts or to organize your life in any of the many colors of Super Saver.

What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:
1 skein 315 Artist Print.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5.5mm [US I-9].

Stitch markers, yarn needle, one
1½" (4 cm) button (La Mode 1995)

GAUGE: 17 sts = 5" (13 cm);
14 rows = 4" (10 cm) in single
crochet. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use
any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Super
Saver®, Art. E300
available in solid color
7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m);
multicolor, heather and print 5 oz
(141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz
(141g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins

Purse measures 5" x 4" (13 x 10 cm).

PURSE

Ch 18

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook
and in each ch across, turn—17 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn.
Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 8" (20 cm)
from beginning, ending with a wrong side row.
Place a marker at each end of the last row
worked.

Flap

Continue working in sc 1½" (4cm) more,
ending with a wrong side row.

Next row (right side): Ch 3 (counts as dc)
skip first sc, dc in each remaining sc to end,
turn—17 dc.

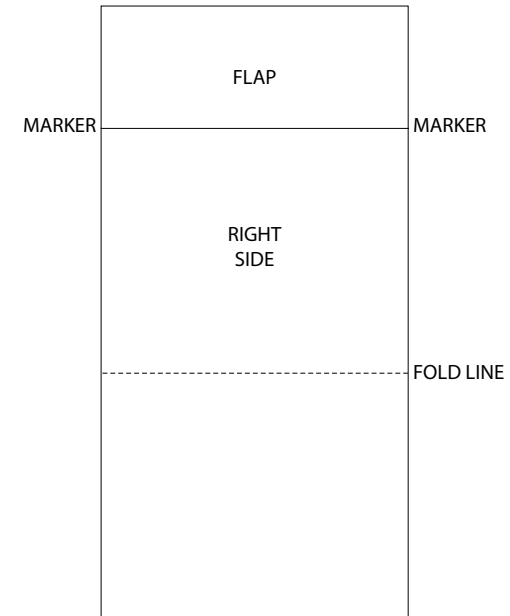
Next row: Ch 1, sc in each dc across.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold piece with right sides together and
foundation chain even with markers. Sew
sides up to markers, leaving flap free. Turn to
right side. Sew button opposite dc row (use
space between stitches as buttonhole). Weave
in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es); **sc** = single crochet;
dc = double crochet; **ch** = chain [] = work
directions in brackets the number of times
specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as
indicated.
