



## MATERIALS

**Red Heart® Super Saver™** (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Gold (0321)

**1 ball**

**Note:** 1 ball makes 12 Envelopes.

Size U.S. 7 [4.5 mm] crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Dcbp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Dcfp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Rem** = Remaining

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**Sl stfp** = Slip stitch in front post

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tr** = Treble crochet

**WS** = Wrong side

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 4½" x 3½" [11.5 x 9 cm]

## GAUGES

14 sc and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm].

Motif = 6½" [16.5 cm] square.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- To work front loop only, insert hook through front arm of "v". See Diagram B.

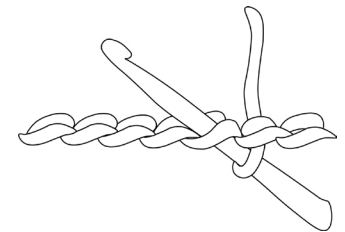


DIAGRAM B

- To work back loop only, insert hook through back arm of “v”. See Diagram C.

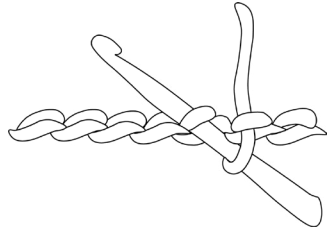


DIAGRAM C

- In 6th rnd of square and 2nd rnd of button, work sl st loosely.

### Square Motif:

See diagram on page 3.

Ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to make a ring.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 8 sc in ring. Join with sl st in first sc.

**2nd rnd:** Working in back loops only, ch 2 (**does not** count as hdc). 2 hdc in each st around. Join with sl st in first hdc. 16 hdc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 5 (counts as first dc and ch 2). 1 dc in same st as join. \*1 dc in each of next 3 sts. (1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dc) in next st. Rep from \* twice more. (1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dc) in next st. 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. Join with sl stfp around first dc.

**4th rnd:** Ch 3 (counts as first dcfp). \*(1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dc.) in next ch-2 sp. (1 dcfp around next st. 1 dcbp around next st) twice. \*\* 1 dcfp around next st. Rep from \* twice more. Rep from \* to \*\* once. Join with sl st in first dcfp.

**5th rnd:** Working in front loops only, ch 1. 1 sc in same st as join. 1 sc in next st. \*(1 sc. Ch 2. 1 sc.) in next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in each of next 7 sts. Rep from \* twice more. (1 sc. Ch 2. 1 sc) in next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in each of next 5 sts. Join with sl st in back loop of first sc.

**6th rnd:** Working in back loops only, ch 1. Sl st in same st as join. Sl st in each of next 2 sts. \*Sl st in 1st ch of ch-2 sp. Ch 2. Sl st in 2nd ch of ch-2 sp. Sl st in each of next 9 sts. Rep from \* twice more. Sl st in 1st ch of ch-2 sp. Ch 2. Sl st in 2nd ch of ch-2 sp. Sl st in each of next 6 sts. Join with sl st in back loop of first sl st.

**7th rnd:** Working in back loops only, ch 2. 1 hdc in same st as join. 1 hdc in each of next 3 sts. \*(1 hdc. Ch 2. 1 hdc) in next ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each of next 11 sts. Rep from \* twice more. (1 hdc. Ch 2. 1 hdc) in next ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each of next 7 sl sts. Join with sl st in first hdc.

**8th rnd:** (Buttonhole rnd). Ch 4 (counts as first tr). 1 tr in each of next 4 sts. (1 tr. Ch 3. 1 tr) in next ch-2 sp (buttonhole). (1 tr in each of next 13 hdc. 3 tr in next ch-2 sp) 3 times. 1 tr in each of next 8 sts. Join with sl st in first tr. Fasten off.

**Button:** Ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to make a ring. Leaving a long end for sewing.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 8 sc in ring. Join with sl st to first sc

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sl st into horizontal bar created below st on WS in each sc (see diagram D). Join with sl st to first sl st. Fasten off. Weave in working end.

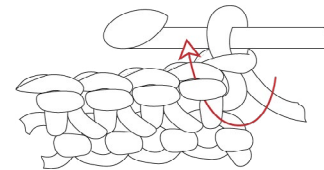


DIAGRAM D

Sew button to RS of work to correspond to buttonhole when Envelope is folded.

Flip to WS up. Fold in and sew tog 3 corners without ch-3 sp to form envelope. See Diagram A.

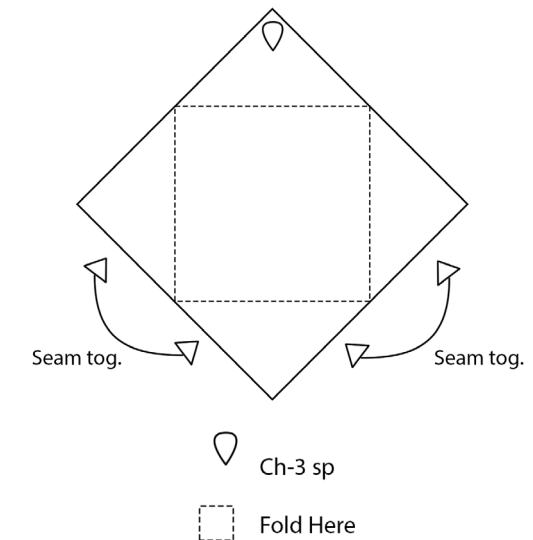
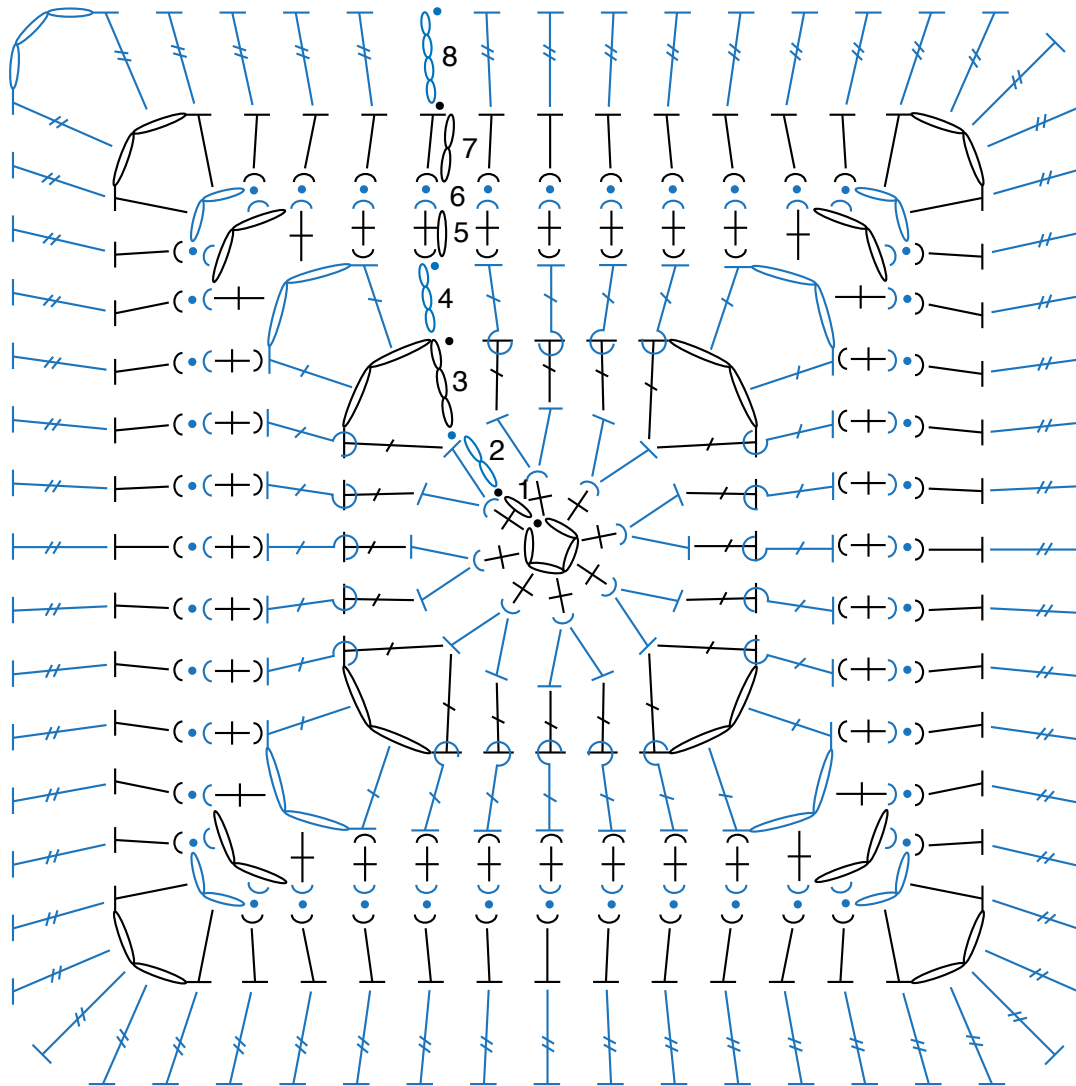


DIAGRAM A: ASSEMBLY

- STITCH KEY**

  - ┆ = front post double crochet (dcfp)
  - ┆ = back post double crochet (dcbp)
  - ⊂ = worked in back loop only
  - ⊃ = worked in front loop only
