

## MATERIALS

Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\circledR}$ (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)
Main Color (MC) Shocking Pink (0718) $\mathbf{2}$ balls or $\mathbf{6 9 2}$ yds/629 m
Contrast A Pumpkin (0254) 1 ball or 323 yds/294 m
Sizes U.S. F/5 ( 3.5 mm ) and U.S. $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ Susan Bates ${ }^{\ominus}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\oplus}$ crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ split lock stitch markers.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg $=$ Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Hdc = Half double crochet
Hdcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work inserting hook from right to left. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook
Hdcrb = Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch.


Yoh and draw up a loop in space one row below where previous stitch was worked.


## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 12" [24 cm] wide x $14^{\prime \prime}$ [18 cm] tall x 3 " $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] deep, excluding handles.

Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.


Pat = Pattern
PM = Place marker
Rem = Remaining
Rep $=$ Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook
SI st = Slip stitch
Sp(s) = Space(s)
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

## GAUGES

15 sc and 17 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] with larger hook.
11 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm ] with larger hook in Hdcrb pat.

## Notes:

- Join each rnd with sl st to first st.
- Ch 2 at beg of rnds does not count as st.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.


## BOTTOM

See Diagram on page 4. With MC and larger hook, ch 30.
1 st rnd: ( 1 hdc. Ch 1.1 hdc) in 3rd ch from hook. PM on ch-1 sp. 1 hdc in each ch to last ch. [(1 hdc. Ch 1) twice. 1 hdc] in last ch. PM on 1st and 2nd ch-1 sps. Do not turn. Working across rem loops of foundation ch, 1 hdc in each of rem 26 ch. 1 hdc in ch where first hdc made. Join with sc to top of first hdc (counts as ch-1 sp). 58 hdc and 4 ch-1 sps.
2nd rnd: Ch 2.1 hdc around post of joining sc. 1 hdc in next hdc. (1 hdc. Ch 1.1 hdc ) in next ch- 1 sp .1 hdc in each hdc to next ch-1 sp. (1 hdc. Ch 1.1 hdc) in next ch- 1 sp .1 hdc in next hdc. (1 hdc. Ch 1.1 hdc) in next ch-1 sp. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of rnd. 1 hdc around post of joining sc. Join with sc to top of first hdc. 66 hdc and $4 \mathrm{ch}-1$ sps.

3rd and 4th rnds: Ch 2.1 hdc around post of joining sc. *1 hdc in each hdc to next ch-1 sp. (1 hdc. Ch 1.1 hdc ) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * twice more. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of rnd. 1 hdc around post of joining sc. Join with sc to top of first hdc. 82 hdc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Note: Hdcrb-sts of Sides are wider than hdc for Bottom. Sides will spread wider naturally.

## SIDES

See Diagram on page 4.
1st rnd: Ch 2. 1 hdcbp around each hdc, skipping ch-1 sps, to end of rnd. Join with sl st to first hdc. 82 hdc.
2nd rnd: Ch 2.1 hdcrb in each st around. Join with sl st to first st. Rep last rnd until work from beg measures 13" [33 cm]. Join A. Break MC.

Border: 1st rnd: With A, ch 2.1 hdc in each st around. Join.
2nd to 4th rnds: Ch 2.1 hdcbp around post of each hdc to end of rnd. Join.

5th rnd: Ch 1. Working from left to right, instead of from right to left, as usual, work 1 reverse sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

## HANDLES (make 2)

See Diagram on page 5.
With A and larger hook, ch 95.
1st rnd: 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to last ch. 3 sc in last ch. PM on 1st sc of just made 3-sc group. Do not turn. Working across rem loops of foundation ch, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. 1 sc in sp where first 2 sc were made. Join. 190 sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st . 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each sc to next marked sc. 2 sc in marked sc. PM on first sc of 2-sc group just made. 2 sc in each of next 2 sc . 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Join. 196 sc.
3rd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each sc to next marked sc. 2 sc in marked sc. ( 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) twice. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc .2 sc in next sc. 1 scin last sc. Join. 142 sc .

4th rnd: Ch 1. Working from left to right, instead of from right to left, as usual, work 1 reverse sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.


REVERSE SC


Rnd of surface sl st: With MC, larger hook and RS facing, work surface sl st across last rnd of sc as follows: Hold MC at WS of work. Insert hook in any sc of last sc rnd from front to back and draw up a loop. *Insert hook in next sc of last sc row from front to back and work sl st loosely (do not pull fabric). Rep from * around.
Fold Handles in half lengthwise and using A sew sides tog, leaving 4 " 10 cm ] of each end unsewn.

## BUTTON (make 4)

See Diagram on page 4.
Note: Button is worked with WS facing.

With MC and smaller hook ch 2, leaving a long end.
1 st rnd: (WS). 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Do not join. Work in continuous rnds. PM for beg of rnd. 2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 12 sc .
3rd rnd: (1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. 18 sc .
4th and 5th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.
6th rnd: (1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog) 6 times. 12 sts.

7th rnd: (Sc2tog) 6 times. 6 sts. Fasten off leaving a long end. Using long ends from foundation chain, fold button flat and sew through the center for tufted shape.

With $A$, sew 4" [10 cm ] unfolded sections of Handles to Tote below orange section, working through both thicknesses and surface sl st. Sew buttons as shown in picture.


FLOWER (make 1) See Diagram on page 5.
Note: Do not join at each end of rnd. Work in spiral rounds, moving marker as work progresses.

With A, ch 2.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. PM for beg of rnd.
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as last sl st. 2 sc in each of next 5 sc . 12 sc .

3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. 18 sc.

4th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 2 sc . *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Rep from * to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. 24 sc .
5th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 3 sc . ${ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. 30 sc .
6th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 4 sc . ${ }^{2} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc . Rep from * to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. 36 sc . Join with sl st in next sc.

First Petal: **1st row: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc .2 sc in next sc. 8 sc . Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1.2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. 10 sc . Turn.
4th to 6th rows: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
7th to 9th rows: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. 4 sts at end of last row.
10th row: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Turn.

11th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Fasten off.**

Second to Sixth Petals: Join A with sl st to next sc of 6th rnd. Work from ** to ** as given for First Petal. Do not fasten off at end of last Petal.

Outer edge: 1st rnd: (RS). With A, ch 1 . ( 1 sc . Ch 1.1 sc ) all in last st. *11 sc down left side of Petal. SI st between 2 Petals. 11 sc up right side of next Petal.** (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc ) all in top of Petal. Rep from * around, ending at ${ }^{* *}$. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

With MC, work surface sl st around Flower, 1 st in from edge as shown in photo.

Sew Flower to front of Bag as shown in picture.
