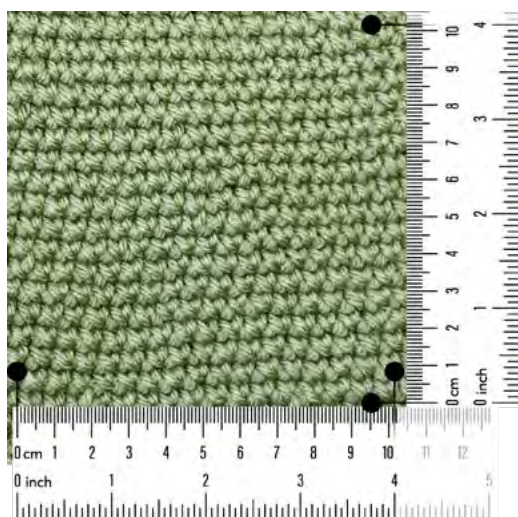

## GAUGE

16 sc and 17 rows = 4" [10 cm].

### Red Heart® Super Saver®

(7 oz/198 g; 364 yds /333 m)

**Main Color (MC)** Frosty Green (0661)

1 ball or 175 yds/159 m

### Red Heart® Super Saver® Super Pastel Kit™

Kit includes: 12 balls (50 g/1.7 oz each; 600 g/21 oz total), yardage (93 yds/85 m each; 1116 yds/1020 m total)

- **Soft White, Dusty Grey, Pale Yellow, Coral, Baby Pink, Pale Plum, Light Blue, Light Periwinkle, Light Sage**
- 1 ball or 50 g each

## TOOLS

- Size U.S. 7 [4.5 mm] Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.
- Pair of purse handles with approx. 7" [18 cm] internal opening.
- Tape measure.

Approx 9½" [24 cm] wide x 8" [20.5 cm] tall, excluding handles.

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## INSTRUCTIONS

### Base of Bag

With MC, **chain** (ch) 31.

**1st round (rnd):** 1 **single crochet** (sc) in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to last ch. 3 sc in last ch. **Place marker** (PM) in center stitch (st). *Working in opposite side of ch*, 1 sc in each ch to last ch. 2 sc in last ch. Join with **slip stitch** (sl st) to first sc. 64 sts.



**2nd to 4th rnds:** Ch 1. 2 sc in first st. 1 sc in each st to 1 st before marked st. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in next st. PM. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to last 2 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in last st. Join with sl st to first sc. 76 sts.

### Body of Bag

**Note:** From this point forward, Bag is worked as a spiral. **Do not** join rnds. Move marker up each rnd to maintain rnd count.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. ***Working in back loops only***, 1 sc in each sc around. PM on last st of rnd.

**2nd rnd:** 1 sc in each sc around.

Rep 2nd rnd until work from first rnd of Body of Bag measures approx 8" [20.5 cm].

**Next rnd:** 1 sc in each sc to last st. **Slip stitch** (sl st) in last st. **Fasten off**.





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## INSTRUCTIONS

### Handle Casings (make 2)

With Light Sage, ch 23.

**1st row:** 1 sc in 2nd chain from hook. 1 sc in each chain to end of chain. Turn. 22 sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

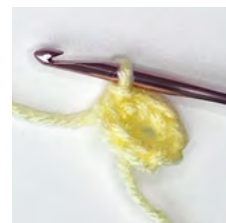
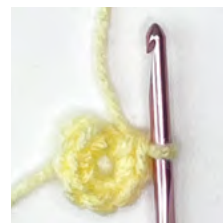
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures approx 3" [7.5 cm]. Fold around purchased handle as shown in photo. With Handle Casings held against Right Side (RS) of work and centered as shown in photo, whipstitch to Bag through all three thicknesses.



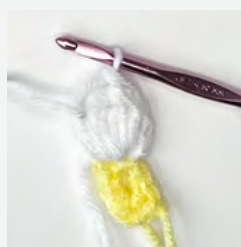
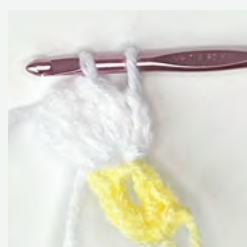
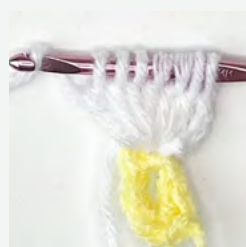
### Puffy Flower


With Pale Yellow, ch 2.

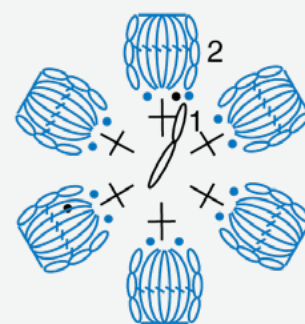
**1st rnd:** 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st to first sc. **Fasten off** Pale Yellow.



**2nd rnd:** Join Soft White with sl st to any sc. \*Ch 3 (counts as dc). Yarn over hook (yoh) and draw up a long loop, equal in height to beg ch 3. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 6 times all in same sc as sl st. Yoh and draw through 6 loops on hook. Yoh and draw through last 2 loops. Ch 3. Sl st in same sc – Petal Cluster made. Sl st in next sc. Rep from \* 5 times more. Sl st in same sc as first sl st. **Fasten off** leaving a 3" [7.5 cm] long tail to seam to Bag. 6 petals total.

PUFFY FLOWER



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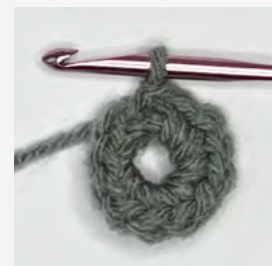
**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Grey and Blue Flower

\*\*With Dusty Grey, ch 2.

**1st rnd:** 12 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st to first sc.



**2nd rnd:** Ch 6 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 3). Skip next sc. \*1 **double crochet** (dc) in next sc. Ch 3. Skip next sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-6. **Fasten off.**



**3rd rnd:** Join Light Blue with sl st to any ch-3 space (sp). Ch 3. 4 dc in same ch-3 sp as last sl st. \*Ch 4. 5 dc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* around. Ch 4. Join with sl st to top of beg ch 3.



**4th rnd:** Sl st in each of next 2 dc. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. \*Ch 1. Skip next 2 dc. (5 dc. Ch 3. 5 dc) all in next ch-4 sp. Skip next 2 dc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join.

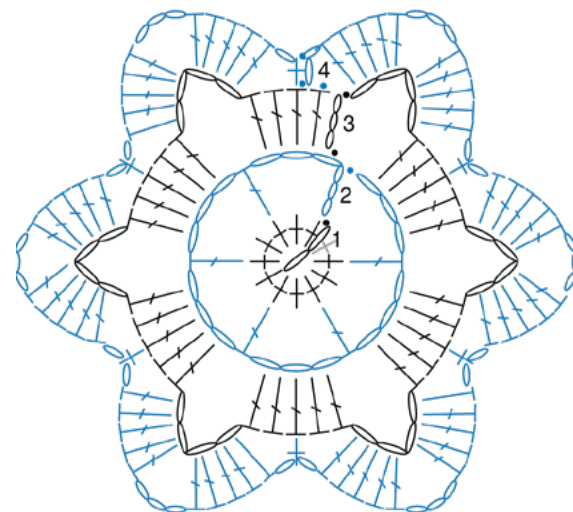
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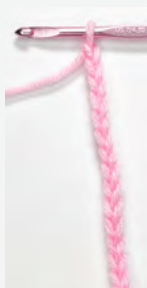

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## INSTRUCTIONS

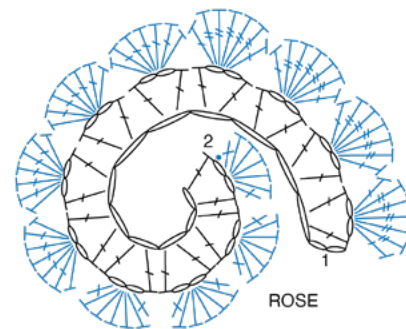
### Rose

With Baby Pink, ch 14.

**1st row:** [1 **half double crochet** (hdc). Ch 2. 1 hdc] all in 3rd ch from hook. (1 hdc. Ch 2. 1 hdc) in each ch to end of ch. Turn.



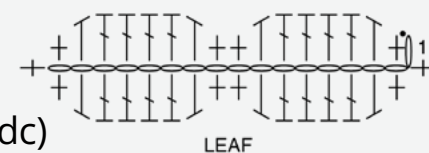
**2nd row:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp. (1 sc. 5 hdc. 1 sc) in next ch-2 sp. [(1 sc. 5 hdc. 1 sc) in next ch-2 sp] 3 times. [(1 hdc. 5 dc. 1 hdc) in next ch-2 sp] 4 times. [(1 dc. 5 **treble crochet** [tr]. 1 dc) in next ch-2 sp] 4 times. **Fasten off.**



### Leaf

With Light Sage, ch 17.

**1st rnd:** 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. \*1 **half double crochet** (hdc) in next ch. 1 dc in each of next 4 ch. 1 hdc in next ch. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch. 1 hdc in next ch. 1 dc in each of next 4 ch. 1 hdc in next ch. 3 sc in next ch. *Working into opposite side of foundation ch, rep from \* once more, ending with 2 sc in last ch. Join with sl st to first sc. **Fasten off.***



## STITCH KEY

○ = chain (ch)  
 • = slip stitch (sl st)  
 + = single crochet (sc)  
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Coil Rose into rose shape and sew to Leaf as pictured.





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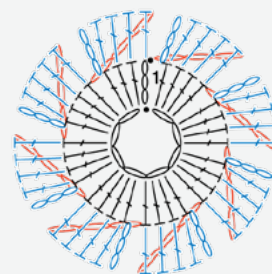
### Coral Flower

**Note:** A video tutorial for this flower is available [here](#). While the yarn and shade may differ, the stitch counts and techniques are identical. This motif is fastened off after the first rnd of work, and is not "squared off" as in the video.

With Coral, ch 8. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.

**1st rnd:** Ch 3 (counts as dc). 3 dc in ring. Turn. Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 dc in 3rd ch of ch 3. Turn. – Beg Petal made. Ch 3. Working across back of petal just made, 4 dc in ring. Turn. Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. Turn – Petal made. (Petal in ring) 6 times more. Join with sl st to top of ch 3 of Beg Petal. **Fasten off.**

### Pale Plum and Light Periwinkle Flower

**Note:** A video tutorial for this flower is available [here](#). While the yarn and shade may differ, the stitch counts and techniques are identical. This motif is fastened off after the fifth rnd of work, and is not "squared off" as in the video.

With Pale Plum, ch 8. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 18 sc in ring. Join with sl st to first sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in same st as sl st. \*Ch 3. Skip next 2 sts. 1 sc in next st. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. Ch 3. Skip last 2 sts. Join with sl st to first sc. **Fasten off.**

**3rd rnd:** Join Light Periwinkle with sl st to first ch-3 sp. (1 sc. Ch 3. 5 dc. Ch 3. 1 sc) all in same ch-3 sp. (1 sc. Ch 3. 5 dc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. **Fasten off.**

**4th rnd:** Join Pale Plum with sl st between 2 sc. \*1 sc in same sp as sl st. Working behind sts in previous row, ch 5. 1 sc between next 2 sc. Rep from \* around, ending with ch 5. Join with sl st to first sc.

**5th rnd:** Sl st in next ch-5 sp. Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 3. 7 dc. Ch 3. 1 sc) all in same ch-5 sp. (1 sc. Ch 3. 7 dc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in next ch-5 sp. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. **Fasten off.** Sew Flowers to front of Bag as shown in photo.
